In addition to their beautiful buildings and picturesque settings, the award-winning wines available at both locations are top-of-the-line and you'll find something for everyone from the person who enjoys a Cabernet Sauvignon to the Chardonnay-lover in your group.

In addition to the nationally-recognized Grand River Valley wine region, Lake County is also home to several new, must-try breweries as well. **Mentor Brewing Company** announced their opening in 2020 and is serving up brews like the James IIPA Garfield Double IPA and the Lighthouse American Wheat Ale, both nods to well-known Lake County attractions; the James A. Garfield Home in Mentor and the two historic lighthouses in Fairport Harbor. Lake County also welcomed the addition of **The Brew Kettle** as part of the **Great Lakes Mall** transformation and expansion in Mentor. The Brew Kettle started making their award-winning beers at their first location on the west side of Cleveland, and their newest restaurant and brewpub in Mentor is a can't-miss for any craft beer lover. My personal favorites at Brew Kettle are the White Rajah IPA and their Major Lager...their tribute to the greatest sports movie of all time, Major League.

We know beer and wine aren't for everyone, but who doesn't love ice cream!? If you haven't visited our friends at **The Fairport Harbor Creamery** or the brand-new **Kirtland Creamery** then you're missing out! The Kirtland Creamery offers everything you could ever want from ice cream to banana splits and anything in between. The Fairport Harbor Creamery has some of the best ice cream you can find, and if you're feeling a little more adventurous you **MUST** try one of their "boozy" milkshakes like the Ship-Faced or the Life Preserver!

Finally, for folks looking to get outside and try something new there are numerous kayak rental locations in Lake County where you'll be able to explore Lake Erie, the Mentor Lagoons or the Chagrin River. The newest kayaking location is in Eastlake, at Erie Road Park, where the ADA- accessible kayak launch is open from spring through fall. Grab a kayak and head up the Chagrin River to the brand new, **Chagrin Tavern** or down the river to **Trader Jacks** and have a bite to eat and enjoy a cocktail on two of the best outdoor patios in northeast Ohio.

While 2020 is a year we'd all like to forget, it made us appreciate being able to get outside, to try new things and how much we enjoy being able to take a weekend getaway. Find a weekend, or a week, in 2021 to visit Lake County and take advantage of the unique, memorable experiences you won't find anywhere else. 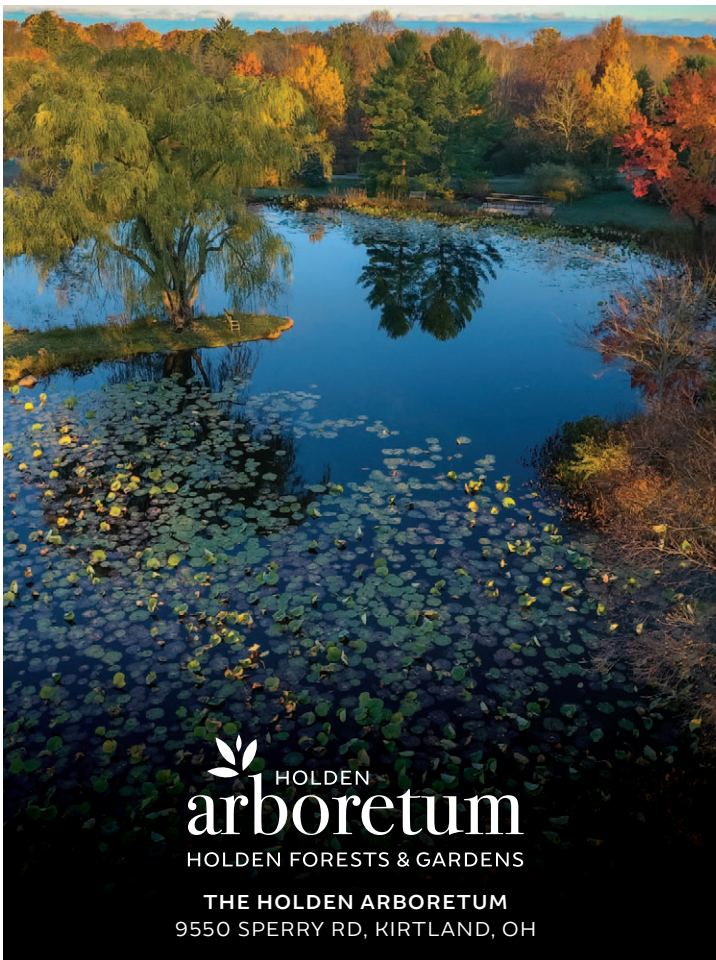
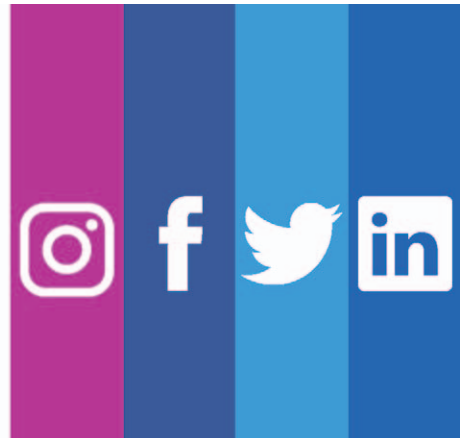

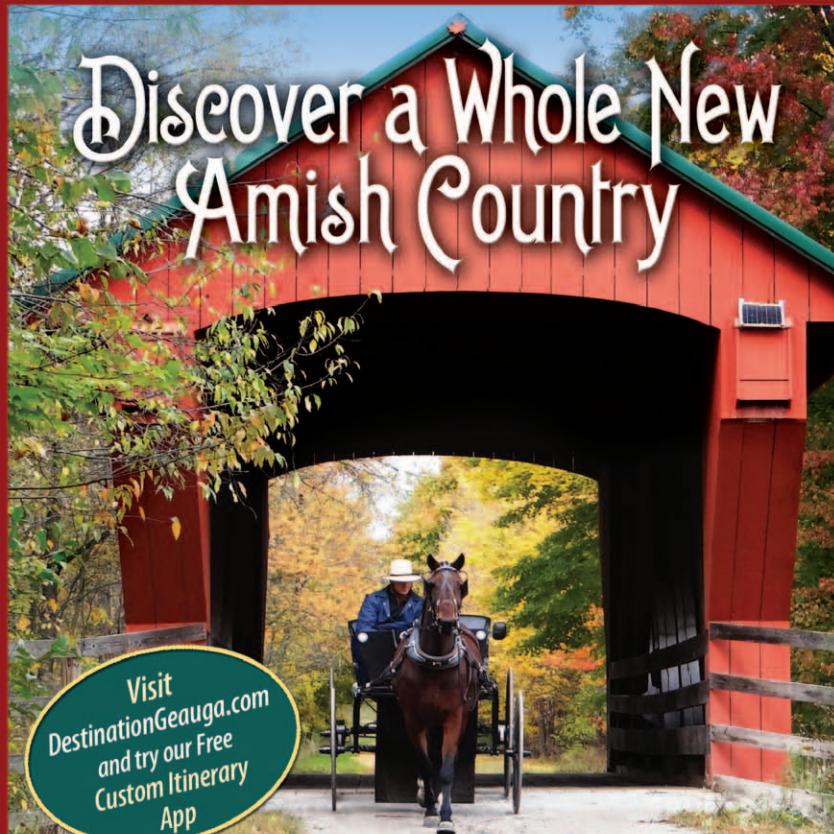

Visit The James A. Garfield National Historic Site and presidential library, one of the state's most popular historical attractions.

Rich national history can be found in Mentor, one of the county's busiest cities. Part of the National Park Service, this site preserves the Lawnfield estate and surrounding property of James Abram Garfield, the 20th President of the United States. Join a guided tour through Garfield's family home, the site of the first established presidential library, or take the cellphone tour around the remaining parts of the 160-acre farm. Stop in the Visitor Center, where visitors can find exhibits and artifacts that illustrate his life

chronologically. Read about Garfield's early life and school days, the Civil War, Washington D.C., the 1880 Republican Convention, and presidency. Also, various artifacts from his funeral can be found in the exhibit area. With so many ways to learn about President Garfield and his family, this site has become one of the most famous historical attractions in the state. The James A. Garfield Historical Site is perfect for a day trip or added onto a weekend adventure.

Located near the shores of Lake Erie in Madison, Rabbit Run Theater is Ohio's premier barn theater, and one of the few barn theaters still in operation. Guests are welcome to bring a picnic dinner to enjoy on the theater's beautiful grounds prior to seeing a performance of many of Broadway's hit shows. A stop at Rabbit Run Theater is the perfect end to a perfect day in Lake County.



Play Ball with the Captains

Classic Park in Eastlake is home to the Cleveland Indians Single A Affiliate, the Lake County Captains. The Captains play 70 home games annually and feature extremely affordable, family-friendly entertainment with easy parking and access. With 20 fireworks shows each season, \$1 beer and hot dog promotions, and Family Fun Sundays the Captains have something for everyone. In addition to promotions for general fans, Classic Park is a terrific place for groups looking to host a unique and memorable event during a game or to rent the facility for a special event on a non-game day. Adjacent to Classic Park is Lake Health Miracle Park featuring a fully ADA accessible playground and specialized baseball field for children with special needs giving every boy and girl the chance to play baseball. The Lubrizol Playground is open year-round with a fully accessible restroom building nearby. The field is used by over 100 special needs boys and girls every Saturday from early June through September



Visit The Holden Arboretum



Locals and visitors alike can not say enough about the 3,500 acres of flora, fauna, trees, and animals at the Holden Arboretum. This local treasure features over 20 miles of trails that take you through impeccable cultivated gardens and native forest. One of the most "remarkable" features is the Murch Canopy Walk, an elevated walkway that takes you 65 feet above the forest floor. Make sure to climb the Kalberer Family Emergent Tower, a wooden tower that rises 120 feet above the forest floor for breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape. If heights are not your thing, the Holden Butterfly Garden is a sight to see. The 20-acre Layer Rhododendron Garden and the 4.5 acre Paine Rhododendron Discovery Garden attracts hummingbirds and butterflies for a whimsical learning experience. Picnic areas are available, and a children's play area will keep the little ones entertained as they reconnect with nature. Tours and guided hikes are available, and you can bring your best friend along (dogs on leashes are permitted), making it the perfect family getaway.



Explore Lake Metroparks

Lake Metroparks is our residents' go-to for all things "outdoor" and "adventure." Bringing in nearly 3.3 million visitors a year, Lake Metroparks carefully conserves 38 diverse parks and more than 60 miles of trails throughout Lake County. Portions of two state-designated wild and scenic rivers and many tributaries flow through Lake Metroparks.

In addition to protecting and maintaining our parks, residents and visitors can also find educational opportunities throughout the year for the entire family, including hiking, birding, boating, biking, and skiing. Lake Metroparks also offers Adaptive Programming that is designed specifically for individuals with special needs.

The Lake Metroparks Farmpark is a family-oriented science and cultural center devoted to agriculture and farming with 235 acres with fields, gardens and farm buildings. Lake Metroparks Farmpark is also home to the premier food and wine event of the year, Vintage Ohio. This annual event is a weekend-long celebration that brings in approximately 11,000 people to sample our region's award-winning wine, partake in food demonstrations, live entertainment, and much more.

Amenities include an accessible harbor view boardwalk, restrooms, changing rooms, shower facilities, picnic area and pavilion with grills, drinking fountain, playground, volleyball court, and a Surf Chair for visitors with mobility challenges. With wooden benches and tables placed along the harbor view boardwalk and parking lot accessibility, visitors can relax and enjoy the view of our remarkable sunsets and historic lighthouse. Lastly, Fairport Harbor Lakefront Park is one of the only beaches on Lake Erie that has a designated dog-swim area so you can bring your best friend along too.

See a Sunset at Headlands Beach State Park

Home of the "Remarkable Sunset," Headlands Beach State Park is the longest natural beach in Ohio and is ranked #1 as Ohio's best beach. The mile-long beach attracts two million visitors a year from the U.S. and Canada. It boasts a mile-long natural sand beach, which is home to many plant species typically found only along the Atlantic Coast. Whether you're a "beach bum" or prefer to hike and explore, Headlands Beach has something for everyone. In the summer you'll find sunbathing spots, swimming and picnic areas, but also parts of the beach in its natural state, including dunes, driftwood and an abundance of wildlife. Seated near the break wall, you'll find our historic lighthouse that can be accessed by both water and walking. Built in 1925, this lighthouse was constructed at the mouth of the Grand River to replace the original Fairport Harbor Lighthouse, which serves as a maritime museum, and sits on a hill in Fairport overlooking the lake. Visitors will find plenty of free parking, restrooms, concession stands, and changing areas for swimmers or sunbathers.

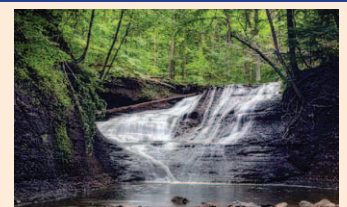

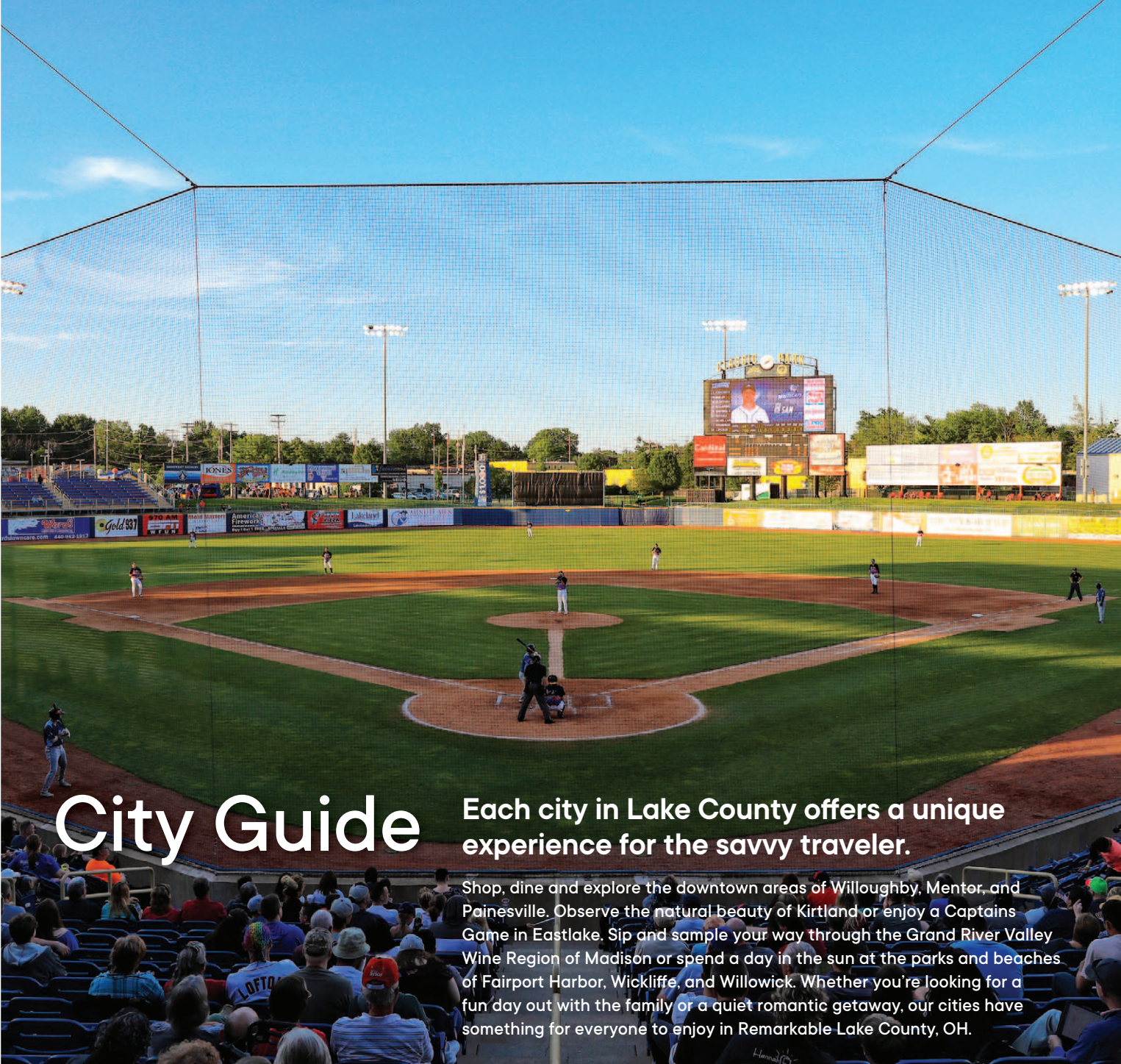

Eastlake: The "Crown Jewel" of Lake County

Eastlake is located 20 miles northeast of Cleveland at the mouth of the Scenic Chagrin River. With several parks, marinas, yacht clubs, and easy access to Lake Erie, Eastlake is a favorite destination for recreational boaters, anglers, and nature lovers. One of Eastlake's most beloved attractions is Classic Park, home of The Lake County Captains minor league baseball team. The team, a Class A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, plays in the Midwest League. The War Dog Memorial honors the dogs that served to

protect our Service People during World War I, World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. Attached to a dog park, its unique location made it the first in the United States, where visitors can bring their dogs and let them run.

Madison: A Picturesque Victorian-era Village

Madison Village is a picturesque Victorian-era village established in 1867 and listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Just three minutes away from three Lake Metroparks, visitors can find camping, hiking, hunting, birding, canoe and kayaking along the state-designated scenic Grand River spanning over 1,300 acres.
