## SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue in week three of our study of our United States Constitution. Last week we studied Article I - Section 1 and this week we study Article I - Section 2 - Clause 1: "The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature." Unlike the Senate in which one-third of their members are up for reelection every two years and the term of a Senator is six years, every member of the House of Representatives is reelected every two years. Therefore, if any member of the House of Representatives falls out of favor with the American voter, they can be replaced every two years. Article I – Section 2 – Clause 2: reads "No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and been seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.'

Therefore, age, citizenship and residency requirements were included to assure that all representatives are of a mature age to be making informed decisions, are United States citizens and not illegal aliens, and are residents of the state in which they seek election. This may seem unnecessary to explain, but many constitutions of other countries are not so strict in their requirements and are often represented by people who are not elected but instead appointed which is not a constitutional republic.

Our founding fathers wished to insure that our Constitution included specific provisions to prevent liberals and potential autocrats from possessing unlimited power which was present in the King of England from which we had just ridded ourselves.

Article I – Section 2 – Clause 3: reads "Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Term of Years, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons." This clause included the reference to "free Persons, including those bound to Service", "excluding Indians not taxed" and "three fifths of all other Persons" which referred to black Americans as being only three fifths of a person.

These were some of the unfortunate compromises which the northern states made to influence the southern states to ratify our Constitution. The representative from South Carolina promised that slavery would be ended in the south within twenty years if slavery was not abolished in the Constitution. However, this was a deception and we later had to fight the Civil War as a result.

Section 2 – Clause 3 included that a national census would be included. It was 1787 and the first federal census was ordered for 1790.

Clause 3 continues "The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct."

We have had a federal census every ten years since 1790. Therefore, it was the intention of our founding fathers that the first federal census would be taken in 1790 so each subsequent census would fall in an even ten year cycle. I hope that everyone who reads these articles more fully understands and appreciates our wonderful Constitution. I would very much enjoy any and all comments.
