





The value of the credit or discount will vary according to individual policies and policyholder circumstances but can be up to a 10 percent discount. The Farm Disaster Preparation Certificate is directed to all sizes of farms and all types of products. Dairy and livestock farms are especially encouraged to participate in the program due to their additional concerns regarding animal agriculture. The person represent a farm should be the insurance policyholder; other key farm personnel are welcome. You must attend both sessions for certificate. ## **SPEAK OUT**

#### Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week five of our study of our United States Constitution. This week we continue with the section regarding the Senate in Article I – Section 3 – Clause 2 which reads "Immediately after they shall be assembled in Consequence of the first Election, they shall be divided as equally as may be into three Classes.

The Seats of the Senators of the first Class shall be vacated at the Expiration of the second Year, of the second Class at the Expiration of the fourth Year, and of the third Class at the Expiration of the sixth Year, so that one third may be chosen every second Year; and if Vacancies happen by Resignation, or otherwise, during the Recess of the Legislature of any State, the Executive thereof may make temporary Appointments until the next Meeting of the Legislature, which shall then fill such Vacancies."

As I mentioned earlier one third of the Senate is elected every two years with the goal of all one hundred senators being elected over a six year period of time which is the term of office of a senator. The Executive Branch of each state may make temporary appointments when the Legislature of a state is in recess, and when the Legislature reconvenes, it may appoint a replacement to fill the vacancy until the next election. Article I – Section 3 – Clause 3 reads "No Person shall be a Senator who shall not have attained to the Age of thirty Years, and been nine Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State for which he shall be chosen."

Again the founders desired to assure that any candidate for the Senate would be of a mature enough age to make wise decisions. They also established residency requirements for each senator. Article I – Section 3 – Clause 4 reads "The Vice President of the United States shall be President of the Senate, but shall have no Vote, unless they be equally divided." We have seen the Vice President presiding over the

We have seen the Vice President presiding over the Senate during the recent counting of the votes of the Electoral College. Also our new Vice President cast a tie breaking vote when the Senate was equally divided 50 to 50. Article I – Section 3 – Clause 5 reads "The Senate shall chuse their other Officers, and also a President pro tempore, in the Absence of the Vice President, or when he shall exercise the Office of President of the United States." The Senate Majority Leader represents the majority of the Senate while the Senate Minority Leader represents the minority of the Senate in the absence of the Vice President. Article I – Section 3 – Clause 6 reads "The Senate shall have the sole Power to try all Impeachments. When sitting for that Purpose, they shall be on Oath or Affirmation.

When the President of the United States is tried, the Chief Justice shall preside: And no Person shall be convicted without the Concurrence of two thirds of the Members present." An oath is a promise to a deity and an affirmation is a pledge on one's personal honor. Both are legally binding promises to tell the truth and subject the oath-taker to penalties of perjury. As I mentioned earlier the House of Representatives


As I mentioned earlier the House of Representatives possesses the sole power of impeachment and the Senate is in charge of impeachment trials. Two thirds of the Senate must submit a guilty vote to convict. Lord willing, we will study Article I – Section 3 – Clause 7 next week. I believe anyone reading the Constitution will see its provisions to protect we citizens. I would very much enjoy any and all comments on my articles. Ron Powell Nunda



Requests of MMCSD residents for transportation to an eligible nonpublic school for the 2021-22 school year are due to the District Clerk no later than April 1st. Transportation Request Forms are provided by the nonpublic school.

If you have a child currently receiving transportation to a nonpublic school and will need transportation again for the 2021-22 school year, or if you have a child who will need transportation to an eligible nonpublic school beginning in the 2021-22 school year, you will need to submit your request to the MMCSD District Clerk no later than April 1st.

Please note that transportation requests must be submitted annually and are due April 1st each year for transportation to be provided the following school year.
