Tim McGraw's song Live Like You Were Dying holds special meaning



New memorial at Courthouse Square dedicated to veterans

ALBION – A new veterans' memorial was dedicated on Nov. 11 at Courthouse Square. The Knights of Columbus, Albion Council #1330, took the lead in the project.

The headstone for the monument includes the inscription: "Dedicated to our courageous brothers and sisters of this community who served our country in times of peace and war. We thank them for their service. And especially to those who gave their lives in that service. May God grant them

The stone includes the insignias of the U.S. Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Army National Guard and Merchant Marine. The new flag pole includes a flag that recognizes the different branches of the military.

Greg Dugan is the grand knight for the Knights of Columbus in Albion. He also has been a local barber since 1991. He said many of his customers over the years have been veterans. He mentioned the late Albion Town Justice Bill Larimer, who was a POW in World War II. Dugan noted the late Rocco Sidari and Charles Shervin. Other current customers, including Ben Jones, currently serve in the military. Jones just returned from tours of duty in Iraq and Afghanistan.

"I've had contact with so many veterans, young and old, since 1991," Dugan said before today's ceremony. Once they are in the barber chair, Dugan

said many veterans open up and share about their experiences, including in combat.

Dugan thanked Orleans County officials for supporting the project and allowing it to be in a prominent place in the community. "It's been a heart-warming and amazing experience," he said.

The memorial includes two granite benches. One bench has an inscription, "To Commemorate." The other has the words, "To Heal."

"Thank you for taking the time to remember our veterans," Dugan told the crowd on Nov. 11. "They never gave up on us and we can't give up on them."



Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 2159 police incidents, including 947 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 208 for the New York State Police and 1004 calls for the Village Police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley. There were 622 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched county wide with 475 of those calls emergency medical in nature and 3 drug overdoses.

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 57 automobile accidents, including 4 with injury and 40 car-deer collisions. Road patrol also made 116 service attempts and successfully served 53 subpoenas, civil or court papers.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 118 incidents including 26 stray or loose animals, 2 animal bite complaints, 9 neighbor dog problems, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 9 animals were taken in to shelter on a voluntary surrender.

Gift-Wrapping Tips and Tricks


Much of the focus of each holiday season is on giftgiving, but all those gifts will eventually need to be wrapped. Stacks of presents just waiting to be covered with paper and ribbon can overwhelm gift givers, prompting them to put off wrapping gifts until the last minute.

Handle oddly-shaped items

Wrapping rectangular boxes can be a snap, but what about something that's round or full of angles? Think about placing oddly-shaped items inside another item to make the shape more uniform. Shoe boxes, coffee cans and even paper towel rolls can hold items. Then place the wrapping on these containers.

Cover prices

To enable easy exchanges or returns, do not cut off the price tags of gifts. Instead, place a festive sticker over the dollar amount, but leave the scan bar visible. This way the gift recipient can return the gift with ease if necessary.



Devote a bin or bins to wrapping supplies and tools. Having scissors, paper, tape, ribbon, and more in a designated spot will cut down on having to hunt and peck when it comes time to wrap. Martha Stewart suggests getting a rotary cutter to cut long straight or decorative edges on wrapping paper. Rotary cutters may be easier to use than scissors, especially when paired with a ruler.


Wrap on a firm surface

Devote a table or counter to wrapping gifts. This will keep the paper taut and neat and make it easier to cut and position. You risk tearing the paper or puncturing it when working on carpeting or bedding.

Color- or pattern-code gifts

It's easy to visualize who gets what gift when each recipient has his or her own special wrapping paper. This is also a handy idea when wrapping gifts from Santa, as it will differentiate the Santa gifts from the ones being given by Mom and Dad. ■

The best way to prevent & treat chapped lips

Chapped lips can be an unpleasant reminder that the weather is changing. Many different people experience chapped lips periodically, but they seem to be especially common when the air is dry and cold. Some people are prone to allergic reactions from cosmetics or skin care products. Read the ingredients carefully and avoid those that have led to reactions in the past.

Drink more fluids

Be sure to drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration, which can dry out lips and skin.

Avoid mouth-breathing

Drawing air in through your mouth can further dry out the lips. Alleviate a stuffy nose so you can breathe through your nose more easily.

The Mayo Clinic recommends speaking with a doctor if chapped lips are chronic and not easily remedied, as this may be a symptom of an underlying condition.

Signs of a HEART

Women are somewhat more likely than men to experience other common symptoms, particularly SHORTNESS OF BREATH, NAUSEA/VOMITING, AND BACK/JAW PAIN.

A village trustee has resigned from the Village Board to take a job as the village's code

Kevin Sheehan was elected to a four-year term as trustee on Sept. 15. He previously served

eight years on the board through 2014. He and trustee Gary Katsanis were filling in at code enforcement in October following the resignation of Tracy Vanskiver. Katsanis was handling complaints about property maintenance

Debbie Taylor, new East Shelby fire chief, first woman to lead fire department in Orleans County

EAST SHELBY — When Debbie Taylor first joined East Shelby Volunteer Fire Company at age 21, she had no thought of becoming a longtime member, let alone, be named fire chief, the first woman from Orleans County in that role. Taylor received the honor at the fire company's Nov. 3 meeting. David Green, who will celebrate 60 years as a member on Dec. 13, has served in many positions, including chief. He had nothing but praise for Taylor,

who he called loyal, hard working and dedicated. "She's been a member for quite a few years, and she works hard," Green said. "She is quick to learn things, she's well organized and she's got the personality to do a really great job." Taylor changed positions with former chief Andy Beach, who has a new baby at home and is very busy on his farm. He was anxious to step down, Taylor said.

After joining East Shelby Volunteer Fire Company at age 21, Taylor moved away and then came back and rejoined. She's been a member now for 16 years. She said joining the fire company was a natural thing. "I grew up watching the TV show 'Emergency," and when I married Jeff, both he and his father were members of East Shelby fire company." When she first joined, she said the thought of becoming chief wasn't even on her radar. "I just wanted to do something for my community," she said.

Serving the fire company is a family activity of the Taylors. Husband Jeff is fire captain and son Devin is first assistant chief. Debbie has worked her way up from lieutenant, to captain and 2nd assistant chief. She hopes to some day pass the chief's hat to her son. "There is no competition among us," Debbie said. "We have a great fire company and we all work very well together. The fire company is my second family." Jeff was first assistant chief, and he stepped back so Devin and Debbie could advance.

Debbie drives school bus for the Medina School District, so she would usually be free to answer a fire call. "I'm still going to be learning things, with all the modern technology," Debbie said. "It's always changing." She is not intimidated by driving even the biggest fire truck. She has had her CDL license since she was 19 and got it to drive milk truck. The biggest challenge, Debbie said, is the fact of the unknown when responding to a call. "You don't know what you're going to encounter," she said. "I've had a lot of help from Dale Banker, director of Orleans County Emergency Management, and Jerry Bentley (deputy coordinator)."

Banker said having the first woman chief is a great thing for the county. "She'll be a role model for any lady who wants to become a firefighter or EMS member," he said. "As long as they are properly trained, a woman can do well in a firefighting role."

He said the county is fortunate to have several women coming up the ranks, any one of whom he wouldn't be surprised to see become chief of their fire company. These include Kristin McAdoo, who is assistant chief of Ridgeway Volunteer Fire Company; Crystal Luckman and her sister Tiffany Petry in Shelby; Sue Maslyn, EMS captain in Kendall; Patty Knapp, EMS captain in Holley; and Robin Hughson,

"I look forward to working with Debbie, or any of the ladies," Banker said. "With the shortage of firefighters and EMS personnel, these women fill an important role."

A keeper for holiday dessert trays

Toffee Cheesecake Bars

Makes 2 1/2 dozen



1 cup all-purpose flour 3/4 cup confectioners' sugar

1/3 cup baking cocoa

1/2 cup cold butter

1 8-ounce package reduced-fat cream cheese

1 14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk 2 ggs, lightly beaten

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 1/4 cups milk chocolate English toffee bits, divided

1. In a small bowl, combine the flour, confectioners' sugar, cocoa and baking soda. Cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Press in the bottom of an ungreased 13-inch x 9-inch baking dish. Bake at 350 F for 12 to 15 minutes or until

2. In a large bowl, beat cream cheese until fluffy. Add the milk, eggs and vanilla; beat until smooth. Stir in 3/4 cup toffee bits. Pour over crust. Bake 18 to 22 minutes longer or until center is almost set.

3. Cool on a wire rack for 15 minutes. Sprinkle with remaining toffee bits; cool completely. Cover and refrigerate for 8 hours overnight. ■
