On Sunday, November 22nd, I received an e-mail that was sent to many shelters in Virginia. A man named Kris Rotonda lives in Florida and after he adopted a dog from a shelter, he became more aware of the pet overpopulation problem. He began a non-profit organization, Jordan's way and then decided to do something bold and start a 50 state tour of shelters, visiting 3-4 in each state. He does a four-hour, highenergy Facebook Live event, spotlighting most of the animals in the shelter and raising money for shelter operations.

We reached out to him and he decided to visit the public animal shelter in Danville. The event was originally scheduled for November 30th, but will now be held on December 7th, from 5-9 p.m. The public is invited to attend, although masks and social distancing will be required by mandate of the Governor.

We appreciate the words of his public relations manager, Jennifer Johnson, which she posted on Jordan's Way Facebook page this past Monday afternoon:

Good afternoon,

I am Jennifer Johnson the PR Specialist and Marketing Manager with Jordan's Way. It has been brought to my attention that some have strong opinions on what shelter is appropriate for our visits. I make the final decision on the itinerary for our fundraisers. We make it a solid point not to be involved in any politics or drama. We also strive not to discriminate and in

all fairness, high kill Shelters are a big target for our cause. We bring exposure and awareness to the animals in an effort to help save more animals in these situations. By offering money in the form of a fundraiser and exposure, we give the animals a better chance at life. We are about saving animals not ignoring them because of where they may have ended up. By offering a fundraiser for a shelter, we are not endorsing their business practices but simply trying to save animals. Berating a shelter or filling our inboxes with accusations takes time and focus off the true cause....Thank you for your concerns.

We are so grateful for this opportunity to spotlight our shelter animals. All of the money raised will be used for our April Hogan Shelter Animal Fund. That fund is used to pay for veterinary treatment needed to make animals adoptable.





HOLLYWOOD - Movie distributors are more than ready to put films into theaters again, but moviegoers aren't ready to take a chance yet. Ryan Reynolds' "Free Guy" was to open July 3, 2020, then Dec. 11, but in November it was pulled. "Death on the Nile," with Kenneth Branagh (as Hercule Poirot), Gal Gadot and Armie Hammer, was due Dec. 18, but was pulled as well. "A Quiet Place: Part 2," starring Emily Blunt, was set to open March 8, 2020, with billboards up and TV ads running, but was sidelined by the coronavirus and rescheduled for April 23, 2021. Undaunted, plans are set for a threequel to open in 2022. ***

Sophia Loren, one of the last four stars of The Golden Age of Hollywood, scored excellent reviews for her Netflix remake of "Madame Rosa," called "The Life Ahead," which began streaming Nov. 13. The Washington Post said, "Madame Rosa is a prostitute who becomes a caregiver and mother figure for children of her colleagues in the sex-work industry. Sophia Loren inhabits the role with vulnerability and majesty. As one of the four final links to cinema's Golden Age, she is simply magnificent. She's still got it, and as this performance reminds us, she always did!'

In 1956, Sophia was signed to a five-picture deal by Paramount Pictures. Her first American movie was "Boy on a Dolphin," filmed in the Saronic Islands off Greece in 1957, with Alan Ladd and Clifton Webb, followed by "The Pride and the Passion," shot in Spain and starring Cary Grant and Frank Sinatra. Since she didn't speak any English, she learned her role and all her lines phonetically. During filming, Cary Grant fell in love with her, and in 1958 he replaced his then-wife, Betsy Drake (who actually wrote the script), in "Houseboat," with Sophia. Drake divorced Grant, but in the end Sophia jilted him and returned to her real love, producer Carlo Ponti, in 2007. They

were married until his death.

Her role in "The Life Ahead" is akin to "Two Women," for which she won a best actress Oscar in 1962. She skipped the Academy Awards that night because of extreme stage fright. Later, she mustn't have realized how big "Dynasty" would become, because in 1981 she turned down playing Alexis Carrington Colby, which went to **Joan Collins** and made her a major international television star.

Zac Efron, who recently lent his voice to "Scoob!" (as in Scooby-Doo), with Mark Wahlberg, Will Forte, Tracy Morgan, Ken Jeong, Amanda Seyfried and Gina Rodriguez, has found his next project, the survival thriller "Gold," with Anthony Hayes. They play two strangers traveling through a desert who stumble upon and have to protect the biggest gold nugget ever found. Hope it's a bigger gem than his last film, "Extremely Wicked, Shockingly Evil and Vile"!

Common Myths of Medicaid Crisis Planning

Everyone can be prone to procrastination sometimes! As a result, inevitably, some elders and their families will not have an opportunity to engage in any **Estate Planning** (which includes **Wills** and **Trusts, Powers of Attorney** and **Living Wills**), let alone start any **Advance Asset Protection Planning**. If you or your loved one is in a nursing home or think that you or they may need to go very soon, you must remember that Asset Protection Planning in a crisis (while not the best scenario at that point) is still available. However, you should be aware that the crisis planning outcome is often not as ideal as when pre-planning is done before-hand.

The goal in crisis planning is to preserve and protect as much income and assets as permissible under the law for the benefit of the elder in crisis (and their spouse, if married). One of the challenges of crisis planning is overcoming the false presumption that many elders and their families have that it is too late to engage in Asset Protection Planning.

Below is a list of common myths regarding **Medicaid Planning/Asset Protection** that we are asked about quite often:

(1) "It is too late to do planning": *False!*

It is never too late to preserve and protect assets! Too often, elders and their families believe that they need to spend-down all their money on the nursing home before the elder may qualify for Medicaid benefits. This misconception is why it is crucial to consult with a Certified Elder Law Attorney to see how they can help as soon as possible. One thing to keep in mind is that property must be protected either by a life estate deed or by placing it in the right type of trust, as both methods are subject to the 5 Year look-back period required by Medicaid.

(2) "The nursing home will do your application for free": <u>*False!*</u>

The nursing home may offer to complete the Medicaid application for free or a low fee, but the fact is that the nursing home will require that you spend down all of your savings before they do that application for "free." To be fair, in truth, applying for Medicaid is not a nursing home's function. The outcome

(4) "Medicaid or Asset Protection Planning requires "hiding" assets or engaging in illegal acts": *False!*

No - nothing could be further from the truth! The fact is that a Certified Elder Law Attorney will disclose all planning strategies directly to Medicaid during the application process. The planning is lawful and you have every right to take advantage of your given rights under the law. Just as folks have the right to employ a CPA to save tax dollars, elders have the right to employ attorneys to save and protect their assets in the Medicaid process.

(5) "Planning is unnecessary - the nursing home covers everything": *False!*

By shielding assets and income, we can help ensure that married clients protect their spouse at home against impoverishment. For unmarried clients, the attorney should ensure that they have rainy day funds to supplement their quality of life for the rest of their lives. The fact is that nursing homes do not cover all of the needs of the elder. Those elders and their families in nursing homes who have planned ahead enjoy a much higher quality of life than those who failed to save assets.

(6) "I am already protected because Medicaid won't count the assets in my spouse's name": *False!*

Sadly, no - Medicaid counts assets in <u>both</u> your name and your spouse's name. Likewise, most assets owned jointly with 3rd parties (adult children, for instance) are also fully countable to the elder in the Medicaid planning process. Asset Protection that yields real results requires the advice of a qualified and Certified Elder Law Attorney, as trying to protect assets yourself without the right help can have real repercussions if done incorrectly.

(7) "I have no chance at all of protecting my home from Medicaid": *False!*

Without careful planning, Medicaid can require the sale of your home or record a lien on your home. Depending on the elder's individual circumstances, it is often possible to save the home. We work to prevent a forced sale or prevent a lien where possible. The key here is that you take action toward this as soon as possible.

Many elders and their families seek legal assistance when an elder is hospitalized or already in a nursing home for rehab or long-term care. Sometimes the elder is already paying privately from their own savings for nursing home care (often more than \$400 per day, which adds up quickly!). They assume wrongly that the elder must spend down their assets on private nursing home costs. With careful planning, private paying to the nursing home can be stopped after a time, protecting assets for the elder's benefit, and qualifying that elder for Medicaid to pay the nursing home costs.

from a nursing home applying for Medicaid is not the same as what can be accomplished by actually working with a Certified Elder Law Attorney!

(3) "I will never qualify for Medicaid – I have too much money": *False!*

You <u>cannot</u> make an informed decision about when or if you might qualify for benefits until after you meet with a Certified Elder Law Attorney. The fact is that every elder deserves to know all of the facts and options before making an informed decision about their long-term care costs!



Warning Signs

As we grow older, some memory difficulties – such as trouble remembering names of people or places or forgetting where you put your glasses or car keys are associated with normal aging. But the symptoms of Alzheimer's disease are much more than simple memory lapses.

Knowing the early warning signs is a good first step in recognizing the difference between typical age-related memory loss and a more serious problem. To help you evaluate your mom's condition, here's a checklist of some common early symptoms to watch for:

Asking the same questions repeatedly. Getting lost in familiar areas. Failing to recognize familiar people. Having difficulty following directions.

Misplaces items in inappropriate places, for example putting her keys in the microwave.


Having difficulty completing familiar tasks like cooking a meal or paying a bill.

Having trouble remembering common words when speaking or mixing up words.

Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday they provide free, confidential virtual memory screenings done via video chat in real time. Your mother will need a phone, tablet or computer with a webcam and internet capability to complete the screening.

The screenings are given by healthcare professionals and take about 10 to 15 minutes to complete. Once the screening is complete, the screener will review the results with her and let her know if she should see a doctor for further evaluation. To set up a memory screening for your mom call 866-232-8484 and make an appointment.

If you find that your mom does need further evaluation, make an appointment with her primary care doctor for a cognitive checkup and medical examination. Depending on what's found, she may be referred to a geriatrician or neurologist who specializes in diagnosing and treating memory loss or Alzheimer's disease.

Keep in mind that even if your mom is experiencing some memory problems, it doesn't necessarily mean she has early-stage Alzheimer's. Many memory problems are brought on by other factors like stress, depression, thyroid disease, side effects of medications, sleep disorders, vitamin deficiencies and other medical conditions. And by treating these conditions she can reduce or eliminate the problem.

Using the Internet to Enrich Our Lives

With most of us spending most of our days at home, it's time for us to take advantage of the internet. Here are some resources that can enrich our lives.

Inquire at the local senior center about any exercise classes online. Some classes will be live on Zoom and others will be videos that the instructors record and post on the center's website. If they're not hosting any classes, search online for "seniors exercise at home" and look for some that are produced by other senior centers.

Virtual art classes can open up new areas of interest and reveal talents you didn't know you had. Better yet, if you're a beginner or are exploring a new art medium, look for videos that you can review over and over. Look online for free art classes online for seniors. Exercise and art aren't the only free classes you'll find online. Yoga and tai chi, sewing, baking and cake decorating, creative writing, a new language -- if it can be done online, there's a class for it somewhere. And don't forget Class Central (www.classcentral.com). Check the website for a list of MOOCS (massive open online courses). There 15,000 different free and low-cost classes in its searchable database from colleges and universities around the world. Read the details for any class you're considering.
