## A Kentucky Colonel

Civilian Honor

TUSCUMBIA — Tom McKnight was unprepared for the package addressed to “Colonel Thomas McKnight,” considering he left the U.S. Air Force with the rank of sergeant.

The package arrived a few months after he was asked by an officer of the Daughters of the American Revolution’s Chief Colbert Chapter if he minded being nominated to become a Kentucky Colonel.

“Naturally, I replied in the affirmative and thereafter

thought no more about it,” said McKnight, a tireless advocate for military veterans and a member of Tuscumbia’s American Legion Post 31 Color/Honor Guard.

Kentucky Colonel is the highest honor awarded by the Commonwealth of Kentucky. According to the Kentucky

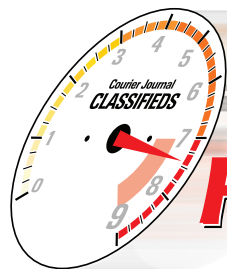

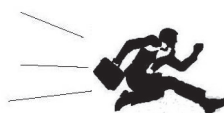

# Cat & Kids

## Take Action

During this week's Five Days of Action!, YMCAs across the nation are working to raise awareness and inspire all adults to take action to protect children from sexual abuse. As the Health and Wellness Director of our local YMCA, I was intrigued when the first action tool came across my desk. So I thought that I would share it. I think that great learning comes through play. And conversation starters are always good for parents. For full information check out [www.fivedaysofaction.org](http://www.fivedaysofaction.org). But meanwhile, think about trying the suggested "What If?" Game with your children.

"The "What If?" Game is a great way to pose possible situations to kids that they may face in life and would need to solve. As a parent or caregiver, it's important to let your kids know you are always there for them and they can tell you anything. But you can't always be there, at least not physically. By playing the "What If?" Game, you are empowering your children to develop positive decision-making skills and giving them the confidence they need to problem-solve

on their own. It helps build resilience, which is crucial for overcoming obstacles.

Check-in with your kids about how they are feeling right now. Ask them hypothetical questions: "What would you do if...?" Mix real questions in with silly questions to keep them engaged. "What if you met an alien - what would you ask? What if you could be a superhero - what would your superpower be? What if someone you don't like tries to kiss you, what would you do?"

**Identify age-appropriate, potential safety scenarios.**

Play in a casual and neutral environment. This makes a great car-ride game!

Ask questions about a mix of daily life events, unexpected situations, and sexual boundary violations.

Be clear it is a game. It's not that you expect these things to happen, but you're prepared if it does.

Include only two or three scenarios at a time. Play the "What If?" Game overtime, not all at once.

Let your kids ask you the questions, too! They can learn from how you respond.

Use index cards to make your own deck or you can purchase a starter pack from the Darkness to Light website.

**Pose scenarios or have your kids come up with them:**

- Use actual scenes and examples from the child's life.

- I.e.: What if you climbed up a tree just fine, but then you weren't sure how to come down? Or, What if during your sleepover at Jeffery's house you wake up scared?
- The idea is not to scare or barrage your child all at once - you may only want to ask one or two questions that involve boundaries and sexual abuse.
- I.e.: What would you do if Sam's brother asked you to look at naked pictures?
- The idea is not to scare or barrage your child all at once - you may only want to ask one or two questions that involve boundaries and sexual abuse.
- You know your child best - if he/she shows enthusiasm, mirror this! If they seem scared or anxious, use encouragement, and don't push them.
- Wait for the child's ideas and try not to coach unless the child is really stumped.
- I.e.: Well, let's just think about ideas we have. Or, What's the first thing you might try? Or, Is there someone around who could help?
- Creating their own solutions builds confidence for problem-solving in all areas, not just the ones you talk about. Children are more likely to remember the solution they thought of."

We need to find ways to talk with our children. Your children need your help in this world. Be their safe place. Take action!

# What Amy Coney Barrett Means to Conservative Women

If the last four years taught us anything, it's that Americans love politics but they hate politicians. Thankfully, the country has a new, non-political figure to admire: Justice Amy Coney Barrett.

Barrett was confirmed last week by the Senate and sworn in as an associate justice to the U.S. Supreme Court. The optics alone were historic. Clarence Thomas, a black, conservative justice, administered the swearing in oath for the first female originalist justice—and the first justice who's a mother of school-aged children.

During the swearing in ceremony at the White House, Barrett made her judicial philosophy clear: She will not legislate from the bench. "It is the job of a judge to resist her policy preferences. It would be a dereliction of duty for her to give into them," she said, adding:

"This separation of duty from political preference is what makes the judiciary distinct among the three branches of government. A judge declares independence,

not only from Congress and the President, but also from the private beliefs that might otherwise move her. The Judicial Oath captures the essence of the judicial duty. The rule of law must always control.” Barrett’s respect for the separation of powers, coupled with her unflappable determination to stay above the political fray, may explain her popularity among voters. She answered grueling questions with nothing more than a blank notebook while displaying a level of patience and grace that could only be matched by a working mom of seven. (It’s safe to assume Barrett is used to dealing with temper tantrums and long days.) Minutes after being sworn in as an associate justice to the Supreme Court, Judiciary Committee Chairman Sen. Lindsey Graham, R-S.C., told Fox News’ “Hannity” that Barrett’s Supreme Court

nomination was a triumph not just for the rule of law, but also for conservative women. “To all conservative women who go through hell for being conservative, who get beat up by the mainstream media for embracing your faith, being pro-life... you’re a winner tonight. There’s a seat at the table for you,” he said. Graham’s remarks stood in direct contrast to Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer, D-N.Y., who hours earlier called Barrett’s confirmation “one of the darkest days in the 231-year history of the United States Senate.” Sure, it might have been one of the darkest days for a leftist, establishment guy. But for the millions of hardworking conservative women seeking an example of what it can look like to balance faith, family, and a fulfilling, successful career, Barrett’s confirmation was one of the brightest days in all of history.

It was especially bright for those of us who are exhausted and demoralized by the ugly rancor and political rhetoric. And it was encouraging for those of us who are told we are traitors to our sex if we don’t vote a certain way. It was also historic for those of us who hear, “There is a special place in hell for women who don’t support other women,” but then watch as so-called feminists turn around to destroy women who don’t follow their explicit agenda. Indeed, they didn’t hold back for Barrett. When a figure like Amy Coney Barrett walks in the door and earns a seat at the table, she establishes a new vision for feminism and reminds conservative women who—and what—we’re fighting for. The significance of her example cannot be overstated. Whether we’re single, stay-at-home moms, career women, or a mix, Barrett shows what’s possible for us to achieve. Her story rejects the tired notion of traditional feminism and replaces it with a bold version that embraces womanhood for all its glories: marriage, motherhood, faith and a fulfilling career. In a year of political burnout, Barrett’s story reminds us of another important thing: Nice guys don’t always finish last. Sometimes, she even finishes first. 

secretary of state's website, it began in 1813 during the second term of Gov. Issac Shelby after he returned from leading the Kentucky Militia on a highly successful campaign during the War of 1812.

Shelby named one of his officers, Charles

Todd, as an aid-de-camp on the governor's staff with the rank and grade of colonel. Later governors commissioned colonels to act as their protective guards. They wore uniforms and were present at most official functions.

"They couldn't afford to pay staff, so he appointed people as colonels to go with him and work with him and whatever he needed," said Verna Brennan, a Kentucky native and member of the DAR.

Today, commissions for Kentucky Colonels are conferred by the governor and the secretary of state to individuals in recognition of noteworthy accomplishments, and outstanding service to a community, state or the nation.

"I sent in his résumé to nominate him," Brennan said. "You have to do a lot of service to mankind and he has definitely done it. That's the biggie."

A Kentucky Colonel since 1984, Brennan said only a Kentucky Colonel can nominate someone for the honor.

A letter included in the package along with his certificate read: "The Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky has identified you as a person of noteworthy accomplishments. You have been chosen to receive a commission as a Kentucky Colonel in recognition of your service to others. This is the highest title of honor bestowed by the Governor, and we are grateful to have a person of your caliber among our ranks."

McKnight has spent more than half his life working with various United Nations agencies that assisted people impacted by drought, famine and civil war. Brennan said McKnight fits the requirements of the Kentucky Colonel.

"My personal philosophy is that service to others, and choosing, or, being directed to

identify a unit of service in one's lifetime, is the rent that we pay on this earth in order to gain entry into heaven when that time comes," McKnight said.

According to the Kentucky secretary of state's website, the ranks of Kentucky Colonels include distinguished leaders such as Presidents Lyndon B. Johnson and Ronald Reagan, English Prime Minister Winston Churchill, volunteer firemen and teachers, people from all walks of life who have performed in an extraordinary

manner.

Brennan said the honor was also bestowed upon a former Sheffield mayor, the late Billy Don Anderson, Sheffield resident Joe Cooney, and Sheffield historian Richard Sheridan, who is also from Kentucky.

Since COVID-19 has impacted DAR meetings, Brennan mailed McKnight's certificate to him.

"I was pleased and honored to be considered for such a prestigious award and title," McKnight said.

# ON YOUR DEBT

## How to Handle Unexpected Income after Bankruptcy

Imagine that you have been wrestling with debt for a couple of years, and finally decided to take charge and reclaim control of your finances. You hire us at Bond & Botes and file Chapter 7 Bankruptcy. A few weeks after you file, you buy a Tennessee lottery ticket while you are paying for gas and you win.

**Now what?**

Under the U.S. Bankruptcy Code, any non-exempt income you receive or have a right to before filing Chapter 7 bankruptcy becomes part of the bankruptcy estate. But most post-filing earnings are not included in the bankruptcy estate. In other words, the earnings are yours to keep. In legal terms, that means lottery winnings from a ticket you purchased a few weeks after filing have nothing to do with the bankruptcy case—you can keep the money. Note, that the date you bought the ticket is the date that counts, not the date you found out you won. A ticket purchased pre-filing is itself an asset of the estate, and if it turns out to have monetary value, that's estate property.

Of course, the fact that you can proceed with the bankruptcy does not necessarily mean you will want to. That decision will likely depend on the amount of debt you were discharging and the amount of money you received. For example, if you were discharging \$23,000 in credit card debt and medical bills and you picked up \$472,504 in the lottery, you might choose to settle with your creditors and dismiss the bankruptcy case.

You will want to discuss the situation with your bankruptcy attorney right away, and before you take any action.

**Some Post-Filing Income Does Belong to the Bankruptcy Estate**

Bankruptcy law specifies some types of post-filing income will be considered part of the bankruptcy estate. The following types of property generally become a part of the bankruptcy estate—and therefore available for distribution to creditors unless they are exempt—if received within 180 days of filing:

- Property received through an inheritance, bequest or devise
- Property received through a property settlement with the debtor's spouse or by order of the divorce court
- Property received as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy or death benefit plan

Pre-existing interests of which you were not aware may also be property of the bankruptcy estate. For instance, if you were injured by a medical device and had a lawsuit in the works or already filed when you filed your bankruptcy petition, that claim would become part of the bankruptcy estate. On the contrary if you become injured after filing, any claim would not be part of the bankruptcy estate. But what if you were injured prior to filing and did not realize you might have a legal claim? Your interest in that claim existed at the time of filing, even though you were not aware of it, and thus is likely considered property of the bankruptcy estate.

In short, income or property received after the Chapter 7 petition is filed

typically belongs to the debtor and is not available for the trustee to distribute to creditors. Even so, income that falls into one of the listed exceptions above or that comes because of a pre-existing legal interest generally becomes part of the bankruptcy estate. You will want to speak with your bankruptcy attorney as soon as possible after you receive or learn that you are entitled to unexpected income to ensure that it is treated appropriately.

**Chapter 13 Bankruptcy Works Differently**

A Chapter 7 bankruptcy case is a short-term process designed to wipe the slate clean. The bankruptcy estate—with limited exceptions—is defined as of the date of filing, and the debtor can begin rebuilding immediately.

Chapter 13 is a longer-term proposition. A proposed plan involves repayment over a period of three to five years. The monthly payments and the percentage of unsecured debt the bankruptcy filer pays back are based in part on income. That means a Chapter 13 debtor may have to report changes or increases in income during the term of the plan. For example, if a person wants to modify and reduce the plan payment, the trustee and court will have the opportunity to review the person's pay stubs or income verification. If there has been an increase in income this may result in a modification of the plan to increase the amount being paid to creditors. Obviously, it would be in the person's best interest to speak with the attorney about any plan modifications or changes in income.

How interests such as lottery winnings, personal injury claims and other significant new property interests are treated depends in part on the bankruptcy court. Most jurisdictions in the Eleventh Circuit, which includes Alabama, has ruled that debtors in Chapter 13 have an ongoing obligation to disclose as long as the Chapter 13 case is pending.

Failure to disclose can have serious consequences, and not just for the bankruptcy case. In some situations, the court may prohibit the debtor from pursuing a claim that was not properly disclosed. So, it is critical that you immediately disclose any windfalls or new claims to your attorney while in Chapter 13 bankruptcy.

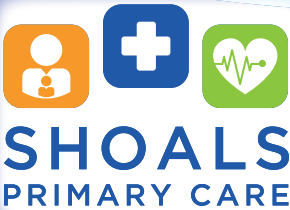

What is rideshare? What does it mean?

Ridesharing is using an online platform to connect passengers with drivers who use their privately owned vehicles to facilitate transportation needs.

- On-demand ridesharing companies, like Uber and Lyft, require drivers to carry only a standard vehicle operator’s license. Taxis require drivers to carry a commercial license.

- You always have a ride home if you’ve been out on the town. Drinking and driving accounts for 10,000 deaths per year — riding in an Uber or Lyft might help reduces the risk of drunk driving.
- Carpooling options help you go green while you’re on-the-go.
- It’s an alternative to public transportation.

Rideshare Safety Precautions

Is Uber safe? Is Lyft safe? Taking a few precautions can help you sit back and enjoy the ride.

- Share your trip with others. If you need to travel alone, consider taking the carpool option. It allows you to ride with others who have a similar destination.
- Keep your personal information confidential.
- Request your ride before you go outside.
- Sit in the back seat and wear your seatbelt.

- If your personal safety is threatened, call emergency personnel immediately.
- If something doesn’t feel right, don’t get into the vehicle.

Ridesharing isn’t only convenient and budget-friendly for riders, it’s also a great way for drivers to earn extra money. If you’re interested in becoming a driver, it’s important to make sure you understand the Ins-And-Outs of Rideshare Driver Coverage.

## Church Assemblies Important

# ASK THE ATTORNEY

**Q** As a homeowner, I am concerned about accidents that may happen when contractors and their employees are working on my house. Do I have any liability as a homeowner if someone who is working on my property is injured?  
*Bob, Florence, AL*

**A** The general rule is that a premises owner, in this case, a homeowner, owes no duty to an employee of an independent contractor if an employee of a contractor is injured on the homeowner's property. This general rule, however, is subject to a few exceptions. If an injured employee is able to establish that the homeowner retained right to control how the contractor performed his work,

the relationship changes from one of homeowner and contractor to master and servant. A master-servant relationship is not created, however, when the homeowner merely supervises or inspects the work of the contractor. Another exception relates to the homeowners duty to warn of hidden dangers. If a defect or danger is hidden and known to the owner, and the contractor does not know (or ought to know in the exercise of reasonable care) the homeowner has a duty to warn the contractor and its employees.

Simply put, as a homeowner, with very limited exception, you owe no duty to a contractor and/or the contractor's employees if they are injured while working at your home or on your property. With regard to the master-servant exception, the decisions of our Courts are a varied as the numerous fact scenarios. Needless to say, it is extremely difficult, if not impossible, to establish that the homeowner retains the right of control over the manner in which the independent contractor and his employees do their work. The only other exception requires that the homeowner use common sense. If you know of a hidden danger and you know that there is no way your contractor will find out about it if you don't tell them, let them know.

Remember, it is always a good practice to maintain homeowners insurance just in case some issue like this arises.

semester.  
According to NW-SCC Assistant Dean of Student Services, Dr. Crystal Reed, this is a way that NW-SCC can offer relief for those that want to continue or start their college education in such a tumultuous time.

"Northwest-Shoals knows how hard 2020 has been financially and emotionally for so many in our community," said Reed. "This is one way we can help those wanting to start or further their education in a very affordable way."

Students must apply for the scholarship at <https://bit.ly/2TuAbKG> to qualify and register for at least six credit hours in the spring semester by December 15. Additionally, each applicant must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (unless they are a dual enrolled high school student). Students can not already be receiving an institutional scholarship, be a high school dual-enrolled student taking classes online or at NW-SCC, or be a first-time student at NW-SCC. Transient students are not eligible for the scholarship.

Even if students have not applied or completed the registration process for the spring semester, the college encourages them to take advantage of spring registration at <https://www.nwscc.edu/2021-spring-registration>.
