Crow Wing Food Co-op new downtown Brainerd highlight

Your shopping and dining experience in downtown

Brainerd just took a leap ahead. The new Crow Wing Food Co-op should open its

doors by press time.

The grocery store and delicatessen is housed in an historic building that had previous lives as a bank, an art store and then a hockey store on the grand corner of Laurel St. and Seventh Avenue in downtown Brainerd..

All up and down the avenue, the hand of refurbishment shows in the many new businesses and spruced up buildings all along Laurel Street.

The food co-op has four times the space as its previous Eighth and Washington streets location. The new spot features a fabulous interior design with organic-looking wooden shelves and black accents.

You wonder if you are in downtown Brainerd or transported to a larger city as a long glass-lined walk-in cooler, terrific produce area and a huge bulk goods section

beckon.

Whether you need produce, dairy, vegan alternatives, fresh meat (including beef, turkey, chicken, brats and pork) snacks and great drinks, stop off at the co-op. It shows the promise of blossoming into a neighborhood gathering center on its sun-

ny corner, overlooking the fabulously restored Menk Jeweler building opposite at the northwest quadrant of the well-traveled intersection.

The co-op's new building at 624 Laurel once housed Citizens State Bank, which switched from a stately co

lonial with columns to a modern 1950s architecture style that makes it a standout. Citizens moved into their new building on Sixth Street sometime after 1971.

The new co-op boasts a commercial kitchen with all the equipment needed to make smoothies, paninis and great homemade soup

in the deli.

The food products are complemented by a line of natural soaps and cleaners, toilet paper (even sold by the single roll) a chocolate display including 99-cent sweet bites, a beef stick to-go area and many great natural fizzy waters to try.

"I am excited about our

expanded produce area and our new deli and our great, expanded bulk section," said store associate David, who has worked for the co-op since 2012.

The soft opening was delayed a little due to waiting for necessary inspections, but management expected it to be open by the end of February.

Rep. Dale Lueck legislative update

Finally, the thermometer is back on the positive side of zero. Yeah!

During Thursday's House floor session we witnessed the rare occurrence of the majority putting a bill forward for a vote when it did not have the votes to pass it. House File 445 would create a special account for emergencies and put \$35 million into that account to pay law enforcement agencies that respond to help other municipalities.

An example being pointed to is the upcoming trial of the police officers involved in George Floyd's death in Minneapolis. Part of the impetus for a special funding bill was that Minneapolis has not yet reimbursed all the local agencies that sent help during last year's almost

weeklong rioting, looting and burning.

In addition to delaying reimbursements to other local governments, the Minneapolis City Council also significantly reduced funding for their own police department. By not paying for the aid rendered, Minneapolis puts the bill on the local property taxpayers in the cities or counties that responded to help.

The bill failed on a 63 yes, 71 no vote, with eight of the majority party members voting against their own colleagues' bill.

I did not support the bill for several reasons. First, it is not just a funding bill; it includes a number of policy and accountability flaws, including making it very easy for the state to corner most of those dollars and leave the

local units of government hanging. The items that would be eligible for reimbursement are so broad some have described it as simply a big slush fund.

More importantly, the Senate has a better approach that would use the state dollars that Minneapolis gets every year via local government aid (LGA) to reimburse those agencies that came to their aid in the past and, if necessary, in the future. LGA was created many years ago to supplement cities' public safety budgets. Minneapolis will

get about \$78 million in annual LGA in 2021, which is 14% of the total \$5.6 billion of state LGA dollars that will go out to Minnesota cities in 2021.

The money to pay up past-due debts and deal with future public safety issues is already available as part of Minneapolis' 2021 LGA funds. That is a better way to deal with this issue.

Three arrested after entering pipe northeast of Huntersville

The Northern Lights Task Force reported that on Tuesday, February 16 at approximately 11:01 a.m., the Wadena County Sheriff's Office received a report of demonstrators on the pipeline right-of-way in section 4 of Huntersville Township, northeast of Huntersville. The reporting party stated there were approximately 30 individuals demonstrating and some of them were climbing on equipment and pipes located at the work site.

Law Enforcement arrived on scene and the demonstrators got off the equipment. Construction workers on scene told Law Enforcement that four individuals from the group of demonstrators climbed into the pipe with cold weather gear and sleeping bags.

Dispersal orders were given to the group of demonstrators that were trespassing on pipeline property.

Most left the area but three remained inside the pipe. The section of pipe was approximately 2,250 ft. long and the three individuals were approximately 70 ft. inside the east end of the pipe. Additional dispersal orders were given to the individuals inside the pipe. These three individuals refused to comply with the lawful order to remove themselves from the pipe. These individuals stayed in the pipe for approximately six hours.

At approximately 5:30 p.m., the three individuals

exited the pipe without incident. They were taken into custody by law enforcement, medically cleared by medical personnel on scene, and transported to the Wadena County Jail. The three individuals were held in custody on probable cause for Gross Misdemeanor Trespassing. They were identified as Trinity Shaw-Stewart, 20, of Medford, OR, Bonnie Hoekstra, age 22, of St. Paul, MN and Jack Keenan, 26, of Stevens Point, WI.

The Wadena County Sheriff's Office was assisted on scene by the Menahga Police Department, Hubbard

County Sheriff's Office and Tri-County Ambulance. The Wadena County Attorney's Office is reviewing the case for formal charges.

The Northern Lights Task Force is comprised of numerous law enforcement agencies throughout northern Minnesota. This task force is strongly supported by State agencies along with fire and EMS agencies within each county. The mission statement for the task force is: "To provide a safe environment that protects life, property, and free speech through a respectful approach by well trained, disciplined peace officers relating to the lawful activities conducted by those who wish to exercise their First Amendment rights in Minnesota."

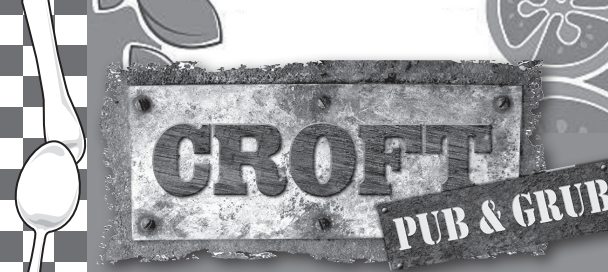

Decreased traffic lane width will be Crosby's future with Hwy. 210 project

On February 22, after the City of Crosby Council unanimously approved the agenda and consent agenda that included the Minutes from the February 8 regular meeting and February 8 workshop and approval of claims, Mayor Jim Hunter asked for public comments. No one from the audience responded, however Councilperson Paul Heglund said he had an issue with Deerwood resident and letter-to-the-editor letter writer, Kelly Avelsgard. Heglund felt that Avelsgard's letters reflected poorly on Crosby.

"I guess what I want to talk about is this Kelly Avelsgard that's talking in the paper all of the time," Councilperson Heglund said. "He's running Crosby down all of the time. And now he's on the [Cuyuna] Chamber [of Commerce]. He was on the [former] Chief of Police Kim Coughlin, [former City Administrator] Lisa Sovo, Bob Novak our [former] Mayor which did a very good job. And he's still popping off in the newspaper and in the [News]Hopper."

Councilperson Heglund requested that NewsHopper owner, Eric Heglund invite Avelsgard to a City of Crosby Council meeting.

"And what I'd like to do, Eric, is invite him to a council meeting here and have him talk in front of us, instead of hiding behind the newspaper," Councilperson Heglund said. "Because I think a lot of people in the City of Crosby are getting sick and tired of him."

Mayor Hunter responded, "We have a right to speak and we have a right for free press... somebody could ask him to come in, but if he doesn't want to, he can still write his letters and do what he wants to do."

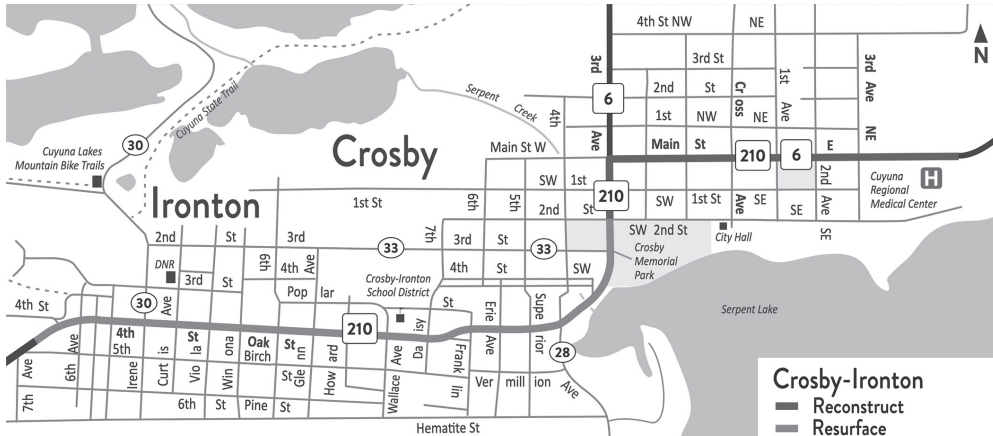
Councilperson Heglund replied, "I know he can do what he wants to. But someone should call him on the carpet, a little bit."

Impervious Ordinance

Under Unfinished Business, City Administrator Matthew Hill talked about getting council approval for publishing the Amendment Summary to the Ordinance for Impervious Coverage. Council unanimously approved publishing in the local paper.

Water Pipe Leak

The Council considered a request by the Cuyuna Range Food Shelf for a \$331.37 credit for the sewer portion of over 26,000 gallon water/sewer bill due to a leak. No adjustment was made to the sewer bill, because it was determined the water did go down the sewer. Council unanimously approved a total of \$49.07 credit for late fees for the Cuyuna Range Food Shelf's water/sewer bill that accrued when waiting a decision on the sewer bill adjustment. Mayor Hunter said that since Cuyuna Range Food Shelf was a non-profit and a benefit to the commu-



nity, he would personally pay the remaining \$331.37.

Hwy. 210 Project Narrowing Traffic Lanes Concern

As requested at the last council meeting, Administrator Hill reached out to MNDOT about opportunities to change the plans that increase the sidewalk and decrease the traffic lanes on the Hwy. 210 Project scheduled for this year. Hill said he was informed that it was to late to make changes, if the project was going to happen this year.

Mayor Hunter said the approximate cost of the project is \$8 million. If the plan was changed and it was moved to 2025 there would be an estimated additional cost of 20 percent or \$1,600,000. Plus the city would lose the \$180,000 grant for the lighting upgrade.

"If we refuse the grant we may not get it back," Hunter said. "MNDOTs increase for the leases and the property that they have signed up for is only good for one year. According to MNDOT that cost would be an estimated \$200,000."

Hunter said that according to MNDOT, after one year the city could have the traffic lanes re-striped to have the left turn lanes removed.

Councilperson Diane Cash spoke explaining that a majority of the sidewalks are currently nine feet wide, some are eight feet wide, and right now they have an orange boulevard border running the length of them where the light standards, waste receptacles and business signs are.

She said the new boulevard be four feet wide will be at a different (less than a 10 percent) slant than the sidewalk. Cash suggested the additional benefit of the enlarged boulevard is temporary snow storage during the winter.

Cash said she had expressed her concern to MNDOT about the increase sidewalk and boulevard width, causing the narrowing of the traffic lanes, going from the current 14 feet wide to 11 feet wide.

Administrator Hill added that Ironton was also involved in this project and didn't feel it would be right for them to delay the project without including them in the discussion.

Cuyuna Lakes Chamber

Cuyuna Lakes Chamber President Matt Larson and Executive Director Brielle Bredsten addressed the council. They indicated they would like to continue to work with the city as partners.

Administrator Hill said that he and City Attorney Joe Langel needed to review the Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyuna Lakes Chamber, after council discussion and suggested revisions. A list of services was included in the proposed memorandum. After some discussion about start date of the agreement, no other revisions were recommended by the council.

Double Funding Requested for Heritage Days

The Heritage Days Committee requested a commitment of \$5,000 from the city for 2021 since last year the event was canceled due to COVID-19 concerns. Linda Peeples indicated they needed more money for promotion, since last year was canceled and they would need to double their efforts and increase their promotional area.

Councilperson Cash said she was concerned about the city's finances. Last year the liquor license revenue was reduced by \$2,800. Campground revenues were also down \$10,000 and she wasn't sure how much it would be down this year. The Hallett Center sales were down \$222,000. Cash asked Peeples how many people attend the Heritage Days Event? Peeples said 500.

Cash said, "When I look at the rate of return, \$5,000

for maybe 500 people that seems way out of proportion. For \$2,000, you get a 1,000 people that come to the boat races."

Peeples said, "I'm sorry, may I correct myself? That was 500 on Saturday. It's an entire week of events. We do sidewalk sales downtown. We do a variety of other things. The 500 I referred to were Saturdays events in the park."

Councilperson Heglund said, "I think Linda did a real good job explaining things. I think all she's asking for is a little support from the council. If this does happen are we going to step up to the plate?"

Councilperson Chris Ryan said, "In years past I've done antiques appraisals for non-profits during the event in the park. There are a lot of people."

Cash asked Peeples if all the money was spent on advertising. Peeples confirmed

it all would be spent and invoices furnished for the Council's review.

Councilperson Ryan asked Administrator Hill if the \$5,000 would come out of the \$12,500 the city had for advertising budget. Hill said it would come out of another fund.

Mayor Hunter proposed an idea for a motion to commit \$3,500 and an additional amount of \$1,500 if requested by the Heritage Days Committee. Ryan made the motion with Heglund seconding. Council approved the funding with Cash voting no.

IRRR Grant Application

Council unanimously approved the IRRR application for a \$350,000 going towards the city utility hookup grant up to site of the new Super-One store in Crosby.

City Administrator Performance

Administrator Hill received a satisfactory six month probationary period performance review. After Mayor Hunter and Member Ryan went through their performance reviews and Administrator Hill shared his thoughts on areas of growth and training that he would like to participate, Mayor Hunter gave an overall performance rating of above average and Councilperson Ryan gave an overall performance rating of

exceeds expectations. Council unanimously approved Hill advance to a Step 5 and receive an additional eight days of vacation.

Other

- The Council unanimously approved the Chamber \$1,250 full page ad in the Visitors Guide for 2021. Deadline is March 15, 2021.

- The city is working with Miner's Inc. in planning a walking path to the new store location. There was no formal proposal submitted at the meeting.

- Administrator Hill indicated that so far the Working Foreman position has one application and the Laborer position has six applications. He anticipates more applications closer to the deadline.

- Councilperson Ryan gave the Economic Development Committee report. Ryan said they will be reaching out to two new businesses. One is a coffee shop and the other is a sporting goods store. The Economic Development Committee will be taking over the Croft Mine Historical Park. Administrator Hill will get the budget information for Economic Development for next meeting.

- Councilperson Cash asked about the plan for chip sealing the roads. Administrator Hill said he would get that information and present it to the council.





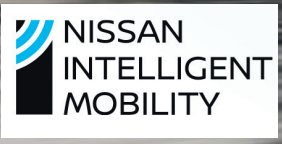
