Grace Newman may only be 16-years old, but she's proven during the pandemic to be wise and

resourceful well beyond her years, working hard to achieve her dream. Newman is a St. Joseph High School student who turned her quarantine time into a creative new business that helps her achieve two major goals: to save money for her own college education and to give back to others by establishing an annual scholarship fund for like-minded young people. Grace tells me, "Through quarantine and all my life, I've always wanted to start my own business. It's tough to be a teenager these days, with the pressure of social media, bullies, and extra teenage obstacles. I wanted to create a way to inspire girls my age and give them a sense of togetherness." She explains, "That's why I created Brilliant Beautiful Brave (BBBrave) Subscription Boxes for Teenage Girls." In each BBBrave box, there's something to make each girl feel beautiful, whether it be trendy jewelry or makeup. She also offers something that is hands-on to share with others; such as her mini waffle maker and super popular cocoa-bomb-making kit. Boxes also include inspirational journals and things for a teenager's room or locker. Grace says, "This box gives girls something to look forward to every month; something just for them." While she is building her college fund, Grace also decided to give back to the community, saying, "I've created a scholarship fund to be awarded each year. I'm able to do this by donating 10-percent of the proceeds each month. Finally, I am looking to now include local craft makers and artisans to support their business, and to use their creations in my box." Ms. Newman's philosophy is fundamental, as she points out, "At BBBrave, I believe that every girl is beautiful and brilliant in her mind and soul. I especially believe every girl is brave! Brave enough to accomplish whatever she wants, whether it be grades, sports, music, arts, family or friends." The goal of the quarantine dream is to extend well beyond the pandemic, as Grace says, "My ultimate mission is to create a place where girls can share their story, feel included and inspire each other. On January 22, Governor Whitmer announced that her administration would be allowing Michigan restaurants to resume dine-in at 25% capacity starting February 1. Cases and hospitalizations had plummeted since November when the "Pause to Save Lives" went into effect and there was no longer scientific justification for the state to keep the beleaguered industry shuttered past the 75-day mark.

For many operators, the news was bittersweet. A 25% capacity limit is simply not financially viable for many restaurants, prompting them to remain closed or curbside-only despite the easing of restrictions. The order enacting these limits was set to expire Sunday, February 21 and, open or not, operators were looking for-

ward to the capacity limit being revisited and revised upwards.

Instead, when the order was updated on February 4 to allow contact sports to resume, MDHHS quietly extended the 25% capacity restriction all the way to March 29. This came without any public announcement, any scientific justification, or any explanation from the admin-

It's one thing to have the goal posts moved when it comes to restrictions, it's another thing to not even be notified. By the time last Sunday rolled around, many restaurants still had no idea things had changed. They had already begun scheduling staff and ordering food, all to have the rug pulled out from under them again.

Michiganders – and restaurant operators in particular - deserve a more open and honest conversation regarding these decisions and the factors that go into making them. While the administration claims to be "following the science and data," an actual review of the numbers demonstrates the decision to extend the 25% capacity limit restriction could not have been based on the

On January 22, the state identified three metrics for a safe restart: hospital capacity measured by the percent of adult inpatient beds occupied by COVID-19 patients; overall case rates measured by the number of COVID-19 cases per million residents; and the percent positivity rate of COVID-19 tests.

On Jan. 22, the state's own data reported:

- Hospital capacity: 9.9%
- Overall case rate: 225 cases per million
- Positivity rate: 6.8% and declining.

On Feb. 4, the state's data reported:

- Hospital Capacity: 6.3%
- Overall case rate: 127 per million

• Positivity rate: 4.4% and declining.
As of Feb. 22, the state's data reported:

• Hospital Capacity: 4%

- Case rates: 48 per million
- Positivity rate: 3.4% and declining.

With our numbers declining drastically, the question we must ask ourselves is why aren't restrictions doing the same? Why are we still unable to provide employers with any degree of certainty about what to expect and when to expect it?

Indiana, Illinois, Ohio, and Wisconsin all have clear, metric driven roadmaps for their businesses and citizens to follow. Here in Michigan, the Michigan Restaurant and Lodging Association even released a reintegration plan that ties restaurant and event space occupancy numbers to the daily positive test rate reported by MDHHS. (For example, if the seven-day average of percent positive tests was between 10-15% the industry would hold itself to a 25% capacity. If the percentage was 3% or lower, they'd be allowed 100% capacity.)

Yet when asked about the MRLA plan at a February 17 press conference, Gov. Whitmer was noncommittal. She instead replied, "We're going to stay very clearly focused on the number and the data and monitor where we are."

Respectfully, I'm focused on the numbers as well. Some 3,000 restaurants in the state have permanently closed and over 200,000 jobs in the industry have been lost. These numbers, unlike those above, get worse every day.

Enough is enough. As we approach Michigan's one year anniversary of "two weeks to flatten the curve," we must demand more transparency and accountability from our state leaders. We must demand a new approach that values local input; takes cases, vaccinations, seasonality, and regional differences into consideration; and sets clear benchmarks for the easing of restrictions on businesses.

Look for our chamber to advocate for this approach in the coming weeks and months.

For our outdoor activity we will take a look at Grand Mere State Park in Stevensville. Grand Mere State Park is a public recreation and nature preservation area. The state park is located adjacent to Interstate 94. Protected from Lake Michigan by the dunes to the west, the park has many natural features not found throughout the rest of the state. In 1968 it was designated a National Natural Landmark. The 985-acre park is mostly wooded and has three geologically ancient inland lakes, left behind as the glaciers receded during the last ice age. The dunes protecting the park also create a relatively cool environment that supports plants not normally seen in southern Michigan. Grand Mere became a state park

The park offers swimming, hiking, picnicking, boat launch, and cross-country skiing. The park has one mile of beach along the shores of Lake Michigan, which can be reached only on foot by climbing over steep sand dunes. There are many trails for hiking and cross-country skiing, but most are neither posted nor maintained. The trail conditions vary from loose sand to hard packed dirt. There are many hills including a large sand dune. Bikes and off-road vehicles are prohibited.



Even before growing his enterprise into the central business district, however, Doug & Sandy were highly successful as operators of the golf shop at the former Wyndwicke Golf Course off of Niles Road in South St. Joseph. Once they expanded their clothing line to finer men's fashions beyond sportswear, the business boomed for years, first at 400 State Street on the southwest corner of the crossroads, and later in 2000 when they grew into the building that had been the 100year long home to Rimes Department Store at 321 State Street on the northeast corner of that same crossroads. Doug dedicated more than 53 years of his life to the clothing business, and boasted many corporate clients along the way as he outfitted them in sartorial splendor until things slowed in that realm due to societal changes that brought on casual office wear. He adapted to the change, but was saddened that the professionalism of the business community was fading into history. Throughout his career he spent more than five decades working on State Street in St. Joseph, and loved greeting the public as they came into downtown St. Joe, residents and visitors alike. Doug loved people, and his family points out, "He had quite the knack for making men look good in their new clothes." They add, "We (the family) jokingly called him 'Mayor,' because we could never go anywhere in the area where he didn't know someone." They add, with



Dear Dave.

My husband

started working at a new company about a year ago. As part of his sign on, they gave him \$5,000 in company stock. The stock has nearly doubled in value since then, and we were wondering if we should buy more, considering how well it has done.

Cathi Dear Cathi,

I totally get why you two might be excited over a stock that doubled in value over the course of a year. But what you're talking about doing right now is a very risky proposition. The truth is any stock that doubles in value over the course of just one year is highly volatile. It's unusual for stocks to do things like that, and it also means it could go down just as fast—or even faster.

I don't know where you and your husband are in your overall financial situation, but I recommend people become debt-free except for their homes, and have an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses saved up before investing. Once you reach that point, I strongly advise to begin

putting 15 percent of your income toward retirement before you start any outside investing.

Don't get me wrong, I don't mind a little selective and educated dabbing here and there once the basics are taken care of first. However, I'd never recommend putting more than 10 percent of your nest egg into a single stock. The reason? If the single stock tanks and you lose it all, then your loss is only a blip on your financial radar.

Of course, it would be fantastic if this single stock went through the roof and you two made a ton of money. Just make sure you limit the potential for damage in this kind of scenario by limiting your exposure.

I don't know if I've mentioned how hot it is where I live. And I'm not talkin' 'bout global warming, or the latest Sports Illustrated swimsuit edition


