



Tex Midkiff in Pursuit of History in Texas

I met a delightful fisherman/author who lives, where else? but on Lake Fork, Texas. He and his wife La Juana built a rustic charmer in a wooded vale teeming with deer a stone's throw from the Birch Creek bridge. I already owned his latest book, Hidden History of Texas... before I was blessed to sit down in his writing study on a pleasant Fall afternoon. Conversation was the relaxed, rambling kind, moving through memorable experiences, bordering on laughter as well as tears, and ending up where we both are now in life, senior citizens with stories we want to share. I found out he loves Texas about as much as I do...and knows much more about the state due to extensive research as broad as our state. Now, I want you to meet him too!

Tex Midkiff is a writer, storyteller, local historian, and a retired VP of an international security concern. Although Tex was 'born here', his ancestors could not make that claim, becasue they arrived too early! Peter Ellis Bean, the husband of his GGGG Aunt, Candace Midkiff came to Texas with the Philip Nolan expedition in 1800 when it was still "New Spain."

Tex's love of East Texas and Texas history has its roots in these early settlements. The Candace Midkiff Bean 1936 Texas Centennial Marker reads in part: "one of those pioneer women who braved the menace of Indians and frontier life and rocked the cradle of Texas liberty."

Tex was baptized in the Trinity River and raised in the piney woods of East Texas. He is the consummate mythical male Texan, with roots firmly planted in the sandy loam coveted by the likes of J. Frank Dobie, John Henry Faulk, and Larry McMurtry. You might even call Tex the "Dittohead Antonym" of Molly Ivins!






