Both transitions are effective immediately.

The news of the transition comes just after Director of Enrollment Jim Collins announced the highest spring enrollment in 16 years at 114 credit students and a total headcount of 204. Collins began a twoyear transition out of his role into retirement last January.





UNA In-Person for Fall Term



The poverty level is \$36,000 for a family of 4.

\$15/hour x 40 = \$600 x 52 weeks = \$31,200 a year. Most jobs are without paid sick leave, without paid insurance, and no paid vacation, but you can't afford a vacation on this anyway because you are still in poverty. The poverty level is not what most Americans get a year. Minimum wage is \$7.25. That's \$15,080 a year working full time.



Joel and I handle injury cases and have since 1988. We help people pick up the pieces after an accident or injury. We know how much it costs to make a house wheelchair accessible. We know how much it costs for a handicap van and how many of those a person will need over their lifetime.

It's just better to not to be hurt. Here are some easy things to do to avoid having an accident.

First, make sure that your tires and brakes are working properly. Tires that have uneven pressure can cause a car to brake unevenly. Secondly, stay calm and don't be frustrated with

other drivers. Sure, some are aggressive and drive too fast, change lanes quickly and cut others off but studies show that taking a deep breath and not being that driver will keep you out of an accident.

Third, assume the other drivers are going to make a mistake. That means just because a blinker is on doesn't mean they are going to turn. When you approach an intersection don't assume everyone else will stop as they are supposed to. Number <u>four</u> is following too closely. The rule is 20 feet of distance for every 10 mile an hour of speed. When you stop make sure you can see the rear tires of the car in front of you. We always have cases where people are hit from the rear and then slam into the car in front of them (this is as known as the "Double Whammy".)

Number <u>five</u>, be careful in bad weather. When you hit a puddle it can pull the steering wheel, cause your car to hydroplane and warp your disc brakes. Just slow down when it's raining. Sixth, WEAR YOUR SEATBELT. Number seven, don't drive drowsy. Your response time slows down and at highway speeds in two seconds you travel about 200 feet. Eight, don't drive distracted. Studies show that talking on a cell phone slows your reaction time and so does putting on makeup and looking at your radio. 'Keep your eyes on the road and your hands on the wheel."

Number nine, don't speed. You don't really save that much time but you can increase your risk of a crash by as much as fifty percent. And that doesn't count getting a ticket. And last but not least, more than thirty percent of all fatalities are the result of drunk driving. So, number ten is don't drive drunk.

influence on his future son and perhaps a bigger effect on the entire planet. But I'm getting ahead of myself.

Arnold's intellectual pursuits were interrupted in 1942 when he joined the military just after the attack

on Pearl Harbor. During the war, Arnold displayed a penchant for building radio transmitters which eventually led to designing new antennas that revolutionized military communications. Few people know that some of his experiences during the war were part of the inspiration for the 1998 film, "Saving Private Ryan.

But, again, I get ahead of myself. In 1949, after the war ended, Arnold received his BS in Electrical Engineering. Upon graduation, he landed a job with RCA where he developed

a system of data storage and circuitry that allowed retailers to sort inventory, calculate markup, add sales tax, and ring up sales. He called this system "point of sale" which is still in use to this

day.
Shortly thereafter, General Electric snapped him up which allowed Arnold to develop a revolutionary room-sized computer that ran a new computer code called "BASIC." This BASIC language made computer coding more accessible to more people which eventually allowed people like Bill Gates

to start working on their little world-changing products. Steve Wozniak, one of the founders of Apple Computers, purportedly used Arnold's computer to design software for early Macs. Rumor has it that Arnold gave his young son a tour of the brightly-lit ultra-modern computer facility that resembled the innards of a starship which greatly influenced his son in later years . . . but I can't seem to stop getting ahead of myself because I just can't wait to tell you what I'm about to tell you.

Arnold married the love of his life, Leah Posner, in 1945 and immediately started a family, giving birth to one son, Steven, and three daughters. Arnold wanted Steven to follow in his footsteps but, alas, Steven had other ideas. Steven was more of an artsy type but shared his father's love of science fiction and technology. In his teen years,

young Steven displayed a bit of a penchant for filmmaking. At age 16, he and his father made a silly film about aliens landing on Earth. Arnold helped Steven with the special effects that were quite advanced for 1963. 16 years later, this little film ended up being a forerunner to another, slightly-more-popular alien invasion film named, "Close Encounters of the Third Kind" and a slew of other influential movies including "Saving Private Ryan." Steven Spielberg's dad, Arnold, died last August, 2020, at 103 years old.

Medicare Minute "Annual Wellness Visit"

Medicare wants you to be as healthy as possible. Because of this, Medicare offers you the opportunity to receive many of your preventive screenings and tests at no out-of-pocket cost to you. If you are in the first 12 months of starting your Part B, these benefits are called "Welcome to Medicare" visits. If you have had Part B for more than 12 months, they're called "Wellness" visits. There are, however, a couple of rules that must be followed for you to receive these benefits at no cost.

The first thing to know is, **you only receive one** "Wellness" visit per year. If you go to a specialist, and they code your visit as a "Wellness" visit, you cannot go to your primary care physician and receive another "Wellness" visit. It is your responsibility to know how your visit is coded. If you do not want a visit to a specialist or primary care physician coded as a "Wellness" visit you must speak up.

The second, and maybe the most important, thing to know is; for a visit to be coded as a "Wellness" visit it must be for preventive services only. Your "Medicare and You Handbook" states; "If you doctor or other health care provider performs additional tests or services during the same visit that aren't covered under this preventive benefit, you may have to pay coinsurance, and the Part B deductible may apply." In other words, if you are having a medical issue and go to your doctor and discuss this issue, you probably will not be able to use your "Wellness" visit and must pay your copay or coinsurance. "Wellness" visits are for preventive screenings and tests only!!

If you go to your primary care physician or specialist, and they "break the news" to you that a visit is not eligible to be coded as "Wellness", please be patient with your provider. It's not that they do not want to help you; it's that Medicare will not approve it.



Why do you seem to put so much emphasis on teaching young children about money? *Isn't there time for that later* when they're older? Cyndi

Dear Cyndi,

I firmly believe that one of the best ways you can make sure your kids are ready to face adulthood when the time comes is to teach them how to handle money at an early age. The reason? To raise kids who later become great adults, you have to begin instilling good character traits in them at an early

Whether it's chores around the house or a job at the mall, work involves accountability and following through on tasks. Work shows kids they are in control of their actions, and that they will reap the rewards or consequences of those actions.



Teaching kids to save them patience. teaches Today's world is one of instant gratification, and saving money makes you slow down and think. It also shows kids they can't have every little thing they want the moment they want it.


When you teach kids to give, you're teaching them generosity. A willingness and desire to give doesn't always come natural to us when we're young. Parents should encourage and model the act of giving, because generosity is a wonderful character trait and a powerful weapon in the fight against selfishness and greed.


