

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we begin a word by word study of the United States Constitution as I promised. I wish to first provide a history and some comments regarding how our Constitution came to be.

For generations immigrants have been expected to read and study the Constitution as one of the requirements for citizenship. I do not know whether present day public schools teach the Constitution, but when I was in public school, we were expected to memorize the Preamble.

While many other countries have had multiple constitutions over the centuries, we are still under the same Constitution under which our country was founded. We need to cherish and honor our Constitution and desire to continue to be governed under this Constitution because no nation in the history of the world has continued in its glory and strength for more than 250 years and we are currently in our 245th year.

I pray that we will be the exception. As many Americans challenge various portions of our Constitution, we must defend our Constitution if we wish to continue in a Conservative Constitutional Republic with the freedoms and blessing which we so often take for granted.

Many of our founding fathers considered our Constitution to have been inspired by God. Sharp divisions among the delegates were present and the Convention adjourned for prayer. A much more congenial atmosphere prevailed when the Convention reconvened. George Washington was perhaps the first to use the word miracle in describing the drafting of the Constitution.

In a 1788 letter to Lafayette, he said: "It appears to me, then, little short of a miracle, that the delegates from so many different states (which states you know are also different from each other in their manners, circumstances, and prejudices) should unite in forming a system of national Government, so little liable to well-founded objections."

James Madison wrote in the preface to his notes on the Constitutional Convention: "There never was an assembly of men, charged with a great and arduous trust, who were more pure in their motives, or more exclusively or anxiously devoted to the object committed to them."

Several believed that the Constitution was established "by the hands of wise men whom the Lord raised up unto this very purpose."

Benjamin Franklin stated in these words: "When you assemble a number of men to have the advantage over their joint wisdom, you inevitably assemble with those men, all their prejudices, their passions, their errors of opinion, their local interests, and their selfish views. From such an assembly can a perfect production be expected? It therefore astonishes me, Sir, to find this system approaching so near to perfection as it does. The opinions I have had of its errors, I sacrifice to the public good."

The Declaration of Independence had stated that these

The Declaration of Independence had stated that these truths were "self-evident," that all men "are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable Rights," and that governments are instituted "to secure these Rights." This inspired Constitution was established to provide a practical guarantee of these God-given rights. Several founding fathers referred to the "miracle of Philadelphia, one must therefore add the miracle of ratification."

We need to understand that our Constitution is under attack from both inside and outside our country and that we must stand up as courageous patriots if we wish to continue living in the land of the free and the home of the brave. Lord willing, as we continue our study next week, we will hopefully more fully appreciate our Constitution and the country of which God has provided us.



Federal Supply of COVID-19 Vaccine to Increase

Mount Morris, NY, February 3, 2021 — Yesterday, Governor Cuomo announced that the federal supply of the COVID-19 vaccine will increase over the next three weeks. In particular, private pharmacies in New York State that are charged with prioritizing the 65+ population will receive an additional 10% directly – or approximately 30,000 total doses – from the federal government to supplement the doses allocated to them by New York State.

Because New York State's supply will increase, Governor Cuomo is granting localities the flexibility to add taxi drivers, restaurant workers, and developmentally disabled facilities to the 1b vaccine prioritization group.

According to Livingston County Administrator Ian M. Coyle, "We continue to deal with vaccine supply and demand issues among the already-approved Phase 1a and Phase 1b groups, which include the 65+ population. Until the vaccine supply increases and demand decreases, we cannot – in good conscience – expand the pool of eligible groups."

"As the vaccine rollout continues, we encourage all residents to remain patient and to keep checking our website for updates," stated Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County's Public Health Director. "Please know we will work expeditiously to add other 1b prioritization groups to our list of eligible residents once supply increases."

To determine your eligibility and schedule an appointment at a state-run mass vaccination site, you can visit the 'Am I Eligible' website. You may also call your local health department, pharmacy, doctor, or hospital for additional information and to schedule appointments where vaccines are available.
