

Nonetheless the message my father had then is appropriate this year. As he put it: "Pessimists might suggest that we have a lot to be fearful of these days and not a lot to be thankful for. They'll say that the threats of terror attacks have cast a dark shadow over the country. And they'll argue that the country is divided politically and that unrest is widespread. But the truth is that every day is Thanksgiving Day. Challenges abound, they always have. But we have much more for which to be grateful than we have to be afraid of. As Psychologist Robert L. Leahy put it: 'giving thanks may be the best gift that you can give to others—and to yourself. And, like the best things in life, it's free"."

Top of the list of optimistic news for which we can be grateful is the promising progress being made on the development of a COVID killer vaccine. At least seven trials of vaccines are underway by respected pharmaceutical firms. They are working feverishly to make an effective serum available for distribution as soon as possible. In fact, bearing in mind that annual routine flu shots are 40 to 60 percent effective, according to the Centers for Disease Control, three of the COVID trials are reported to have shown impressive efficacy results in the 92 to 95 percent range.

Meanwhile, Just days ago Pfizer and its partner BioNTech announced that they are petitioning the FDA for approval for "emergency usage" of their vaccines. And several other drug companies whose trials have shown their COVID shots are highly effective are expected to file their own requests for early usage.

If these developments don't make you grateful, there are plenty of other reasons to be thankful. Keep in mind the armies of caregivers and first responders who risk their lives day after day to help the victims of the coronavirus.

And then there are our friends and neighbors who aren't afraid to offer help when needed, like Lauren Laborde who lost her job due to the pandemic. Instead of feeling sorry for herself she decided to do chores, including lawn work, for locked down senior citizens and veterans in her community in Houston, TX. She's not alone. Across the country there are thousands of citizen volunteers who go out of their way to help friends, families and strangers during these trying times.

My hope is that this message gives you a reason to have a Happy Thanksgiving.

River District Association announces RDA 2021 Dream Launch Boot Camp

DANVILLE VA - In celebration of Global Entrepreneurship Week, the River District Association (RDA) is excited to announce the continuation of the River District Association Dream Launch Boot Camp and Pitch Competition in 2021.

The RDA Dream Launch Boot Camp is for entrepreneurs who wish to learn how to open a business in the Dan River Region. It is also open to existing businesses who wish to hone their business knowledge. This will be the third RDA Dream Launch Boot Camp and Pitch Competition. "The program goes a step beyond incentivizing good ideas. Those that register for the program with the intent to pitch will be required to attend all sessions of our 'Entrepreneur Boot Camp', an intensive workshop that will meet once per week for 8 weeks beginning in January. Through this program, we can provide start-ups the tools, information, and assistance to give them the best possible opportunity for success."

Once participants complete the 8 week Boot Camp, they have the opportunity to pitch their idea for funding to open or expand their brick and mortar business in the River District.

Additionally, in 2021, entrepreneurs participating in the RDA Dream Launch Boot Camp, who may wish to locate their brick and mortar business in Pittsylvania County, or in Danville but outside of the River District, will have the opportunity to choose to instead pitch their idea at the Rev Up Danville Pittsylvania Pitch.

Eligible participants may only choose one pitch in which to participate. This year there will be \$50,000 in cash and prizes available in each of the pitch competitions, for a total of \$100,000 to support entrepreneurs locally.

RDA Dream Launch Bootcamp and both pitch competitions are also open to current businesses that would like to expand, as well as those that would like to audit the courses to prepare for potentially opening a business in the future. There is no cost to participate in the bootcamp or pitch. Due to COVID, the Dream Launch Boot Camp will be held virtually in 2021.





The Best Pumpkin Pie



INGREDIENTS

1 cup heavy cream

1 cup whole milk

3 large eggs plus 2 large yolks

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

115-ounce can pumpkin puree

115-ounce can sweet yams, drained

2/3 cup sugar

¼ cup pure maple syrup

1/2 teaspoon ground ginger

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

¼ teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/2 teaspoon table salt

1 prepared pie crust (homemade preferred)

Other: Deep dish pie pan

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 400° F. Adjust oven rack to lowest position, and place rimmed baking sheet on the rack.

In a large bowl, whisk cream, milk, eggs, yolks, and vanilla together; set aside.

In a large, heavy pan (not nonstick): combine pumpkin puree, yams, sugar, maple syrup, ginger, cinnamon, nutmeg, and salt. Bring to low boil over medium heat, 5-7 min. Continue simmering and stirring constantly while mashing yams against sides of pot with a fork until mixture is thick and smooth (10-15 min.)

move pan from heat. Whisk in cream mixture until fully incorporated and smooth without clumps.

Place prepared pie crust in a deep dish 9-inch pie plate. Flute edges as desired. Remove heated baking sheet from oven; carefully place pie on the preheated baking sheet. Pour the filling into the crust, and bake for 10 minutes at 400° F. Without taking the pie out of the oven, reduce the heat to 300° F, and continue baking until edges of pie are set (instant-read thermometer inserted in center registers 175° F), 45-55 minutes longer. The center may look firm but jiggle slightly; it will firm upon cooling. *Actual cook time depends on your specific oven.

Transfer to wire rack and cool to room temperature and not in the refrigerator to ensure that the filling sets, at least 3 hours depending on room temp. Cut into wedges and serve at room temperature or chilled with whipped cream.
