

Public Service Announcement

Free Vaccine Available for Food Service Workers

The Orleans County Health Department has been awarded a grant to provide the Hepatitis A Vaccine to food service workers at NO COST to them or the employer.

In Western New York and across the United States, foodborne outbreaks of Hepatitis A have occurred as a result of infected food service workers. Brenden Bedard, Director of Community Health Services for Genesee and Orleans Counties, understands the severity of Hepatitis A and the effect it can have on a business and community. "Hepatitis A is a serious issue because most food service workers will spread the infection before even knowing they have the disease. A food service worker can spread the virus to customers or other staff by contaminating surfaces, utensils and/or food, which can make unvaccinated individuals very sick. By offering the vaccine to food services workers, we can prevent unnecessary illness from spreading in the community."


Hepatitis A is a contagious (spreadable) liver infection that is caused by the Hepatitis A Virus (HAV). It is typically spread through the feces (poop) of infected individuals. Someone can become infected by consuming (eating) food or drink that has been contaminated by feces as well as having close personal contact with a person who is infected, or use of injection and non-injection drugs. The symptoms of HAV may include sudden onset of fever, loss of appetite, nausea / vomiting, stomach pain, dark-colored urine and jaundice (a yellowing of the skin and whites of the eyes). HAV usually does not have signs or symptoms until the second week of infection and is the most infectious during this time.

The good news is that Hepatitis A can be prevented through vaccination! According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the vaccine has a 94% -100% efficacy rate. The Hepatitis A vaccine is a two dose series that is administered 6 months apart. As the vaccine is not required to attend school or daycare, many people have

Any food service worker living or working in Orleans County can receive the vaccine. By receiving the vaccine, you are also protecting yourself from getting the virus if you come in contact with dishes and/or utensils that may have been contaminated by a customer or co-worker. Restaurants who have participated in this opportunity will receive a certificate honoring their commitment to protecting the health and safety of their workers and customers.

Restaurants or food services workers who are interested in receiving the Hepatitis A vaccine should contact the Orleans County Health Department immediately as this opportunity is ending on April 1, 2021. What is Octane and Should it Affect

familiar with the word "octane." But few drivers may know what octane refers to and how it might affect their vehicles.

According to Kelley Blue Book®, octane is a colorless component that boils at high temperatures. Octane is added to fuels, including gasoline used in vehicles, to eliminate preignition in combustion engines. The higher the octane rating, which is a measure of a fuel's ability to resist "knocking" or "pinging," the less likely the fuel is going to explode unexpectedly. In fact, KBB notes that gasoline with a high octane rating can withstand more compression than gas with a low octane rating.

So what does this mean for the average driver when he or she arrives at the pump and has to choose between 87, 89 or 93 octane gasoline? Likely very little. The U.S. Department of Energy notes that most gasoline vehicles are designed to run on 87 octane gasoline. However, some vehicles are still designed to run on higher octane fuel, so drivers should always consult their owners' manuals to determine which octane is best for their vehicles.

Using a lower octane fuel than the one mentioned by the vehicle manufacturer can damage the engine over time. The DOE even notes that using a fuel with an octane rating other than the one recommended by the vehicle manufacturer may actually void the warranty. That gives drivers even greater incentive to consult their owner's manuals before filling up for the first time.

Drivers may wonder if using a higher octane fuel than the one recommended by their car's manufacturer will improve performance. And in certain instances, it might. The DOE notes that higher octane fuel may improve performance and gas mileage and reduce carbon emissions when towing or carrying heavy loads. However, there's typically no such benefit when driving in normal conditions.

Drivers encounter octane anytime they visit a filling station. Learning more about octane and what it does for vehicles can help drivers become more informed motorists. ■





Commons Symptoms of Engine Control Module Problems

The notion of vehicle maintenance often conjures images of greased-stained hands and car hoods propped up. While professional and amateur mechanics are still no strangers to getting their hands dirty, vehicle maintenance in the 21st century also involves diagnosing issues that might arise with a car's engine control module.







What is an engine control module?


An engine control module, or ECM, serves as the primary computer system for many critical components in modern vehicles. ECMs essentially serve as the brains behind the engines, controlling everything from fuel mixtures to emissions controls. Sensors within the engine send signals to the ECM, and the ECM then uses that information to help the car run smoothly. Issues that arise with the ECM can make driving difficult and, in some cases, impossible.

What are some potential signs of ECM issues?

The automotive service provider Aamco notes that a faulty or failing ECM will exhibit various symptoms. However, it's important to note that these symptoms are not always indicative of issues with the ECM, so when they arise drivers may want to schedule appointments with their mechanics so the true culprit can be identified and the problem can be fixed.

- Check engine light comes on: Many drivers have experienced the dreaded check engine light, which indicates some type of issue with the engine. That issue can be a failing engine component, or it may indicate a failing or bad ECM. A mechanic can determine why the light has come on.
- Engine performance issues: Even though the ECM is a separate entity from the engine itself, a bad or failing ECM can affect engine performance. That's because such ECMs throw off the timing and fuel settings of the engine, leading to a sudden and noticeable reduction in engine performance. Engine power may be affected, and the vehicle may experience a drop in fuel efficiency and issues with acceleration.
- Vehicle will not start: A failed ECM means the vehicle won't start, as there's nothing controlling the engine to tell it do so. Failing ECMs may lead to struggles starting the vehicle, and whenever drivers experience these issues, they should consult their mechanics immediately so the issue does not escalate to the point where the engine won't start at all.
- Erratic engine behavior: A malfunctioning ECM can lead to stalling or misfiring. These issues are often sporadic, which may give drivers the impression that nothing is seriously wrong. However, erratic engine behavior is a strong indicator of problems with the ECM, and these issues should be addressed immediately.

Identifying ECM issues and promptly addressing them can help drivers keep their vehicles on the road. ■

I thought I'd take you on the rest of my October 2018 Caravan bus tour. A couple weeks ago, I took you to Yellowstone and the Grand Tetons and in May of last year, I took you to South Dakota. Now, I want to take you to Idaho and Utah. I'll also touch on a couple other parts of the trip that we visited between South Dakota and Yellowstone.

We didn't spend much time in Idaho, but the major stop there was one of my top few favorite experiences of the trip. The National Oregon Trail Center in Montpelier, Idaho is fully run volunteers dressed in period clothing and funded solely by donations. And, they do an amazing job – they told us they were really proud of their little museum and we all agreed they have every right to be. They offer an exciting and interesting first-hand experience of what it was

like to travel from Missouri to California in the 1800s by wagon train along the Oregon Trail. We were first greeted by a cowboy who explained how they traveled. They loaded their wagons with all their belongings, which left no room for riders — everyone walked — all day, every day for miles, except the severely ill and dead. It was very expensive to join a wagon train — they had to purchase a wagon and an appropriate team of animals to pull the wagon, so it was typically only the wealthy or upper middle class who were able to go. Everyone on the wagon train had a job — even the children — and they had to ensure they traveled a certain number of miles each day to stay on schedule. It was a long and difficult journey and not everyone made it. The next part of the Oregon Trail experience was a simulated ride in an actual wagon with all the uncomfortable bumps and pitches. There were recorded readings of actual stories from diaries of the travelers to listen to along our "journey". We, then, got to sit around a simulated camp site to show us what happened at the end of each day — the work doesn't end. It really was an awesome experience and I learned a lot about pioneer life.

I mentioned in my Colorado article that I met a man from Batavia in the elevator of my hotel. Well, there on the Oregon Trail in Idaho, we met one of the volunteers who happened to be from Lockport! I continue to be amazed at how small this world really is.

Another claim to fame for Montpelier, Idaho: The former location of the Bank of Montpelier boasts being robbed by Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid on August 13, 1896 — they got away with more than \$16,500 in gold, silver, and currency. There is a Butch Cassidy museum there, now, and they are quite proud of their brush with the famous outlaws.

We moved on to Utah — Salt Lake City was the final destination for the trip. We stayed at a hotel right in the middle of downtown just a couple blocks from Temple Square and the Mormon Tabernacle. We were let out to tour Temple Square and it was fascinating! Two lovely young missionaries led a guided tour through two of the buildings - the Tabernacle and the Assembly Hall — and the beautiful gardens in the courtyard. We were not permitted to tour the Temple, because only those Mormon who follow the strictest of the church's covenants and are declared "clean inside and out" may enter. Temples are considered the House of God and no unclean thing may enter. The organist was playing while we were there for the tour – the sound was incredible! The organ has over 11,000 pipes, multiple keyboards, and multiple sets of foot pedals. We were told that the acoustics in the Tabernacle are perfect — if the organist wasn't playing, they could

drop a pin in the choir loft and you could hear it in the back of the room.

After dinner, we were given the option to return to the Tabernacle to listen to the Mormon Tabernacle Choir Thursday evening rehearsal, which is open to the public. WOW... getting to listen to their angelic voices and musicians in that stunning Tabernacle with the perfect acoustics was indescribable. An evening I will remember forever.

The other two parts of the over-all trip I wanted to briefly touch on were in Wyoming and Montana. First — while in Wyoming, we stopped at Devil's Tower. I wanted to swing by there when I went on a cross country motorhome trip with my brother and sister-in-law in 2016, but it didn't work out, so I was happy to get to see it on this trip. Like millions of others, I saw the movie "Close Encounters of the Third Kind", so it was an unexpected thrill to see the tower in person (and, listen to that tune in my head while I was there, and I'm happy all over again if I just caused you to get it stuck in your head, now — hahaha). We didn't have any "close encounters" on this trip,

but it was still pretty cool. The Indian legend of the Devil's Tower is that a group of young girls (I believe they said three) were playing when a huge bear came upon them. They ran and when it became obvious that they wouldn't be able to outrun the bear, they huddled together and prayed that they could be raised higher than the bear could reach. Suddenly, the earth around them began to rise up to save them. The distinctive streaks on the sides of the tower are said to be claw marks from the bear as he tried to reach the young girls, but failed to do so.

The other stop we made was in Montana — or, more specifically, the Sovereign Nation of Crow Country. As soon as we entered Montana, we immediately left Montana and entered the Sovereign Nation of Crow County, which is about 2.2 million acres NOT considered part of Montana, even though it is inside Montana's borders. It is the greatest span of land within the US borders that is still not under control of the American government.

While in Crow Country, we stopped to visit the Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument. In 1876 in the Valley of Little Big Horn, Sioux and Northern Cheyenne, led by Sitting Bull and Crazy Horse, overwhelmed General Custer and his Calvary. It was a solemn place that the Crow now consider There were no "Close Encounters" when we visited the sacred. We attended a talk by a park ranger, who is a member of the Crow Devil's Tower in Wyoming. Nation — he told the story of the battle and dispelled the myths and legends

that have been embellished over time. On the site, there is a memorial to the Native Americans who fought in the battle and markers all over the hill leading up to the peak showing where bodies were found after the battle. Beside the site, there is also a National Cemetery that has nothing to do with the battle. The park ranger told us that, although it is a National Monument, the site is proudly maintained by members of the Crow Nation. His personal pride in being a part of honoring this Native American heritage was strongly evident in his talk.

We got a nice taste of all these amazing states and I'd love to return, someday, to see more. I did get to spend more time exploring Utah when I traveled to New Mexico and Monument Valley — but, that's a story for another time.






