





There is a cycle of violence that involves both humans and animals.

Years ago, I was flying to visit my sister and her family. I sat next to a woman who looked and acted completely broken. She told the story about how family and friends had packed her clothes in a hurry to get her away from her husband. She had to leave her small dog there and hoped that the friends would go back to the house in time to remove the dog before her husband came home for lunch. She told details about how he had tortured the dog. Even though this was in the mid-1970s, I never forgot the story. When I started employment at the animal shelter, I knew we had to help the animals who belonged to human victims of domestic violence. The problem of cruelty to animals is not just a problem for people who respect and care for animals. People learn how to abuse, torture, and then ultimately kill humans by practicing on animals.

We received a telephone call several years ago from a woman who had witnessed a man harshly beat two puppies. When we went to his house to speak with him about it, his response was an arrogant and chilling, "I don't beat my puppies any harder than I beat my children."

Research and data support what is actually a matter of common sense; that is, if someone hurts an animal, they will also hurt a human.

In one case, we took two dogs from a man because he had just cut off their ears with box cutters. His girlfriend came to court and testified about how he

was such a kind pet owner. Within a month, he had stabbed her to death.

In another case, a young man was accused of putting a small kitten in a mail drop box. His mother defended him and told us what a sweet, gentle person he was. Several months later, the son killed his mother.

Victims of domestic violence can be reluctant to leave an abusive situation because they do not want to put a pet at the mercy of the one who abused them. Because of my experience on that plane so many years ago, the City animal shelter is pleased to offer a safe haven for pets at risk when the owners leave home to enter a protection program. It is entirely confidential and free.

If you know of an animal or a human at risk of domestic violence, please let them know we will help relieve their worry for the animals. There is a very real cycle of violence that affects humans and animals.

NOT A MYTH: Medicaid Can Recoup Benefits Paid Out From An Estate When Someone Passes!

Fewer things will send someone into a total panic faster than receiving a Medicaid Estate Recovery letter in the mail. Imagine a family still grieving from the passing of a loved one getting a letter informing them that the government funds used for nursing home care for the deceased are owed and must now be paid back! In some cases, we are talking in upwards of <u>hundreds</u> of <u>thousands</u> of dollars here.

This very real concern arises from a long-standing but little-known aspect of Medicaid, the state-federal program that provides health coverage to millions of low-income and elderly Americans. In certain cases, a state has the right to recoup its medical costs by putting a claim on a deceased person's assets. Make no mistake, this includes the state of Virginia.

Under Medicaid law effective for <u>all</u> states, following the death of the Medicaid recipient a state can attempt to recover from his or her estate whatever long-term care benefits it paid out for that recipient's care. States also have the option of recovering all Medicaid benefits from individuals over age 55, including costs for any medical care, not just long-term care benefits. However, no recovery can take place until the death of the recipient's spouse, or as long as there is a child of the deceased who is under age 21 or who is blind or disabled.

While states must attempt to recover funds from the Medicaid recipient's probate estate, meaning property that is held in the beneficiary's name only, they have the option of seeking recovery against property in which the recipient had an interest but which passes outside of probate (this is called "expanded" estate recovery). This includes jointly held assets, assets in a living trust, or life estates. Given the rules for Medicaid eligibility, the only probate property of substantial value that a Medicaid recipient is likely to own at death is his or her home. However, states that have not opted to broaden their estate recovery to include non-probate assets may not make a claim against the Medicaid recipient's home if it is not in his or her probate estate.

In addition to the right to recover from the estate of the Medicaid beneficiary,

state Medicaid agencies must place a lien on real estate owned by a Medicaid beneficiary during his or her life unless certain dependent relatives are living in the property. The state cannot impose a lien if a spouse, a disabled or blind child, a child under age 21, or a sibling with an equity interest in the house is living there.

Once a lien is placed on the property, if the property is sold while the Medicaid beneficiary is living, not only will the beneficiary cease to be eligible for Medicaid due to the cash from the sale, but the beneficiary would have to satisfy the lien by paying back the state for its coverage of care to date. In some states, the lien may be removed upon the beneficiary's death. In other states, the state can collect on the lien after the Medicaid recipient dies. Consult with a Certified Elder Law Attorney[®] who specializes in Asset Protection in your state to see how your local agency handles this.

There are some circumstances under which the value of a house can be protected from Medicaid recovery. The state cannot recover if the Medicaid recipient and his or her spouse owned the home as tenants by the entireties or if the house is in the spouse's name and the Medicaid recipient relinquished his or her interest. If the house is in an irrevocable trust, the state cannot recover from it.

In addition, some children or relatives may be able to protect a nursing home resident's house if they qualify for an undue hardship waiver. For example, if a Medicaid recipient's daughter took care of him before he entered the nursing home and she has no other permanent residence, she may be able to avoid a claim against his house after he dies.

WONDER DOG

Skipper, a newborn border collie in Oklahoma City, may go down in history, says the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. The puppy was one of a litter of nine pups but, unlike her brothers and sisters, she was born with six legs. The dog's veterinarian Dr. Tina Neel says that a week after her birth she was going strong, noting that Skipper may be the first pup with her condition to be born alive. "She has one head and chest cavity but two pelvic regions, two lower urinary tracts, two reproductive regions, two tails and six legs, among other things." Neel says Skipper is a "strong" girl who "loves to nurse and is able to scoot around just like a regular puppy. We think that she may have some things to overcome, but she is determined right now and thriving."

A CRYPTIC PREGNANCY

An Indonesian woman claimed recently that she got pregnant when a "gust of wind" entered her body, reports the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. She says that within 15 minutes she went into labor and was rushed to a local clinic where an hour later she gave birth to a healthy baby girl. Neighbors in the religious West Java community where this happened were quick to assume that she concocted the story to cover up an extra-marital affair. But it is more than likely that she

simply didn't know she was pregnant. Such so-called cryptic pregnancies occur more often than you might think. The online site WebMD reports that one in 2,500 pregnant women show no signs that they are with child until they go into labor.

SLEEPY TIME GAL [OR BOY]

The Sleep Standards Website claims to provide visitors with all there is to know about getting a good night's rest and now it's offering one lucky visitor a "dreamy" way to earn a bit of cash-- \$2,000, to be precise, says the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. The job is pretty easy; all you need to do is snooze away for five nights in a row. Each night you'll find yourself in the sack in a different location, including one night in a 5-star hotel room. The aim is to identify ways of improving "sleep quality," so when you awake each morning you will simply jot down a description of how well you slept and rate the experience on a scale of one to ten.

LONG LOST TWINS

The state of Indiana unsealed adoption records a few years ago, allowing 51-year-old Karen Warner to identify her birth mother. She also made the surprising discovery that she had a twin brother, reports the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. With very little information at her disposal, she embarked on a hunt for her sibling. It was a long and tedious undertaking, but Karen never gave up and finally found her twin by checking voting records for birthdays. Not only did they share a birthday, but it turned out that she and her twin, Mike Jackman, knew each other way back when they were high school classmates. Since they found each other Karen and Mike apparently can't get enough of each other; they get together several times a week. As Mike put it: "It's filled a void in my life I didn't know was there."

A TIGHT FIT

A 1,034 square foot townhouse that's up for sale in the Shepherds Bush section of London with an asking price of 950,000 pounds [\$1.3 million]. But this is no sprawling five-story piedà-terre; in fact, it's just six-feet wide, according to the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. The real estate agency that's listing the property says it is "quite probably the thinnest house in London." It does have three bedrooms, including a third-floor master bedroom that is six feet, two inches wide and almost 21 feet long. Two additional bedrooms are located on the first floor; one is a not so spacious eight feet by six feet and the other is about 16 and a half feet by five feet, ten inches. The lone bathroom takes up the entire second floor.

Dear Viagra,

It's true. If you're age 62 or older and are still raising young children, there's a Social Security benefit strategy that can put some extra money in your family coffers.

Here's how it works. When you file for Social Security retirement benefits, your minor children can get money on your work record equaling half of what you would receive at full retirement age, now gradually rising from 66 to 67. Even if you were to take a smaller benefit by claiming earlier, your kids will still get half of your full-retirement age amount.

To qualify, your daughter - whether she's biological, adopted or a stepdaughter must be unmarried and under age 18. Kids that are over 18 but still in high school, can collect too until they graduate or turn 19, whichever comes first. (Other rules apply to kids that are disabled.)

But that's not all.

Because one of your children is only 14, your wife (if you're married) can collect Social Security benefits on your work record too, and it doesn't matter if she's just 40 years old. The minimum age requirements to collect retirement benefits (62) or survivor benefits (60) does not apply when it comes to collecting benefits as the caregiver of a young child. The spouse's benefit, which is also worth up to half of your benefit, will stop when your daughter turns 16.

But note that there are limits to the amount of money that can be paid to a family. The Social Security "family maximum payment" is determined by a complex formula and can range from 150 to 180 percent of your

retirement age benefit is \$2,400 per month. That would make your family maximum benefit (according to the Social Security formula at SSA.gov/ oact/cola/familymax.html) roughly \$4,200 per month.

Subtract your \$2,400 benefit from the \$4,200 family maximum benefit, which leaves \$1,800. That's the monthly amount that can be split between your two children - \$900 each. If your wife wants in on it too, the individual checks are smaller, at \$600 a piece, but the family amount is the same.

You should also know that minor children can collect up to half of a disabled parent's Social Security disability benefit. And if the parent dies, they will get a survivor's benefit, which is up to 75 percent of the deceased parent's basic Social Security benefit.

One Caveat

Social Security benefits for your kids may not be available before full retirement age if you are still working. In 2021, you will lose \$1 in benefits for every \$2 earned over \$18,960, except in the year you reach full retirement age. In that case, the earnings limit is \$50,520, with \$1 in benefits withheld for every \$3 earned over the limit.

If you lose your benefits, your dependents also lose theirs. You can recoup those payments later, but your kids can't.

Another COVID Scam

You know it's getting bad when local police chiefs go on the nightly news to warn against scams. That's what is happening in my area, and possibly in yours. Scammers are going all out to steal your information, money and identity, and they're using the COVID vaccine as their tool. A few weeks ago, the scammers' tactic was to claim we were eligible for a special CO-VID Medicare card. The card doesn't exist. So many of us might have said that in response to the frequent phone calls that the scammers changed tactics. Now they claim to have an appointment for you to get the COVID vaccine. Here's how it works: A scammer will claim to be calling from your doctor's office, without actually naming the doctor. All they need from you, they say, is your Medicare card number and possibly your bank account or Social Security number "for identification." Your best bet is to just hang up. But if you ask for the name of the doctor, they won't know it. It's the same with hospitals and clinics.

If you're not sure whether the call is fake, hang up and call your doctor, the hospital or clinic, and ask if they've tried to contact you. Scammers also are using different tactics: telling you they can fit you into a quick appointment, saying they're from Medicare or your insurance provider, sending you an email that indicates you can get a fast appointment reservation by calling their special phone number, or offering you the vaccine at a "reduced cost" (the vaccines are free). Some of them actually offer to mail the vaccine to you.

Don't fall for any of these scams. If you need help signing up online for an appointment, call your doctor's office or the senior center. Don't give scammers any information, not even your name.
