



There is a common misconception that the First Amendment protects speech in any place. It does not. Therefore, a private employer may make rules about what is or is not appropriate for discussions at work.

For the most part, when employees are not at work, they are on their time. However, they still represent your company and should behave in a professional manner.

People shouldn't forget that's why they call it work. Someone else is paying for their time and that has consequences.

People can not be fired for having a particular religious belief or national origin. People can be fired for engaging in activities while on the employer's time on the employer's property. Generally speaking, people can be fired for good cause, bad cause or no cause at all but there are certain protected classes that are protected by

The right of an employer to control workplace discussions that they deem inappropriate is protected by law, but this control must be exercised even handedly and an employee should only be fired after a fair

WOW, THESE PAST FEW PANDEMICAL MONTHS HAVE BROUGHT US A TON OF MACINTOSH ISSUES.

Macs comprise only 10% of the computers out there and it feels like we've seen all of them. For the uninitiated, a "Mac" is an expensive

Macintosh computer manufactured by Apple.
It seems that

PCs are seen as tools for PC people but Mac people treat them as if they were

favorite stuffed animals. I'm not judging; I have the same love for some of my gadgets -- just not my computer. I suspect this has much to do with the purchase price of a Mac. They start at

That sounds expensive but it's not 100% fair. When you buy a new Mac, you are getting the top-of-the-line, cutting edge technology and excellent support acknowledged a problem with should you need it during the warranty period. If the postwarranty issues that I discuss

If you're in the market for a new computer, I suggest you not buy a Macintosh--at least not until they get their stuff together and make them remotely affordable to fix. Following are a

\$1,300 and go way up from there. few examples of why I hate Macs and why you shouldn't own one.

> After years of pleading from customers (and a class action lawsuit or two), Apple finally the tiny, thin little cable that runs between the main body of their laptop and the display. Symptoms are that the display backlight continuously or intermittently shows vertical bright areas along the entire bottom of the screen or the display backlight stops working completely (aka, "blank screen").

This problem is prevalent in Macbooks from 2016 - 2018. It is so prevalent that it has a name, "Flexgate." If you have this problem, call Apple and let them fix it for you at no charge. Before this issue was addressed by Apple, we were charging \$600 - \$800 to replace displays. That is a ridiculous amount of money to pay for the repair for just a little cable but that's what the repair requires. On a PC, this would cost \$25 for the part and 10 minutes to repair. My shop would hit you up for \$65 if you can't do it yourself. Speaking of displays, crack a Macbook screen and you'll pay at least \$500 and up to \$900 for a replacement. On a PC, that's typically \$150 - \$350.

If your keyboard stops working, or your cat pulls the keys off a notebook PC keyboard you'll pay about \$100 to \$300

to replace the keyboard. Do the same on a Macbook and pay \$400 - \$500. That's ridiculous.

Don't get me wrong; I love taking your money for these repairs but this just isn't acceptable. I recently had a college-age woman cry when I told her how much it was going to cost to fix her Mac. She gave me the inspiration to write this article. I don't need that kind of drama in my life, nor do you.

You normally get what you pay for but Macs just aren't worth it.

lifesaver for us. Why do you think some people are unwilling to listen to good advice, and make changes in their finances?

Dear Tammi,

Thank you so much for all the kind words. I'm really proud of you two for putting in the effort and hard work that goes along changing your financial behaviors and gaining control of your money.

I think there are several reasons why some folks resist making changes in their lives, even when those changes would make things a whole lot better and easier for them. One of those things is often denial.

My dad used to tell me 90 percent of solving a problem is realizing and admitting a problem exists. I'm convinced that one of the major factors keeping people from winning with money is they don't realize they even have a problem. If you are apathetic because you think things like debt and living paycheck-to-paycheck are okay or just the way things are, you'll be unwilling—or even afraid—to make the big changes necessary to achieve big results. Debt is so ingrained into our culture that most Americans can't envision a car without payment, or college without student loans. We've been sold on the idea of debt so aggressively that most folks don't believe life



without a pile of payments is possible.

Also, change is painful. Most people won't change until the pain of where they are exceeds the pain of change. No matter who you are, where you're at right now financially is, in large part, a sum total of the decisions you've made to this point. If you don't like where you are, you have to acknowledge the fact that things need to change—you need to change.

Finally, there's element of ignorance involved. Don't get me wrong, I don't mean being dumb or stupid. What I'm talking about is a simple lack of good information. The land on which this district rests was part of the 1818 sale by the Cypress Land Company which established the City of Florence. During The Civil War Confederate soldiers constructed breastworks here for the defense of Florence. House construction began in 1907 and thirty-three were built before 1929. This lovely neighborhood contains fine examples of Prairie. Mission, and English Tudor architecture but the Bungalow style dominates. A tour of the district reveals the excellent condition of the homes, the tree-lined streets, and the comfortable life available here. The neighborhood was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1995.

Location: 700 Sherrod Ave, Florence 34.8096°N, 87.6798°W

Just north of the University of North Alabama campus, this area contained Confederate fortifications during the Civil War. Half a century later, the property was sold off and developed into the neighborhood we see today. College Place is the most northern of Florence's ten historic districts.
