## New owners have big visions for Butler Building in Aitkin

The historic Aitkin landmark currently known as the Butler Building has new local owners.

Dwight Marwede and Christine Bright Marwede of Aitkin purchased the building from Sylvia Allen on Nov. 4, and are exploring plans to revitalize and once again make the historic building a regional destination.

"The building has been at the heart of Aitkin for generations. Christine and I are proud and humbled to carry on and build upon its tradition," Dwight Marwede said. "We are fully committed to an inclusive vision that will strengthen the community through business, food, the arts, and culture."

The couple, in partnership with the Aitkin County Friends of the Arts, plan to commission a feasibility study to explore possibilities for the new Butler Building. After the completion of the feasibility study, finalized plans for their vision are expected to be announced sometime in the new year.

Short-term plans for the building include the continuation and expansion of the Farmer's Market through the winter. There are no plans now or in the future to displace any current tenants in the building, Bright Marwede said.

Dwight and Christine both have a long connection and passion for the performing

arts that began in childhood.

Dwight Marwede was born in New York City, grew up in Cincinnati where his appreciation and love for music theater and the arts was fostered by his parents who were involved in community theater as performers and behind-the-scenes crew. During high school, Dwight played the drums in the band and in local musicals. He is the Di-

rector for Technical Services for North American Roofing, a nationwide installer of commercial and industrial roofing systems.

Christine was born and raised in Aitkin before moving to Minneapolis to go to college. Like Dwight, she has always had an appreciation for music and the arts, including participating in band and choir in high school,

playing organ at her church, and minoring in Art History at Augsburg College with an emphasis on architecture.

She is an attorney and owner of Haberkorn Law Offices in Aitkin, and is currently the chair of the Aitkin County Friends of the Arts. She is also on the governing board of Riverwood Hospital, serves on several committees at First

## Aitkin man charged for alleged attempted murder of father



A 32-year-old Aitkin man has been charged with second-degree attempted murder for allegedly attempting to kill his father.

On November 6, 2020, Aitkin County Dispatch re-

ceived a call from a woman reporting she had received a call from her son, Andrew Riley O'Neil, telling her he had just killed his dad and was on the way to get her.

Deputies, familiar with O'Neil from previous incidents, responded to the father's residence. En route O'Neil was located near a stalled vehicle on Highway 47, displaying assaultive behavior toward a woman who stopped to help him.

O'Neil was immediately arrested. Before to his arrest O'Neil told a deputy that he had pointed the gun at his father and pulled the trigger four times, but the gun never

went off.

On December 7, 2020, an amended complaint was issued in Aitkin County District Court charging O'Neil with Second-Degree Felony Attempted Murder, Felony Felon in Possession of Firearm, Felony Felon in Possession of Ammunition, Second-Degree Felony Assault with Dangerous Weapon, Felony Threats of Violence, Felony Unauthorized Use of Motor Vehicle, First Degree Felony Criminal Damage to Property, along with four misdemeanor charges. O'Neil has remained in custody since his arrest, the Aitkin County Sheriff's office reported.

# Big Al’s Bar and Grill fundraises for Iron Range Coffee House moving fund

Big Al’s Bar and Grill, seven miles south of Emily on Hwy. 6, had a great first three years in business. Their smoked meat was popular and they were hosting concerts and other events.

They were just ready to start turning a profit when the pandemic, and shut-downs, hit. Since then, Al Brenycz has lost \$200,000 and is subsisting by living in an apartment above his restaurant.

In order to help his neighbors, he decided to throw a benefit for Thor and Candy Freeburg. The Freeburgs have operated a coffee shop, The Iron Range Coffee House (in the former Silver Creek Traders building in downtown Emily) for a couple of years.

“Their scones are phenomenal, their breakfast sandwiches are killer and their coffee is better than the major brands. I am a customer every day and get five-to-six shots of espresso with steamed milk and caramel,” said Brenycz.

The building was sold to a new owner and negotiations didn’t work out to continue the lease. So, the Freeburgs have a short time to find a new home for their coffee shop.

“They work hard and I’ve seen it. I am a customer every day. When you own a small business up here, you work hard seven days a week.”

The Freeburgs had plans to expand into coffee roasting for regional sales, he said.

Al’s donated and bought food for the benefit dinner held on Saturday, December 5. It was supposed to run from 5-7 p.m. — but they sold out of food.

“They were lined up before 5 and we ran out of food in 30 minutes,” he said.

Al, his cook and volunteers, prepared 100 pounds of pasta, nearly 100 quarts of sauce, 70 pounds of Italian sausage and 50 pounds of meatballs. He got up at 4 a.m. to make the sauce and stirred it every 15 minutes.

They ran out of pasta first and customers purchased partial meals until all the food was gone. “This will give Thor and Candy a boost to get them started and I advise folks to donate on their go fund me page.”

Al is very discouraged but isn’t ready to give up. He turned 50 in September and has cashed in all his chips to keep his restaurant afloat. Government programs haven’t helped as much as they are reported to have done.

“My bar is as clean as an operating room, but I’m declared unsafe,” he said. He recently invested \$15,000 in his kitchen and has a marvelous pizza oven. “I will be serving pizza once a month but otherwise we are shut down till spring. I’ll probably have to get a job to pay for propane to keep the place heated. In Minnesota, we have lost 7,000 restaurants since the pandemic hit and 800 small businesses a day are going under in the United States.”

#### About the Butler Building

The building, originally called the Aitkin Opera House Building, was built in 1903 by Samuel Hodgeden to be the cultural center of the community. Construction included bricks made in Aitkin from Mississippi mud and fired locally. Aitkin’s Opera House Building housed a general merchandise store, bank, barber shop, hardware store, seed & feed warehouse, buggy and wagon shop, bath house, and the opera house. The building has had many names and tenants over the years.
