IS ENTRAPMENT A REALISTIC DEFENSE?

Proving entrapment is a lot more complicated than simply showing that an undercover police officer offered you the opportunity or mislead you into doing something illegal. Even enticement is not entrapment. In order to qualify for entrapment, an officer or government agent must persuade a person to commit a crime he or she had no intention of committing and would not likely commit without the officer/agent's influence. Along with police officers and agents from the FBI, CIA, NSA, or any other law enforcement agencies, government agents can include anyone, even a civilian, that is working on behalf of the government, such as informants and those who have made immunity agreements in exchange for their involvement.

Whether the actions of the police qualify as entrapment will depend heavily on the facts of any given situation, as well as the standard that is used in the case. If you are charged with a crime, contact an attorney immediately. If you think you might have an entrapment defense or any other defense, you'll need a competent attorney who understands the law regarding such defenses. **Please call the Law Office of MACK & PACE at (585)798-1000.** We emphasize criminal law, family law, estate planning, and business law.

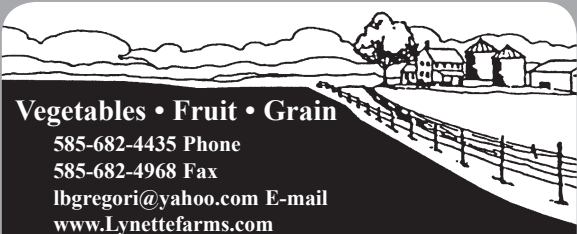

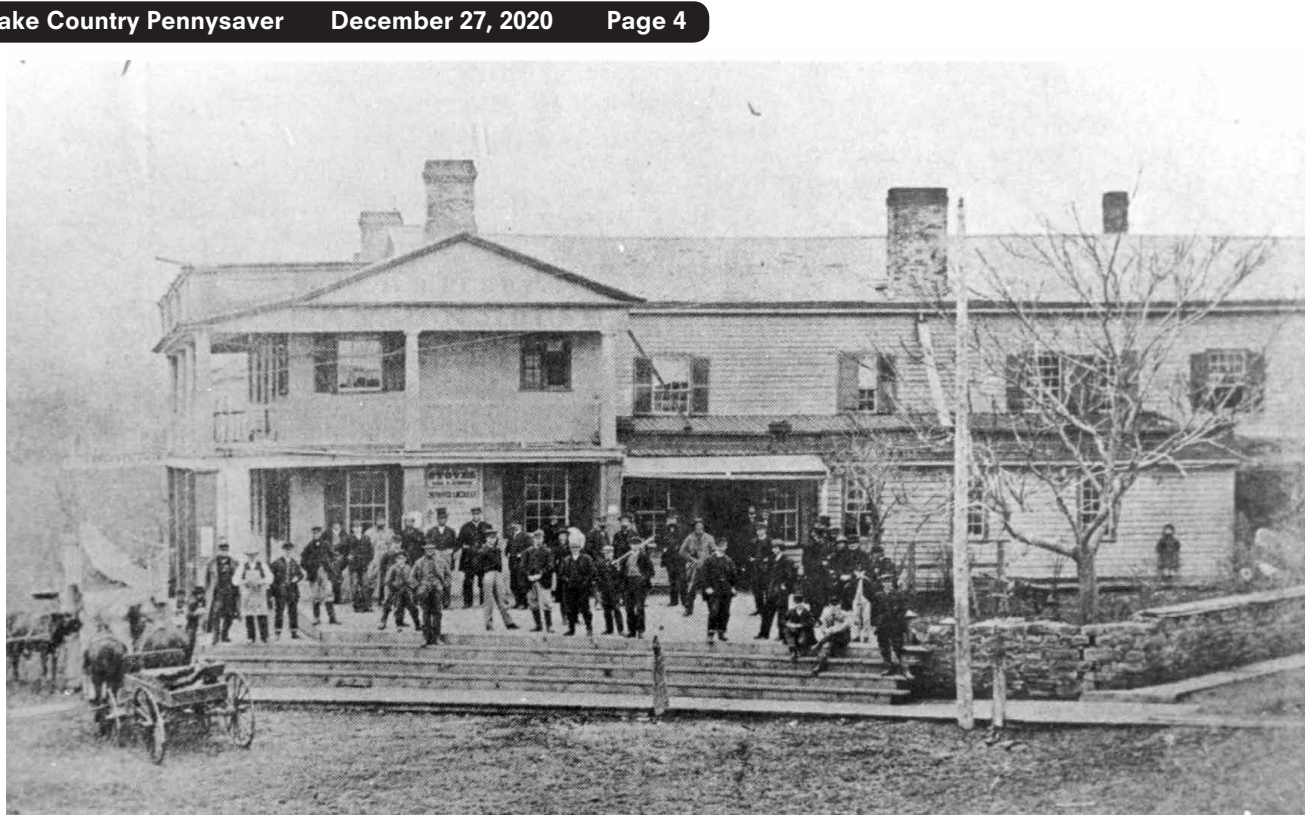

Samuel, Henry, and Burrall Spencer operated the distillery under the direction of their father, Zachariah Spencer, who operated the cobblestone inn located nearby. The business was later purchased by John B. Lee and subsequently referred to as Lee's Distillery. Early distilleries provided farmers with an alternative market for grain, particularly in the infancy of the Erie Canal.

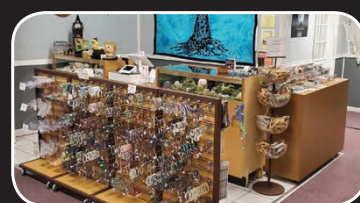

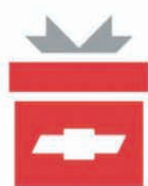

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

Best Bets for Nighttime Snacking

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Weight Control Information Network says that a calorie is a calorie no matter when it is consumed. That means it doesn't matter if calories are consumed in the morning, afternoon or evening. It is how many are consumed and the amount of physical activity individuals perform that will affect their weights. Conversely, the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics says they're not sure if a calorie is a calorie no matter when it is consumed. Their research and data from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine's Center for Weight and Eating Disorders indicates that when food is consumed late at night the body is more likely to store those calories as fat and gain weight rather than burn it off as energy.

But what is a person to do when hunger pangs hit at night and one fears that their rumbling stomach may interrupt their sleep? According to the nutrition and fitness experts at MyFitnessPal, tick to a snack that is between 100 and 200 calories. Choose a food that is high in protein, fiber or healthy fats. Apples and peanut butter, string cheese and fruit, or whole grain crackers and Greek yogurt can be healthy, satisfying nighttime snacks. Avoid sugary, calorie-dense foods, which may be hard to digest and can compromise sleep quality.

More studies may be necessary to determine the relationship between body weight and snacking at night. In the meantime, nighttime snackers should choose healthy foods when reaching for a late night bite to eat. ■

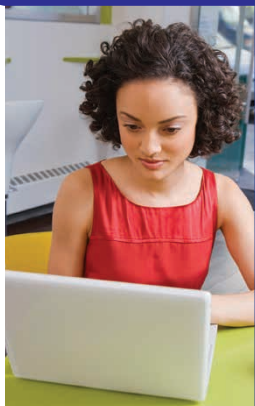

SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1** Ask the person to **SMILE**.
- 2** Ask the person to **TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- 3** Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.
- 4** Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking**, **dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause

Exxon Mobil Education Grant**

The Royalton-Hartland Elementary School is getting closer to their goal of an outdoor classroom space at their site. Thanks to the generosity of Exxon Mobil's Educational Alliance, they received a grant for \$500. The Crosby-Reid Petroleum Company decided to match the grant and added an additional \$500 for the school.

The Exxon Mobil Education Alliance is a national program that funds math and science programs at schools in need. It is part of their ongoing effort to support science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) education. Their hope is that their partnership with Royalton-Hartland Central School District will give students the tools and technology they need to connect what they learn in the classroom with what they see in the real world and create "Aha" moments.

Jessica Monaco and Susan McLaughlin are the two teachers at the school who are spearheading the outdoor learning spaces. "We are trying to extend what we did at the playground," explains Ms. Monaco. "As educators we thought it would be nice to give students the opportunity to learn science by interacting with the natural world on campus." "We also wanted our campus to have a beautiful natural setting and more space for the community to enjoy things like a walking trail and stage," adds Ms. McLaughlin.

Thanks from input from their fellow teachers, administration and the community there are several proposals for their vision of their outdoor space which is broken into nine quadrants. Area 1 would be a pollinator garden that will contain an insect hotel and a bluebird house. Area 2 will contain a sundial, an elevated sand table, talking tubes, solar shields and chalkboard flowers. Sycamore and tulip trees will be planted in Area 3. A greenhouse and mini orchard containing apple, peach, pear and cherry trees will occupy the space of Area 4. Area 5 will be the designated graduation garden and have a tree planted by the kindergarten class of that year and also contain willow domes. Raised beds, a shed, rain collection barrels and compost stations will populate Area 6. A Trim Trail will take up Area 7, which is the old playground. Area 8 will give students a chance to tap into their creative side with an outdoor stage and moveable seating. The final area, number 9, will contain vertical gardens.

When the district was told that they were receiving monies from Exxon and Mobil and Crosby-Reid they were thrilled. "I thought it was amazing," says Ms. McLaughlin. "This will help us fulfill so many plans." Ms. Monaco says, "It means a lot to everyone that we have the community's support for this venture. We think this will be a great space for everyone to enjoy." Dr. Hank Stopinski, the District's Superintendent, adds, "This is what Royalton-Hartland is all about; community." "This is very exciting," says Principal Donna VanSlyke. It is very generous and to think we now have \$1000 dollars, we can do almost everything we were hoping to accomplish. We are very thankful to Exxon Mobil and Crosby's for this gift."

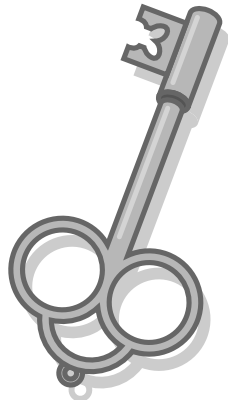

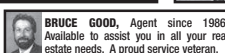

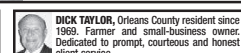

The right way to leave a job

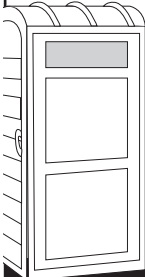

On November 3, 2020, New York State Trooper Scott Gregson was handling an incident in the Security Office of the Walmart Super Center in Albion, N.Y. Trooper Gregson was in the process of conducting interviews when a 77 year old male slowly sat down, leaned over face first and grabbed his chest. In November, Sheriff Christopher M. Bourke presented Trooper Gregson and Sheriff's Investigator Kevin Colonna with the Sheriff's "LifeSaver" award.

On November 16th, 2020, At the December Legislature meeting, The Orleans County Legislature acknowledged the great work of these two Law enforcement Officers and read into the record the details surrounding the LifeSaver Award from the Sheriff.

The quick decisive actions of Trooper Gregson and Sheriff's Investigator Kevin Colonna on November 3rd, 2020, without doubt, saved the life of another human being. The seamless coordination and quick response by these Law Enforcement officers serves to exemplify the great working relationship that exists between the New York State Police and the Orleans County Sheriff's Office.
