APAP Announces Winter Games Schedule of Activities

Arnolds Park Amusement Park announced its Winter Games schedule of activities with Human Foosball, Food Trucks, 3

concerts, and the Okoboji Kite Festival headlining the event. The Winter Games weekend at the park facilities starts on Thursday night with the Iowa Rock and Roll Music Association hosting The Mr. V Trio & The Iowa Rock 'N Roll All-Stars with music of the Buddy



Holly/Ritchie Valens/Big Bopper era.

On Friday, the Okoboji Kite Festival returns for another year, sponsored by Eagle Construction and Kozy Heat. Friday has kite flyers from all around the world getting in a practice day on West Lake Okoboji flying giant kites. The pilots will be flying Friday, Saturday and into Sunday. "The site over Okoboji with all of these kites in the air is unbelievable" said kite festival coordinator Steve Boote. "It is worth the trip to the area just to view this magnificent display alone" continued Boote. Friday evening at the park concludes in the Roof Garden Ballroom with Thunderstruck – an AC/DC tribute band. Seating for all of the concerts will be socially distanced and limited to 300 attendees to keep everyone safe. Face coverings will be required when not seated and any state or federal COVID mandates in place at the time will be followed.

Saturday has a full slate of activities to enjoy. Snowga, Yoga in the snow sponsored by Yoga Okoboji, starts at 8:00am. A 5K fun run sponsored by EXIT Realty Midwest starts at 9:00. Human Foosball will take place on Preservation Plaza for the second year in a row at 9:00am. The Arnolds Park Museum will host a vintage pinball tournament starting at 10:00am.

The Majestic Pavilion will host Boon & Lambert from 11:00-1:00 and 3:00-6:00. From 1:00-3:00 The HAPI Feud Game Show tourney will take place with teams competing in a Family Feud like game show on stage. Food trucks will be out in front of the Pavilion and tables will be set up in the Pavilion from 11:00-6:00 where guests can enjoy their food and get warmed up.

A new event this year on Preservation Plaza sponsored by F45 Training is the Snowball Fights starting at 1:00pm. Other things happening on the Plaza include games, a courtyard area with firepits, and burning of the greens, sponsored by Bank Midwest at 6:30. The popular Polar Plunge sponsored by Great Lakes GM Toyota takes place in front of the park property at 3:00pm.

After the burning of the greens The Pork Tornadoes take the stage in the Roof Garden Ballroom, sponsored by C & B Operations. "We are excited to be a part of the University of Okoboji Winter Games activities" said park CEO Jeff Vierkant. "We have added a number of exciting activities over the past few years and are grateful to the Iowa Great Lakes Chamber of Commerce, the Okoboji Kite Festival and all of our partners for this year's events" Vierkant continued.

Bargfrede Named to President's List



Newbrough Receives Veteran's Quilt

A couple of weeks ago Donald "Red" Newbrough was presented with a quilt from "Quilts for Standown", a quilters group based out of Ringsted Iowa. These great quilters make quilts for veterans and their families to show them an appreciation for their sacrifice and service to our country.

Mr. Newbrough enlisted in the Navy in 1951, during the Korean War. He did his basic training in Waukegan, Illinois, and then went for further training in radio and Morse code in San Diego, California. He was aboard the USS George Clymner AP-27 attack transport around Japan and Korea for the first year. He then was sent to northern California where he received further training in teletype repair and other communications equipment He then spent the rest of his service in the Philippine Islands.

Presenting the quilt to Red was Department Commander James Kessler of The American Legion Department of Iowa and board member of the Dickinson County Veterans Service Office. There to help present the quilt were Andy and Connie (Red's daughter) Clark.

In 2013 she was awarded the Champion for Children Award from South Dakota Voices for Children and was the recipient of the inaugural Sioux Falls Stage Award of Excellence, 2020, for her years advocating for the Arts. Sara is a licensed clinical social worker and lives in Sioux Falls.



2 1/2 cups vegetable broth 1 tablespoon olive oil 8 ounces whole wheat rotini 14 1/2 ounces no salt added diced

tomatoes, undrained 1 yellow onion, thinly sliced 1 cup fresh sliced mushrooms

1 1/2 teaspoons mineed garlie, about 3 cloves 1 42 teaspoons dried basil

1 1/2 teaspoons dried oregano 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper 15 ounces cannellini beans,

drained & rinsed 4 cups fresh spinach

42 cup shredded Parmesan cheese

In a large pot, combine vegetable broth, olive oil, rotini, undrained tomatoes, sliced onion, sliced mushrooms, garlic, basil, oregano and black pepper. Cover and bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat to

medium and simmer, covered for 8-10 minutes, gently stirring every few minutes so pasta doesn't stick together. When pasta is nearly al dente. remove the lid and stir in cannellini beans and the fresh spinach. Cover and continue

to cook for 3-4 minutes more, until spinach is wilted. Serve topped with Parmesan cheese.




41st UofO Winter Games should warm things up!

Thursday night (January 28th) will kick off with a Roof Garden Jam — the music of the Buddy Holly / Ritchie Valens / Big Bopper Era — starting at 6:00, in the Roof Garden. Friday, the 29th, will follow with Thunderstruck, America's AC/DC Tribute Band, also in the Roof Garden, but starting at 7:30. And Saturday will see live music around the noon hour, with the live sounds of Boon and Lambert in the Majestic Pavilion, from 11 - 1:00, then again, from 3 - 6:00, when the Majestic Pavilion will host the HAPI Feud Game Show tourney for the entire family to enjoy.

In addition to the concerts at Arnolds Park, all three days and nights are expected to see live entertainment at places like The Gardens, Nautical Okoboji Bar & Grill, Portside Pizza Pub, The Barefoot Bar, The Fish Shack, Parks Marina Boat Club, and The Ritz...

This weekend the Little Swan Lake Winery will be featuring the *Beyond Blue* Duet on the stage in the barn, Sunday afternoon, from 4-6:00. The following Sunday, Storm Rising will be the closing act for the Winter Games — on the same stage in the barn, just north of Superior...

With all the recent discussion about can and bottle recycling in Iowa, it had to be someone from Minnesota who discovered that today is Tin Can Day. And our very own research director, RD-a proud Redwood Falls, Minnesota native — has again come up with a "no brainer" of a song. You've probably already guessed that RD is talking today about the witless Straw Man portrayed by Ray Bolger in the 1939 Wizard of Oz motion picture. Bolger sang If I Only Had a Brain with then 17-year-old Judy Garland... The song was written by Harold Arlen, and lyrics by Yip Harburg, with other anatomical references as well, including a heart, and a nerve used...

Wednesday is Penguin Awareness Day. While you probably have very few Penguins in your backyard feeders, cartoonists Paul Smith and Tex Avery created Chilly Willy, the diminutive penguin in cartoon form, for the Walter Lantz Studios in 1953. Chilly Willy is the second most popular Lantz/ Universal character — behind only Woody Woodpecker. Fifty *Chilly Willy* cartoons were produced between 1953 and 1972. Every one of them opened with his aptly-named theme song, *I'm Chilly Willy The Penguin*, written by

The Beatles second album, Meet the Beatles, was released on the Capitol label in the United States on January 19, 1964, including some of The Fab Fours' most famous hits, I Want to Hold Your Hand, All My Loving, and the only song on the album not credited to a member of the group — 'til There Was You - from Meredith Willson's 1957 Broadway musical production and 1962 musical motion picture, *The Music Man...* Now you know the rest of that story!

The second passage is even more compelling: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay. In due time their foot will slip; their day of disaster is near and their doom rushes upon them". Both sides of the aisle need to take heed, as each has acted in a less than laudable manner.



Local Musician Awarded Iowa Arts Council Grant

Local musician Gary Lambert has been awarded funding through the Iowa Arts and Culture Recovery Program, administered by the Iowa Arts Council, a division of the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs.

A total of 267 cultural organizations and 152 artists serving 118 Iowa communities submitted requests totaling more than \$37 million. Governor Kim Reynolds allocated \$7 million in the state's share of federal CARES funds to assist Iowa arts and cultural organizations, business and individual artists whose operations were impacted by the pandemic. Lambert was awarded \$2500 to cover eligible revenue loss due to COVID-19 during 2020. He was the only individual artist from Dickinson County. Other organizations from Dickinson County that were awarded funding include: Pearson Lakes Art Center (\$60,300), Historic Arnolds Park, Incorporated (\$41,300), and the Iowa Rock 'n Roll Music Association (\$16,000).

Gary Lambert operates Route 86 Music and has been a musician for over 25 years. He has resided in the Iowa Great Lakes since 2004. During his time here, Lambert has performed in hundreds of concerts and taught music lessons to hundreds of people through private music lessons and 10 years of hosting a summer rock camp. Lambert currently performs in 5 different bands as well as playing for a variety of churches. Lambert also does all the recording for Treasure Village musicals and records local artists under his music label Route 86 Records. He pursues his passion for music when he's not working in special education at Okoboji Schools. Lambert was honored with the Spirit Award by the Iowa Rock & Roll Music Association in 2011.

Private Pesticide Applicator Training and COVID-19

Each winter I conduct about 25 continuing education training sessions for pesticide applicators in the nine northwest Iowa counties I

serve. At these sessions we review the laws that are to be followed, provide hints on safety and personal protective equipment, and discuss Integrated Pest Management (deciding when to not use a pesticide, or when it makes sense to use them). To get a pesticide applicator license in the first place, applicators must pass a test offered by the Iowa Department of Ag and Land Stewardship (IDALS). Applicators can



choose to test every three years to renew their certification or attend a continuing education session each year. Most choose education. In those nine counties in northwest Iowa, I get to educate nearly 2,000 crop producers each winter.

Due to COVID-19, we are not operating under a "business as usual" situation. However, at this time, regulations do still require that pesticide applicators who choose to renew their certification through continuing education must have their annual requirement completed before April 15. Iowa State University Extension and Outreach staff recognize that there are some people who are not at all concerned with COVID risks right now, many are at least somewhat concerned about potential health risks, and there are people with very significant health issues. We hear the different levels of concern our clients have and are working hard to offer this program in ways that meet the requirements for certification, and still honor client concerns.

How are we doing that? In northwest Iowa during December we started offering live sessions, like what we have done in past years. However, we set up the rooms with six-foot spacings between seats and require masks on participants. Because of that, we must put hard limits on the number of attendees at each site, so pre-registration is required and no "walk-ins" are allowed. This means that a few more meetings than normal are being offered. You can find schedules of upcoming meetings on almost any northwest Iowa Extension office website. We do, however, reserve the right to change this schedule as Iowa meeting guidelines change related to COVID.

Many offices are also offering a chance to schedule a time for individuals or small group to watch a pre-recorded video of the private pesticide continuing education meeting, for those uncomfortable with attending a site with a lot of people. These office personnel deal with a wide array of programming daily, so please allow scheduling flexibility if you choose this option.

Some of our clients feel that the risk of even watching a video in an Extension office is higher than they are willing to take. One option that ISU Extension and Outreach is developing is a state-wide, online session that could be watched from your own home, on your own computer. Starting on February 11, there are two of these scheduled per month through early April. There is a requirement that we can prove you are participating, so we cannot offer this as something available upon demand at any time. If you would like to choose this option, contact your local Extension office to get on their list and to get more details. They will require registration and payment in advance for this and will document if you have participated actively before issuing your attendance certificate. Only one person can watch on a computer at a time.

And one final option. The Iowa Department of Ag and Land Stewardship does have an online testing option available for private pesticide applicators during this COVID time period. Since it is online, it would be an open-book test this year - which it isn't during normal testing procedures. To find details on this option, go to this website: https://iowaagriculture.gov/pesticide-bureau.

Applicants Sought For Healthcare Scholarship & Loan Programs

Applications are now being accepted for the Bennie B. and Ernestine F. Shine Scholarship, Adam J. Anderson Scholarship, as well as the Cornwall Loan Program. All programs are designed to help area students pursue healthcare careers.

The Shine scholarship fund, administered by Spencer Hospital, annually awards funds to persons who have completed at least one semester of a nursing or allied health program, such as radiology, therapy programs (respiratory care, speech, physical or occupational), medical technology, laboratory tech, paramedic training, pharmacy, etc. These programs are not intended to fund individuals pursuing a degree in medicine, dentistry, physician assistant or veterinary science. The Anderson scholarship fund, administered by Spencer Hospital, annually awards funds to persons living in the Spencer area to pursue education & training to become certified EMS provider (EMT through Paramedic).

Ben Shine was a long-time trustee of the Spencer Hospital Board. His wife, Ernestine Shine, was active in the hospital auxiliary and served as president of that organization. The Shines recognized the importance of quality health care for their community and were actively involved in maintaining a quality and progressive hospital. One effort toward achieving this goal was the establishment of the Shine Scholarship.

The Ruth Cornwall Loan Program was created by Wilson Cornwall in memory of his wife, Ruth, who had received quality hospital care and later home care from Spencer Hospital during an extended illness. The Cornwall family wished to help local people interested in receiving healthcare education. To accomplish this, a low-interest loan program was created. 118 loans have been granted since 1977. During that time over \$124,825 has been loaned to area people involved in health education programs.

The Adam J. Anderson Scholarship was created by Duane Anderson of Webb and Marcia Anderson Taylor of Spencer in memory of their son Adam who died in January 2001 of cancer. Adam had worked as a volunteer on the Terril ambulance crew after graduating from Iowa Lakes Community College and later took a job as an EMT for Spencer Hospital. According to his mother, Adam's goal was to obtain his paramedic certification and he was accepted into paramedic school in August 2000; however, his illness had progressed so much he was unable to attend. The scholarship is intended to honor Adam's memory and his spirit, and to enable others to fulfill the dream to be of service to others as paramedics.

The application deadline for both the Shine & Anderson Scholarship and Cornwall Loan is March 31, 2021. Recipients will be notified of their award in May. Students interested in applying for the scholarship or loan program should contact Danelle Stumbo, Human Resource Development Director at Spencer Hospital, 712-264-6623.
