

#### CHICKEN BISCUIT SKILL

1 Tbsp. butter 1/3 cup chopped onion 1/4 cup all-purpose flour 1 can (10-1/2 oz.) condensed chicken broth, undiluted 1/4 cup fat-free milk 1/8 tsp. pepper

2 cups shredded cooked chicken breast 2 cups frozen peas and carrots (about 10 oz.), thawed 1 tube (12 oz.) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits, quartered

Preheat the oven to 400°. Melt butter in a 10-in. cast-iron or other ovenproof skillet over medium-high heat. Add onion; cook and stir until tender, 2-3 minutes.

In a bowl, mix flour, broth, milk and pepper until smooth; stir into pan. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly; cook and stir until thickened, 1-2 minutes. Add the chicken and peas and carrots; heat through. Arrange biscuits over stew. Bake until biscuits are golden brown, 15-20 minutes



#### Strategies To Overcome Seasonal Affective Disorder

some improvements within one to two weeks of beginning treatment. Light therapy is usually continued throughout the win-

• SPENDING TIME OUT-DOORS: People with SAD who don't typically spend much time outdoors when the temperatures dip may notice their symptoms improve if they make a concerted effort to spend time outdoors in winter.

• REARRANGE ROOMS IN

THE HOME: The APA notes that rearranging rooms and furniture in a home or office to allow more natural light in during the daytime can help improve symptoms of SAD. SAD is a legitimate concern for millions of people across the globe. Working with a physician to overcome SAD can help people successfully transition to days with fewer hours of sun-

light.
