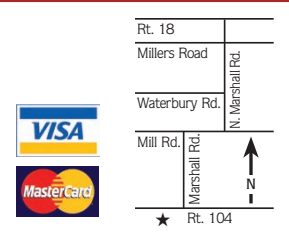

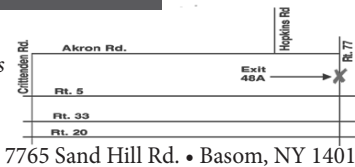

Art Teacher Works With Buffalo Bills on "My Cause, My Cleats"

Orleans/Niagara BOCES Art teacher Tom O'Brien is known for working on murals and public art in the Buffalo area. Over the past few years he has also been working with the Buffalo Bills for the "My Cause, My Cleats" charitable campaign in the NFL. "I had an artist friend of mine approach me to see if I wanted to work with some of the players on the designs. I started out working with Robert Woods and then the following year I worked with Josh Allen and some of the other players. I also work with the coaches and their wives. It's a lot of fun collaborating with them and I am humbled that they allow me to part of it."

"My Cause, My Cleats" is in an initiative in which players design cleats to support a charitable cause of their choosing. The cleats are then auctioned off, with proceeds going to that charity.

O'Brien says he has gotten to hang out with the players or the coaches in the locker room during the practices or would have lunch with them to discuss ideas for their cleats. Now of course, Zoom calls are the norm. "They will meet with me two to three days and we exchange ideas about what their cause is and I try to use my skills to give them what they want." Asked about the fantastic season they are having, he says it is hard not to be a fan boy. "I have so much respect for them as people and of course I am so proud of them and the year they are having. I have to thank them for all they do for the community and the causes they highlight. They are a wonderful group of people. I am very proud to be part of the Bills Mafia."

Mr. O'Brien also has his own fans; his students at the Orleans Learning Center and Newfane Learning Center. "I love being a teacher and working with these kids," he says. "I work with a great group of educators and I am really happy to be working at Orleans/Niagara BOCES."



CREATING A NONPROFIT

Setting up a nonprofit organization may seem daunting, but if you break it down into steps and seek appropriate legal advice, it can be an attainable, as well as worthwhile, goal. First, you'll need to find a name for your organization to use for the next step, which is to file "articles of incorporation" at your state's corporate filing office. Next, you will need to file for both state and federal tax-exempt status. Once you have done that, it's time to draft your organization's bylaws, appoint a board of directors, and hold a meeting at which they will adopt those bylaws. Finally, you'll need to make sure you have all licenses and permits required by your state and federal governments.

Running a nonprofit corporation is a lot like running a for-profit corporation. When you are running a nonprofit corporation, you must maintain an eye for details and keep accurate records. For example, meetings for the directors and members must be held and minutes of the meetings must be recorded for the records book. The nonprofit must ensure that its activities do not personally benefit its members, officers or directors. Loaded Baked Potato Soup

Makes 6 servings



- 6 slices thick bacon, coarsely chopped
- 1 yellow onion, diced
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 2 pounds Hannah sweet potatoes, peeled and diced
- 10 ounces cauliflower, cut into florets
- 4 1/2 cups chicken bone broth
- 1 cup cashew milk
- 3 1/2 teaspoons fine sea salt
- 1/2 teaspoon smoked paprika
- 1/2 teaspoon apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly squeezed lemon juice
- Chopped fresh chives, for serving (optional)
- Dairy-free sour cream (optional)

Line a plate with paper towels. In a stockpot, cook the bacon over medium heat until the fat is rendered and the bacon is crisp, about 8 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, remove the bacon from the pot and set it on the prepared plate to drain. Pour off most of the grease, reserving about 2 tablespoons in the pot.

Return the pot to medium-high heat, add the onion and garlic, and sauté for 2 minutes, until fragrant. Add half of the sweet potatoes and all of the cauliflower and cook for 5 minutes, stirring frequently. Add the bone broth, bring it to a gentle boil, and cook for 10 minutes, until the potatoes and cauliflower are tender.

Using an immersion blender, or working in batches in a blender, blend the soup until smooth. (If using a blender, remove the cap in the blender top and place a kitchen towel over the top to allow steam from the hot liquid to release while you blend.) Return the purée to the stockpot. Add the remaining sweet potatoes, the cashew milk, salt, paprika, vinegar, and lemon juice. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat, then turn the heat to low and simmer for 12 to 15 minutes, stirring frequently, until the sweet potatoes are tender and the cashew milk has thickened the soup.

Ladle the soup into bowls and top with the reserved bacon, chives, and dollop of sour cream. Serve immediately.

Store leftover soup in an airtight container in the refrigerator for 5 days, or in the freezer for 6 months. Defrost overnight in the refrigerator. Reheat in a saucepan over medium heat, stirring frequently, for 10 minutes. ■
