



Be a Tourist in Your Backyard

by Rebecca Peters, Okoboji Tourism Director Each year thousands of people visit the Iowa Great Lakes to enjoy the activities and attractions our area has to offer. Join me each week as I become a tourist in our backyard to explore a few of the spots that make the Iowa Great Lakes special!

This week I visited Okoboji Classic Cars, an incredible experience unique to the Iowa Great Lakes Area! If you've never visited, what are you waiting for? Okoboji Classic Cars is a car dealership featuring cars spanning 100 years. It's a full restoration shop. It's also a paradise for art, history, antique, and car fans!

The moment you walk into Okoboji Classic Cars, you are greeted by friendly staff. Maggie was my guide for the tour. She started by telling me about the restoration shop and paint booth that bakes the paint onto cars at 140 degrees! I could see 4 cars at different stages of restoration being worked on during my visit. Each car that visits the restoration shop goes home with a scrapbook documenting the work done. They had scrapbooks from several cars on display. It's incredible to see pictures of the rusted frames that come in compared to the sparkling works of art that are completed right here in West Okoboji!

After learning a bit about artist Jack Rees' studio and the work he did within the building, it was time to be transported back in time! Currently there are over 90 cars on display within Okoboji Classic Cars. They're parked along "Grand Avenue" in Spencer. Jack Rees hand-painted a 28,000 square foot, floor to ceiling mural that depicts Grand Avenue in Spencer from the 1960s. Over 30 storefronts beckon you take a closer look. They're filled with over 2,000 antiques that are amazing to view on their own. To inspect the storefronts, you get to weave around amazing cars, each with their own unique story.

I love history and art, so this was a real adventure for me! The murals depict sunsets at each "street corner." They're painted to make you feel like time is passing as you walk through the building, with the sun setting, and colors becoming darker and more vibrant as you progress on the tour. It's also fun to learn about the local history of the Iowa Great Lakes and Spencer.

View From The Bench by John Adams, Jr.

February Fran Fade?

After an impressive 12-2 start and a top 5 national ranking, the Iowa Hawkeyes have lost 4 out of 5 games after a tough 67-65 loss at Indiana on Sunday. Iowa, once a contender for The B1G Championship, now finds themselves in sixth place and four games out of first place. While losing to Ohio State at home and at Illinois is certainly nothing to hang your heads about, as both teams are currently in the top 10 nationally, losing twice to a mediocre Indiana team in a two-week span is a head scratcher for this Iowa team. Unfortunately, Iowa fans are used to these late season dips (referred to as the February Fran Fade) under coach Fran McCaffery, who in his 10+ season leading the Hawkeyes has an 80-90 mark after January 15th.

One major reason for this year's slump is the injury to sharp-shooter CJ Fredrick, who was injured in the first Indiana game. Fredrick tried to come back and play in Iowa's win over Michigan State but was only able to log 12 minutes and hasn't played since then. Fredrick averages almost 9 points a game and shoots 50% from 3-point range, and most importantly, helps spread the court so people can't focus as much on Hawkeye big man Luka Garza. It's unclear when Fredrick will be back as the Hawks are as vague about his injury as Iowa State football coach Matt Campbell is about injuries to his team that are normally listed as "day to day". Another reason for the "Fran Fade" is that Iowa is not shooting the ball well, especially in the second half of these games. Over their last five games Iowa was just 16 for 57 (28%) from deep in the second half of those games; Iowa is shooting 38% from the 3-point line for the season so that is a large dip for a team that generally shoots the ball well. In the Indiana loss on Sunday the Hawks hit just 2 of 10 from 3 in the second half. Another concern of mine, earlier in the year, was that the Hawks may not have it defensively. During the last five games, they gave up nearly 80 points per game, and that includes just the 67 to Indiana who was awful from the field during the first 18 minutes of the game. Iowa doesn't have a defensive identity as they struggle guarding man to man, and teams have figured out weak areas in their zone.

I've never been a huge Fran fan as I think he plays too many guys, often mistreats his own media and displays immature antics later emulated on the court. I believe Fran is a fantastic offensive coach, as Iowa's offense is normally among the most efficient in the nation, but defense has always been the Achilles heel of the Hawks, and he does nothing to change that. I also wonder if his teams get sick of his screaming by this time of the year and just get worn out. While his players always seem to have his back and you don't hear negativity about him from former players, one has to wonder with his late season record if that is an issue. This team still has the talent to make a deep run in the NCAA Tournament, but they are running out of time and if they don't figure things out on the defensive end of the court, they will continue to watch their NCAA seed drop like the temperatures in northwest Iowa.









USDA Extends General Signup for Conservation Reserve Program Biden Administration Considers Changes to Bolster Effectiveness of Program and Recommits to Making CRP a Cornerstone of Conservation Programming

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is extending the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) General Signup period, which had previously been announced as ending on Feb. 12, 2021. USDA will continue to accept offers as it takes this opportunity for the incoming Administration to evaluate ways to increase enrollment. Under the previous Administration, incentives and rental payment rates were reduced resulting in an enrollment shortfall of over 4 million acres. The

All Service Center visitors wishing to conduct business with FSA, Natural Resources Conservation Service, or any other Service Center agency should call ahead and schedule an appointment. Service Centers that are open for appointments will pre-screen visitors based on health concerns or recent travel, and visitors must adhere to social distancing guidelines. Visitors are also required to wear a face covering during their appointment. Our program delivery staff will continue to work with our producers by phone, email, and using online tools.
