



- 2 to 3 tablespoons chili powder
- 1 to 2 tablespoons paprika
- 1 to 2 teaspoons ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- sriracha sauce, to taste
- 1/2 cup strong coffee 1 pip chocolate
- (from a Hershey bar)
- 1 can (15 ozs.) diced tomatoes, with juice
- 1 can (15 ozs.) tomato sauce
- 1 can (15 ozs.) dark red kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 can (15 ozs.) light red kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 can (15 ozs.) cannellini (white) kidney beans, drained
- and rinsed 1 can (15 ozs.) corn, drained 1 to 2 cups beef broth or water salt and freshly ground black


