SHEFFIELD--Bank Independent's 7th Annual Food Share drive to benefit local food banks is underway.

The "Feed a Family for \$5 with Food Share" campaign will continue through March 26. All their bank locations and strategic partner organizations will serve as donation points for non-perishable food items and cash donations, along with PayPal found on bibank.com/help.

Bank Independent works with local partner organizations across their seven-county footprint to ensure donations are distributed to area families in need.

The 2020 drive was revised last year due to the local impact of the Covid-19 pandemic. Early dismissal of local schools and restraints placed upon food banks and a general sense of uncertainty

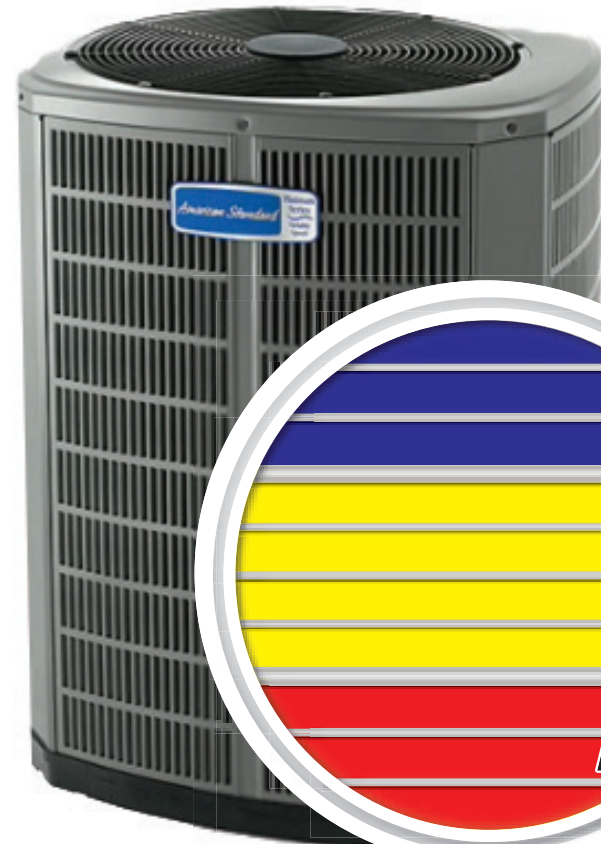

will be named its National Alumna of the Year for 2021, the university's highest alumni honor.

Nicholson received her masters and doctoral degrees in elementary education from MSU in 1967 and 1977, respectively. She also holds an education specialist degree from Vanderbilt University's Peabody College of Education.

She was with the University of North Alabama for 37 years in teaching and administration during her 50-year career. She retired from Blue Mountain College as executive vice president for Student Affairs and Graduate and Special Programs in 2012.

Nicholson earlier was recognized by MSU as the College of Education's Alumnus of the Year in 2018. The Booneville native also served as interim head of the MSU Department of Curriculum, Instruction and Special Education from 2015-2017.

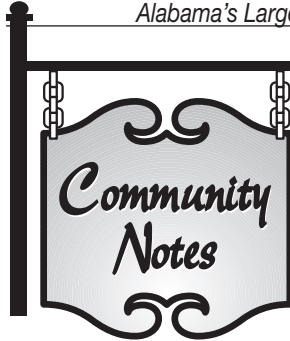

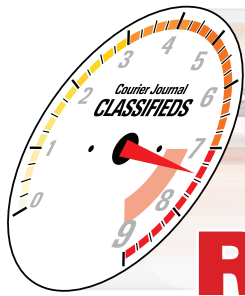



monthly utility bill, citizens can help provide utility assistance for the elderly, disabled, and those who have a fixed income or no income at all. Florence Utilities serves only as the collection service for this fund. Every dollar given to Project Help will go through the Help Center to those in need. No contributions collected will be used to pay workers or subsidize any other expenses. "COVID 19 has placed an increased burden on citizens in every aspect of their lives. It has also increased the need for assistance with basic needs such as housing, food, and utilities," shared Sandie Freedom, Florence Utilities Customer Service Manager. "It is easy for customers to donate small amounts through their monthly utility bill to the Help Center. All donations go directly to assist people in this community. Customers will be receiving a flyer in their bill this month with a signature form that can be returned with their payment. The Project Help donation will be added to the customer's utility bill each month. This is a great way to help fellow citizens during such a difficult time. We look forward to growing and continuing our partnership with the Help Center."

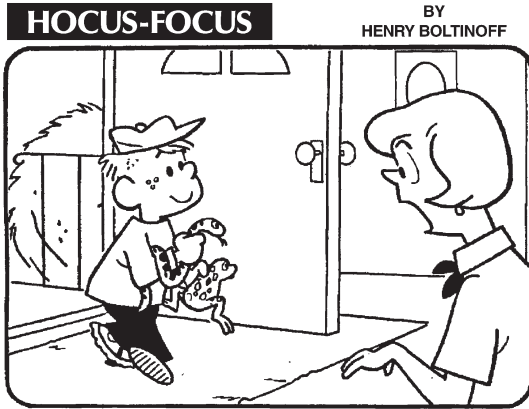

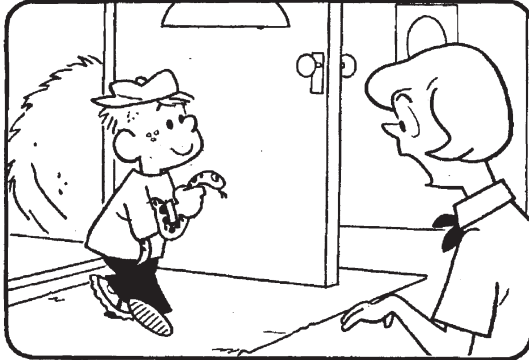

Q My daughter is disabled and is having a hard time getting a job. Can an employer refuse to hire her for no reason?

Kathy, Florence, AL

A Some employers, but not all are subject to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. The Rehabilitation Act of 1973 only extends to the federal government and protects only workers in the federal sector. The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) applies to all employees – both in the private and public sector – provided their employer has 15 or more full-time employees for the calendar year. The Rehabilitation Act uses the term "handicap," while the ADA uses the term "disability."

For example, the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) provides an example of a cashier in a store who has the disease lupus, which makes her more prone to fatigue. The employer could provide a reasonable accommodation to this employee by giving her a stool to allow her to sit, instead of stand, while performing her cashier duties. An employer following the ADA would make this accommodation.

An employer does not violate the ADA if the employer refuses to hire an employee who poses a direct threat of harm to others or himself on the job. In *Chevron U.S.A. v. Echazabal* (2002), the U.S. Supreme Court unanimously ruled that employer did not violate the ADA when it refused to fire a former employee whose disability (hepatitis and liver problems) would be exacerbated (made worse) by exposure to toxins in the workplace.

The Court reasoned that the direct-threat defense articulated in federal regulations should also extend to workers who posed a danger to themselves. The Court did say that the direct-threat defense must be based on reasoned medical judgment and should not be used as a guise to discriminate against disabled workers who don't truly pose a threat at all.

Tell your daughter to consider contacting the Easter Seals Foundation or Alabama Adult Vocational Rehabilitation.

Dear Cathi,
I totally get why you two might be excited over a stock that doubled in value over the course of a year. But what you're talking about doing right now is a very risky proposition. The truth is any stock that doubles in value over the



here and there once the basics are taken care of first. However, I'd never recommend putting more than 10 percent of your nest egg into a single stock. The reason? If the single stock tanks and you lose it all, then your loss is only a blip on your financial radar.

Of course, it would be fantastic if this single stock went through the roof and you two made a ton of money. Just make sure you limit the potential for damage in this kind of scenario by limiting your exposure.



Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part B Coverage"

Medicare Part B is most used when you visit your primary care physician or specialist. But Medicare Part B is also used for many other medically necessary services. Medicare defines medically necessary as "healthcare services or supplies needed to diagnose or treat an illness, injury, condition or disease, or its symptoms and that meet accepted standards of medicine".

One of these other services covered by Part B is transportation by ambulance. Medicare covers and helps pay for ambulance services only if other types of transportation will endanger your health and will only cover and help pay for you to be transported to the nearest medical facility that's able to give you the care you need. If you choose to be transported to a facility farther away you may have to pay more.

Another service Part B covers is Durable Medical Equipment (DME). DME must be long lasting equipment that is used in your home for medical reasons and has an expected lifetime of at least 3 years. Medicare has a long list of equipment that falls under DME.

One of the most important benefits of Medicare Part B are the preventive services that it covers. These services include health care that is used to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage.

Medicare.gov list 23 screenings and shots that fall under preventive services. They include things such as mammogram screenings, colorectal cancer screenings and flu shots.

Part B has an annual deductible of \$203 and a coinsurance of 20%. This means that if you have Original Medicare only, with no other supplemental coverage, you will owe the first \$203 filed on Part B each year and, after the deductible is met, you will be responsible for 20% of the cost of Part B services you receive.

syndicated, *Rush Limbaugh Show*, which began in 1988. There were around 600 radio stations in the US that were talk-based when his program began - all on the AM dial. Today there are 12,000 on both bands.

Maybe Limbaugh came across as abrasive at times. However, that candor often included ingenious musical levity and the precise words of many left-leaning icons in parody, exactly what was needed to demonstrate the levels of absurdity to which liberalism in this country has climbed. And it was expertly done, entertaining millions while poking the exact groups or people that he was exposing.

Limbaugh added more humor, often reminding people that he was doing it all with "half his brain tied behind his back just to make it fair."

Still, very often he only scratched the surface. And we can't forget his dozens of other legendary phrases during the show and returning from breaks, like, "Talent on loan from God," "America's Anchorman," "Permanently ensconced behind the Golden EIB microphone," "America's truth detector, documented to be right 99.6% of the time," and "what I'm holding here in my formerly nicotine-stained fingers."

Limbaugh was always willing to offer a hand up, but he despised society's ever-widening hammock. Some called that hateful and mean-spirited. But Limbaugh was the epitome of doing what it takes to avoid relying on the government teat, and he was always the hardest on himself. He represents the pinnacle of work-ethic, of self-motivation, and of individual triumph in spite of repeated setbacks.

Limbaugh had challenges to overcome for most of his life. He was a college dropout who loved radio, yet he was fired from numerous DJ and on-air jobs before he was 30. That never deterred his drive. Even with health issues in his middle to late years, he never felt sorry for himself or wanted sympathy. He always looked for ways to overcome adversity and to bring others with him. He didn't even want to mention his cancer diagnosis to his audience initially, because he didn't want the show or the topics

to be about him.

Most cannot appreciate Limbaugh's perseverance, thick skin, humility, ingenuity, brilliance, and light-hearted sarcasm. - Because they never truly listened. And he always used his pulpit to create opportunity for others when possible. As I mentioned in a piece last year, he was as generous as they come. More examples have surfaced since his passing.

Limbaugh never took the easy route of groupthink, giving in to a popular feel-good trend of liberal foolishness.

In spite of what his detractors would have us believe, it was clear by Limbaugh's life structure and long-time associations that he never let race, nationality, or gender influence his decision-making. Those who knew him and listened to him with any regularity knew that. And that's really what drives the left the craziest. They want him to be racist so badly that they manufacture situations and facts based on one or two comments, sayings, or elements of hearsay - without a bit of context.

Rush met his wife, Kathryn, through a nonprofit of South African professional golfer, Gary Player. Kathryn worked for Gary and she was supposed to arrange a list of potential celebs to play in Gary's benefit event. He wanted three lists, A, B, and C options, and he wanted Limbaugh on his A-list. However, Kathryn had heard about this Limbaugh guy already. She C-listed him on purpose.

As it turned out, that C-list had to be used to fill the tourney, and Limbaugh accepted. She had to interact with him often during that weekend and admitted on-air after his death that Rush was very kind and respectful, and the most humble man that she had met. All the bad things she had heard about Rush were just not true.

The left labeled Rush as a racist from the outset, even during his wildly-popular, but short-lived TV program. They were lazy and it was easy for them. His extensive list of left-leaning multicultural political and entertainment targets included the likes of Jesse Jackson, Don King, Carol Moseley-Braun, Donna Shalala, Maxine Waters, Al Sharpton, Sheila Jackson Lee, and Barack Obama, minorities who the liberal media viewed as

above reproach. Limbaugh was an equal opportunity skewer. Anyone who advocated liberalism was a target regardless of age, color, gender, religious affiliation... or not. He lambasted the philosophies and parodied lily-whites like Ted Kennedy and Hillary Clinton for three decades. Everyone was entitled to equal treatment.

In fact, Rush was among the first to really delve into the left's insulting approach to minorities, the implication that racism in 20th and 21st century America is too burdensome for minorities to overcome without government assistance. This is a racism that the left itself instigates through what Michael Gerson originally coined as "a soft bigotry of low expectations." It was tepid liberal support while suppressing motivation.

The left can only tolerate individual success in select areas. Education and upward economic mobility of minorities is not among them. The left talked big, but it was usually symbolism over substance. And Limbaugh exposed them daily. Accusers are either woefully ignorant and just parroting others, deflecting attention from their own sketchiness, or simply dimwitted character assassins.

Limbaugh was never afraid to clearly say what was on his mind in the face of constant social pressures. It's largely what got him fired early on and he even had sponsors leave his show on occasion. Not to fear, others gladly replaced them.

Limbaugh assured the many millions of conservatives that they need not apologize for having integrity, principles, respect, opinions, and a backbone to say and practice what they believe.

No one could articulate a position as clearly as Limbaugh and he included the moral footing he used for each position. Sure, he was wrong in his long range assessment at times, but it wasn't often.

Even though he was speaking to upwards of 20 million people at his radio peak, he seemed to be speaking with each person as an individual. Over 99.99% of listeners didn't "know" Rush Limbaugh. Yet, he had a bond and/or a personal closeness to listeners that no one else in the industry has ever had. That is why everyone else

in the entertainment/talk radio business will always stand in his shadow.

Rush had a fundamental confidence in the wisdom and goodness of the American people. He portrayed a kindness and held a genuine interest in every American, and every person who would call his show, both fan and foe. He actually became good friends with many who had opposing political beliefs;

some of them very famous people. He knew that opinions and ideologies didn't absolutely define the person, the soul, who held them.

The media's willful ignorance toward him is only one of his legendary elements. Journalists paid to listen to his show in order to find fault and write negatively is a testament to how on-target he was, and how many political agendas he was undermining just by being himself.

Arguably the best thing that President Trump accomplished while in

office was presenting the Presidential Medal of Freedom to Limbaugh in the House of Representatives during his last State of the Union event.

In spite of all his success, Limbaugh remembered his struggles. For many years, he was one of the little people, one of the American patriots who don't have the glamor or a large nest egg, don't hob-nob with elites, who go to work every day anticipating the next pay check, and keeping an eye out for others. And that mindset never left him.

He would want us to remember that the enemies of freedom are all around us, attempting to demoralize us and take away any of life's joy. They want us to join them in a perpetual mood of despair.

Instead he spoke for all of us and we all benefitted from his career whether we realize it or not. His spirit and a passion for unapologetic individual excellence will live on for generations.

Rush was right.

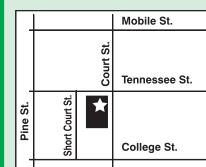

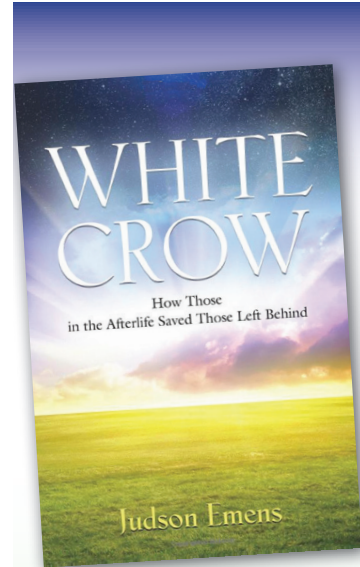

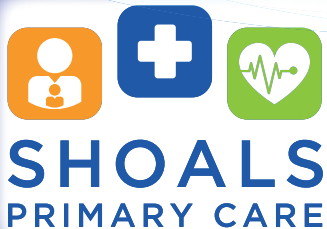

1851 - expanded to Memphis - Charleston RR.
A vital line in Civil War, it changed hands several times.
1898 - became part of Southern Railway.

The 1832 charter went to the Tuscumbia, Courtland and Decatur Railroad Company. Early freight cars were pulled by horses, however in 1834, a steam engine was put in service. In 1888 the wooded station was torn down and the 5th St Depot was constructed. In 1948 the depot was presented to the city of Tuscumbia.

godsend for her family.

Jett has received valuable services, for free, for over a year.

Jett's doctor confirmed what the family was already seeing with developmental delays during his one-year checkup. He wasn't walking, pointing or making eye contact.

An extensive evaluation revealed Jett's diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder.

Leslie and her husband, Andrew, knew early intervention was key for Jett, and the Shoals Cerebral Palsy Center was the answer.

Speech therapist Angie Rogers began making monthly home visits, and later virtual visits because of the pandemic, to work with Jett and to teach Leslie how to better work with her son at home.

"It's been great because Angie has taught me how to help him with daily routines and activities," Leslie said. "She's given me so much help."

Rogers, along with the center's physical and occupational therapists, provide much needed help for families throughout the Shoals.

The therapy, as well as all other services provided by the center, are supported largely through fundraisers, the largest of which is the annual telethon.

This year's telethon is in its 57th year and takes place March 7 at Florence High School with a goal of \$100,000.

The telethon will be aired live on the My 8 channel from 1-4pm.

Center Director Alison Isbell said donations may be made ahead of time by calling the center office at 256-381-44310.

Donations on the day of the telethon will be made through the televised number.

The telethon is one of two fundraisers the center has each year. The center hosts a half marathon and 5K race every October, but the live event was cancelled last year due to the pandemic and a virtual race was held instead.

The race, which typically raises at least \$20,000, raised \$5,000.

"We stress the importance of the telethon every year, just to keep the doors open and continue offering all our services, but this year it truly does hold even more significance, especially after the year we've just had," Isbell said.

The center doesn't turn children away who qualify for services. And once a child is in the program, he or she can remain until the age of five.

When Jett becomes three years old, he will transition out of the early intervention program to an early head start program to prepare him for kindergarten.

Leslie said the combination of teletherapy and Jett's interaction at the center has helped her son with motor skills, social skills and communication.

"He's always babbled and he can sing songs and say words, but he can't communicate with us," she said. "His understanding is there, so we expect communication to catch up between the ages of 3 and 5."

Leslie said Jett's speech is much improved.

"Jett is true to his name — constantly climbing, running, singing," she said. "He so much fun and just a happy, sweet child who shows a full range of emotions. The center plays a big role in his development so far."
