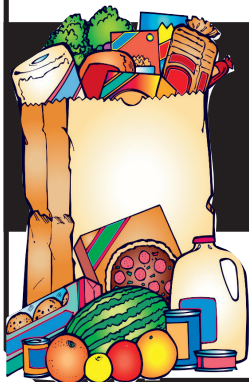

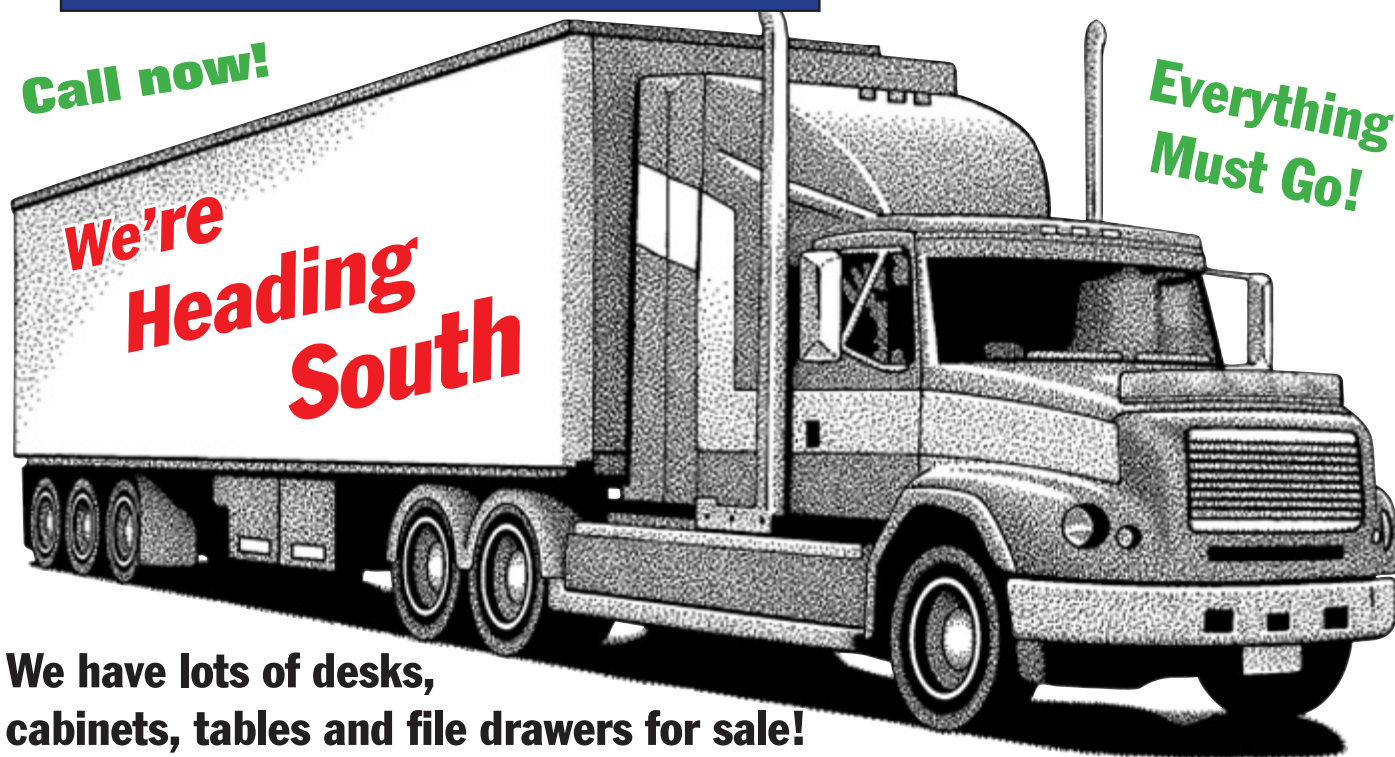

Dear "Speak Out",

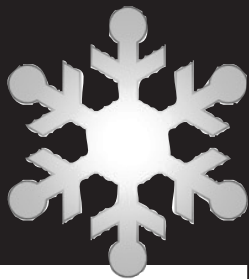

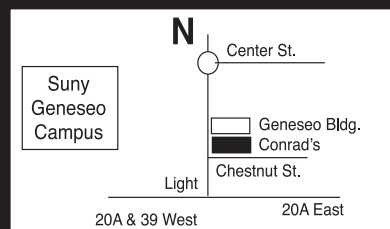

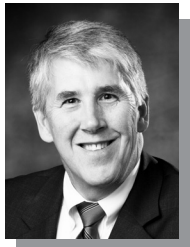
