

Heritage Wind Project Orleans County, New York NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF 94-C TRANSFER APPLICATION

Heritage Wind, LLC ("Heritage" or "Applicant") will be transferring its Application to construct a major wind electric generating facility from Article 10 of the New York Public Service Law to the Office of Renewable Energy Siting (the "Office") pursuant to Section 94-c of the New York State Executive Law. This notice announces that on or about January 4, 2021, the Applicant will file a Transfer Application pursuant to 19 NYCRR 900-3.2 seeking a Permit from the Office authorizing the construction and operation of the Facility. Upon the filing of the Transfer Application, the Transfer Application shall be complete in accordance with Section 94-c on the basis that the Application was deemed complete under Article 10.

The Facility is a proposed wind-powered electric generation project consisting of up to 33 wind turbines generating up to 184.8 megawatts (MW) of electricity to be located in the Town of Barre, Orleans County. The Facility will include wind turbines, access roads, electrical collection lines, substations, permanent meteorological towers, an operations and maintenance (O&M) building, and staging/laydown areas to be used during construction, which may include a potential temporary concrete batch plant. A point of interconnection substation will be placed in the Town of Barre, along the existing National Grid Lockport-Mortimer 115 kV power line, to deliver electricity generated by the Facility to the New York State electric grid.

The Facility is a zero-emission wind energy facility that will assist the State in meeting the goals of the Climate Leadership and Protection Act and State Energy Plan, which includes obtaining 70% of energy generation from renewable sources by 2030 and significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Other positive impacts of the Facility include diversification of energy supplies, new employment opportunities (both temporary construction employment and full-time jobs), and increased revenues to County and local tax bases, purchase of local supplies, goods and services. In addition, the Applicant has attempted to minimize impacts to land associated with the Facility by limiting the disturbance to forested lands and wetlands to the maximum extent practicable. However, the construction and operation of the Facility may result in some environmental impacts as more fully described in the Transfer Application, including, but not limited to: impacts on terrestrial ecology, including avian and bat species; minor impacts to forested land, wetlands and agricultural lands; and impacts to people. including noise, traffic and visual impacts.

Savannah was established in the mid-1700s with the intent to provide a buffer zone between the Spanish pushing northward from Florida and the English colony of South Carolina. The squares were uniquely designed to give Savannah a strong military advantage and are now lovely parks and memorials to the rich history. James Edward Oglethorpe started the colony with four squares

and, by 1851, it grew to twenty-four squares with twenty-two remaining, today. The city is truly a walker's dream...and a history buff's idea of heaven



Colonial Park Cemetery is an eerie walk back in history – a must see when visiting Savannah.

During our days in Savannah, we learned a lot about the wonderful history. The gorgeous mansions, the cotton exchange, the monuments, the shops, the industry, and so much more filled us with wonder and awe. Each square is a block with a beautiful park in the center and the mansions or shops or whatever surrounding it. The City Market is amazing. It is in the middle of the city, but feels much more like a park. In fact, we really didn't feel like we were in a city anywhere we went. We may have crammed a lot into a few days, but it was such a lovely, relaxing time that we hardly noticed until we looked back on all we accomplished.

My very favorite part of Savannah is the Riverfront district. The buildings are old and the streets are cobblestone with trolley rails and the river views are stunning. There are some really great shops and restaurants, but the main attractions are the monuments and memorials along the edge of the river. Among them is one called "The Waving Girl", honoring Florence Martus.

Florence waved a handkerchief by day and a lantern by night at all the ships entering and leaving the port of Savannah from the porch of her home on Elba Island. It is said that she never missed waving at a single ship between 1887 and 1931.


