Anita Mayou will be retiring after working 32 years as a nurse for Dr. Kalkhoff and at the hospital before that.







Obituaries

John Mather Hinn

Anonymous Donor, Community Business Leader, Mentor, Friend John Mather Hinn, beloved husband, father and generous businessman, died on February 26, 2021 after a long, hardfought battle with cancer. John's passion for life was evident from the very beginning of his life. The son of Robert "Maurice" and Irma Lucille Hinn, John was born in his family's home in Laurens on September 13, 1942. With the love and patience of his mother and aunt Larie Wells, he was deemed



healthy after just a few months. He is survived by his sister Marney

John knew a good thing when he saw it. He often told the story of his "love at first sight" moment with his soulmate, Kathleen. While John was attending Buena Vista College, he was also managing the Super Valu store in Laurens. It was there that he saw Kathleen Mefferd and decided he absolutely had to go out with her. Kathi and John were married after just 6 months of dating, on June 12, 1966, and they celebrated their 54th anniversary in 2020. John was so proud of Kathi that he had a T-shirt made with her picture on the front and he wore it proudly at one of the family's legendary 4th of July pool parties.

Nothing made John happier than his family and friends. John had a gift for making everyone feel special with his trademark smile and big hugs. John and Kathi built their home on the lake to accommodate the non-stop parade of people who stopped by each day, including his many nieces and nephews who always dropped by to see their favorite uncle. He cherished his time on the lake, especially in the summer. John always said there were just 69 beautiful, warm days a year and he refused to leave the lake during that season. John's passion for his spot on the lake was also due to his need to care for his "Secret Garden" situated on over an acre of his backyard. He loved growing vegetables and sharing them. He was especially fond of growing hot peppers. John's homemade salsa and hot pepper jellies had a large fan following across the U.S. Later in life, John looked forward to his timely afternoon meetings and fellowship with local friends at "The Shop".

When John did agree to leave the lake, he would go to his favorite retreat- Saskatchewan, Canada. He visited there twice a year to hunt and fish with his son, Rob, good friends, and cousins. After his High School graduation, John took some time off and traveled with his parents through Mexico. And, he continued to travel to Mexico every winter with his family and his best friend, Duane Mueske and

While John liked to have fun, he was also a man of business. He graduated from Buena Vista College in May 1967. John and Kathi purchased their first cabin in the Iowa Great Lakes in 1969 and moved to the Lakes area permanently in 1974. John owned and operated the Hinn's Super Valu Stores in Laurens and Estherville, which he purchased in 1974. He continued operating them until 1978 (Laurens) & 1980 (Estherville). John started in real estate in 1979 at the Orville Carlson Agency. In 1980, he and Kathi left there and with another couple, started a firm called Town Lakeshore Country Realty. They had an opportunity in 1983 to purchase another Firm in Spirit Lake, Iowa, and not have any partners. They purchased the Fred Dowden Agency and renamed it DOWDEN-HINN REALTORS on January 1, 1983. It is there that two of their children and their daughter-in-law are REALTORS. Their oldest daughter, Gretchen, is a real estate agent with Keller Williams in New Jersey. The Dowden Agency was started in 1918, and at 102 years old, DHR is one of the oldest continuous run Real Estate Offices in the State of lowa. John's vision for the next 100 years had them join the Keller Williams Franchise which will enable them to expand into additional

From his earliest days in business, John was committed to giving back and helping people. From the very beginning of his career, John treated those who worked for him like family. He mentored the carryout boys who worked for him in the grocery stores and bought one of them a suit for graduation so he could be like everyone else. In 2020, John was named Citizen of the Years by the Spirit Lake Noon Kiwanis, and in an interview about the honor John said "I've always felt it necessary to take care of the children of the county. Anything that involves a child, I'm for and will help." And while John and Kathi have been generous to a myriad of organizations throughout their lives, they almost always did so anonymously. They believe that people are meant to help each other, and the stories of their

John will be remembered by his children as a generous, loving father who inspired and guided them. He showed them the importance of living a joy-filled, purpose-driven life. He leaves to mourn his wife, Kathleen, daughter Gretchen (Anthony) Lucy of Tenafly, NJ; son Rob (Angela Bousquet), Callan, Cade, Sophie, Gracie, and Max; and daughter Angela (Eric), Alex, Zac, Oliver and Gus; his sister Marney Norman; numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by daughter, Heidi Larie, his parents Morrie and Irma Hinn.

toration of a 104-acre section of Anglers Bay Wildlife Area will begin this winter when a contractor will begin removing invasive and non-target trees on a 17-acre section along the shoreline of Anglers Bay.

The goal is to create an oak savanna which involves removing the competition for the bur oaks and restoring a high-quality prairie. This opens the canopy allowing for natural regeneration of oaks on the area and removes shading from the hardstem bulrush beds which allows the aquatic plants to thrive.

"Our long-range plan for this area was first to protect it, then to restore the upland habitat and finally to restore the shoreline by replacing low quality invasive trees and shrubs with a high-quality oak savanna," said Mark Gulick, northwest district supervisor for the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Wildlife Bureau.

This section was acquired in 2006 by the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation, with assistance of many partners, both local and non-local, then turned over to the Iowa DNR to manage. With the restored native prairie and wetlands on the upland areas completed, the focus turns to the final land management action of restoring the shoreline and associated wooded uplands.

This final phase of the long-term management plan was presented during a public meeting at Gull Point State Park Lodge on Oct. 7, and has been part of numerous local discussions. This project is supported by the Spirit Lake Protective Association and was approved by the Natural Resource Commission of the Iowa DNR on Feb. 11. It's available online at https://www.iowadnr.gov/Hunting/Hunting-and-Habitat-Public-Meetings, then scroll down to [Oct 7] Forest Stewardship Plan for Angler's Bay Meeting then click on the pdf link at the end.

The project focuses on shoreline stabilization which includes tree and brush removal with follow up treatments using prescribed fire, mowing and spot chemical treatment to prevent trees and shrubs from regaining a foothold. It may take up to four years to complete. The result will be the beginning of a rare oak savanna ecosystem returning to the landscape.

The oak savanna will have an open canopy resulting in less shading to the Anglers Bay hardstem bulrush beds. While these bulrush beds are considered the largest of Iowa's large natural lakes and the healthiest based on aquatic plant species diversity and abundance, only about half of the original pre-settlement species remain, and some are stressed due to a number of factors including shading from the invasive shoreline trees. Removing this shading allows the aquatic plants to thrive, which helps protect the lake by removing nutrients from the water and protect the shoreline from erosion, and provide exceptional habitat for fish

The area will remain open to all compatible forms of outdoor recreation including hunting, wildlife watching, hiking and more, and provide exceptional views from land and water of a rare ecosystem type that was once common in Iowa. It will support common wildlife species like deer, turkey, eastern bluebirds, black crappie, bluegill as well as species that need this critical habitat, like red-headed woodpeckers, Cope's gray treefrogs, silvery blue butterflies, banded killifish, tiger salamanders, leopard frogs and more.

"This is a legacy project, a living museum when it's done, but it will take time," Gulick said. "A healthy oak savanna of this size is rare."

Representatives Cast Vote to Give Extra Funding to Schools for COVID Costs

On Thursday February 18, Representative Megan Jones (R-Sioux Rapids) of House District 2 and Representative John Wills (R-Spirit Lake) of House District 1, voted in support of House File 532 to give more than \$27 million in extra funds to schools to help cover COVID costs.

HF 532 will divvy up \$27 million in COVID relief funds to schools based on the amount of days they spent in-person this fall. This bill was crafted with the understanding that schools incurred increased costs for in-person learning during the pandemic such as PPE, cleaning supplies and more substitute teachers.

"Studies have made clear that having our kids in school is the best learning environment for the majority of students in Iowa," said Jones. "Many school districts worked hard to provide that in-person option for their students this fall and sustained increased costs in the process. This money will help provide relief for those extra costs."

HF 532 passed the Iowa House with a bipartisan vote of 71-26.

Time for IHSAA to Change

It is time for the Iowa High School Athletic Association to change how they do their postseason basketball pairings. I have thought this for a long time, but have never written about it until now. This past weekend Class 2A #1 Boyden-Hull had to play #2 OABCIG for the opportunity to go to the State Tournament; that game should be for the State Championship, not to go to the State Tournament! For years the IHSAA has paired teams together simply based on geography and not based on getting the top 8 teams to the State Tournament, which is how it should be done and how the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union normally does it (although last year they shafted our 7th ranked team by sending us to the same region as the #2 team, Clear Lake who we had to play to go to State; not that I'm still bitter!). Normally the IGHSAU sends the top 8 teams in the State of Iowa to their own region so they don't have to face each other until they are in Des Moines; just look at this year's bracket as NW Iowa sent three teams in Class 3A in Unity Christian, Cherokee and West Lyon. In 2016 when we made it to the State Tournament, we actually had four NW Iowa teams make it to State in Okoboji, Unity Christian, Western Christian and Manson NW Webster, and three of us made it to the Final Four.

Another outdated thing that the IHSAA does is that they make the boys' coaches for each District meet to determine their seeding. The IHSAA puts boys' teams in their Districts and then the coaches for those teams have to get together and vote on how each team is seeded for tournament play roughly 10 days before District play begins. Can you imagine how awkward this is to be in a meeting with five other coaches and have to vote as to what team gets a higher seed? And can you imagine some of the possible deals that go on with coaches who know each other very well and how that can persuade a certain vote? The IGHSAU simply sends the teams their tournament bracket on one of the last Thursdays of the season and everyone is seeded; you have no idea who you're going to play and you don't have to meet with other coaches to vote who plays who.

One solution to this archaic seeding process would be to have one high school union and then have separate divisions for the boys and girls, but have both be under the same association. I have never understood why we have a separate boys and girls union for high school sports in our state, as I believe we are the only state in the nation to have two separate unions. This would create more uniformity on how things are run, and hopefully the two divisions could work together to find a common solution to tournament seeding. Geography should not be the main factor when determining Districts, it should be how you did during your season and those who had great seasons should be rewarded with higher seeds and protected from playing another top seeded team. When we made it to State in 2016, we had to travel two hours to Clarion to play our Region Final game on a Monday night, but I guarantee you, not one player or fan complained about that trip as it gave us a better chance to get to the State Tournament than simply keeping things based on geography where we would have possibly had to meet Unity Christian or Western Christian in the Regional Final. The IHSAA needs to figure this out and they should have figured this well before this happened, the kids deserve better!


Roses Just Because To Benefit Emergency Services


Pioneers Win Tourney

West O even has a variety of hard seltzers they craft locally! You can enjoy a beer in their taproom or get a growler to-go.

My brewery tour started at Okoboji Brewing Company in Spirit Lake. The brewery offers a number of local and regional brews. They also serve local wines and root beer! I tried a beer flight with 4 different beers. I tried Okoboji Brewing Company Early Riser Coffee Porter, Rosey Irish Red Ale, Shot in the Dark, and the Iowa Strangler Cider from Fairfield, IA. All four were uniquely delicious, and it's tough to decide which was my favorite. The brewery offers a wide variety of games to entertain you while you visit, and you are welcome to bring in food. Papa Murphy's Pizza is next door, and Okoboji Brewing Company will bake the pizza for you in the brewery!

My second stop was West O in West Okoboji. West O serves a large variety of their own beer that is brewed right here in West Okoboji. They also have a couple of ciders and wines from Iowa businesses. I also ordered a beer flight at West O to sample four of their beers. I tried the French Toast Coco Stout, Shandy, Smoked Red, and Pilsner. All were delicious! They were unveiling a new Grapefruit Soak'd Pale Ale when I visited. While I didn't sample it, a number of customers gave it a thumbs up! West O also allows you to bring in your own food to enjoy while you're drinking their beer in the tasting room. I paired my beer flight with a JJBLT from Jimmy Johns!

I hope you are inspired to become a tourist in our community, and support the many businesses and attractions that attract tourists to visit our community! We're lucky enough to have breweries like Okoboji Brewing Company and West O right in our backyard. Plan your own Okoboji adventure and sample some local beer! 
ILCC Awarded for Military and Veteran Friendly Efforts






