


Thank You, Harris-Lake Park FFA Chapter





planning a long-awaited upgrade to the first arch, on the Preservation Plaza promenade walkway,

which houses the sign for the entrance to the Arnolds Amusement Park property. LED lighting will be installed and wired inside the Red Letters to make the Arnold's Park Promenade glow. "The sign will be wired for lights to shine directly on the letters so that even at night, you can clearly read the words," said Michele Goodenow, Executive Director. Mueske Electric, Alger Customs and Gopher

Lighting will be doing the work. The first arch is scheduled to come down very soon so that work can begin and the new arch with lights can be put back up by early May.

Imagine Iowa Great Lakes is also excited to announce a new project in partnership with the City of Arnolds Park to work on the shoreline by cleaning up the overgrown brush and invasive species along Pillsbury Point. A pathway already exists along this shoreline, however, needs some attention to improve the walkability. Underneath this historical piece of land, there are probable historical artifacts which need to be preserved and protected. The stone benches will be safely repaired for preservation. The history on this piece of land is deep. It was the original site of the Spirit Lake Massacre in 1857 and Pillsbury Point was donated in 1928 to the state of Iowa and declared a state preserve in 1934. The Civilian Conservation Corps built the footpaths, stone steps and the five stone benches to allow tourists to enjoy the beauty





of the view. In 1940, the park was reclassified as a "historic archaeological park." This project will be a unified effort between the IDNR, the city and the Imagine Iowa Great Lakes board. "No words can describe our gratitude to the Imagine Iowa Great Lakes group for their contributions and dedication to the betterment of the local area. Everyone on the city council would like to extend a heart felt Thank You for helping to protect our beautiful natural resources and historical land," said City of Arnolds Park Mayor, Jim Hussong.

Candidates will be judged on personality, attitude, awareness, leadership and citizenship, contribution to the community, overall appearance, charm poise and her three-minute or less self-expression portion. All judges' decisions will be final.

Our business will deliver to your home or workplace, a weekly CSA share/box of locally grown produce for up to 20 weeks, starting in May and ending in October.

The following are the CSA share choices:

CSA Mini Share: includes one monthly delivered box of locally grown produce starting in May - October which is a total of 6 times/ boxes for the 2021 growing season. A CSA mini share is for a household of 1 to 2 adults/family.

CSA Bi-Weekly Share: which is delivered every other week for a total of 10 boxes of locally grown produce

CSA Half Share: includes a weekly delivered box of locally grown produce starting in May - October for a minimum of 17 weeks to a maximum of 20 weeks. A CSA half share is for a household of 1 to 2 adults/family.

CSA Full Share: includes a weekly delivered box of locally grown produce starting in May - October for a minimum of 17 weeks to a maximum of 20 weeks. A CSA full share is for a household of 3 to 4

We intend to deliver 20 weeks/times for your enjoyment of our boxed produce half or full share but wish to have an understanding that our growing season can be unpredictable and have included the 17 week minimum. During the 2017 growing season we delivered 20 times. Deadline to purchase a CSA share is May 1, 2021.

The following fruits and vegetables will be available sometime during the 2021 growing season in the CSA box share: apples, asparagus, beans green, beets-red or golden, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage-green or red, carrots, cauliflower, celery, chard, cucumbers-slicers-burpless-pickling, eggplant, \*garlic, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce-leaf green-red-romaine, onions-red-yellow-white, peas-sugar snap, peppers-sweet bell-hot, pie pumpkins, potatoes-red-white-Yukon, rhubarb, radishes, \*raspberries, rutabagas, scallions, shallots, summer squash-yellow, sweet corn, tomatoes, winter squash- 10 varieties, and zucchini.



We note all that history so you might have a better appreciation of the work of of John Williams, some of which is available now as a free download.

It was many years ago that we learned of the U.S. Marine Corps' annual recordings being made available for "educational purposes" to schools and broadcasters.

Though many stations shied away from the free music, The Old Professor took them up on the offer along with other material The President's Own band posted for download. Many other military bands have similar programs – mostly as a recruiting tool. The last year being what it was, the Marine Corps wisely decided to make the album conducted by John Williams available for online listening (on YouTube.Com) and as a free download (Yes, it is your tax money at work.) Get the download from: bit.ley/JohnWilliamsAlbum

Research director RD tells us that it was on March 22, 1857, that culinary expert Fannie Farmer was born in Boston. While the name should be familiar it should not be confused with the candy company. What's more important is that Fannie Farmer improved cooking by introducing the measurements of ingredients in her cookbooks, which included fudge! While measuring ingredients sounds like a novel idea today, it was truly significant at the time.

Note, too, that Fannie Farmer and Fanny Farmer (candy) are spelled differently, but they both agree on good candy - for which chocolate fancier RD picked a song that was first performed by Johnny Mercer and the Pied Pipers in 1944. Candy was recorded not only by the Mercer mob, but by The Four Freshmen, in 1960, The Manhattan Transfer in 1975, and Clark Terry with The Metropole Orchestra, in 1995.

It was March 25, 1951, that Guys and Dolls won the award for the Best Musical at the Grammy Awards. The best-known song from that show was written by Frank Loesser, and saw Frank Sinatra have a quick hit with it, as did Jack Jones, in 1964, and Ed Ames, in 1966...

'Sassy' Sarah Vaughan was born in New Jersey, on March 27, 1927. A lady of many nicknames, including "The Divine One," she made her recording debut in 1950, with a Columbia LP that included East of the Sun and West of the Moon, which RD wisely selected to celebrate Sunday's full moon. Enjoy!

# National Library Week STEM Challenges Festival April 2021







## **RSVP Volunteer Cultivating Connectedness Through Art**

Since the start of the pandemic, RSVP volunteers have been unable to join elementary students in their classrooms to provide reading assistance, mentoring, and companionship. Volunteers and volunteer coordinators continue finding new ways to be there for the students and offer inter-generational contact and mentoring. One unexpected connection between an RSVP volunteer in Dickinson County and a first grader at Okoboji Elementary School warms the heart through art.

Judy Hart, RSVP Volunteer, from Milford told DeNeitt Van Den Broeke, the Dickinson County RSVP Coordinator, that she had been using her artistic skills to help her 3-year-old great-grandson cope with the loss of socialization with his peers due to the pandemic.

"He was so sad, and he told me, 'I notes of encouragement and friendship, don't have any friends," explained Hart. Wanting to lift her great-grandson's spirits with something to look forward to, Hart began drawing intentionally goofy dinosaurs. Realizing how much of an impact the drawings were having on her great-grandson, Hart offered to do the same for any other young child who had similar problems or who were struggling to socialize.

VanDenBroeke loved the idea and reached out to the school counselor from Okoboji Elementary School. The counselor found the perfect student for Hart's artistic drawings, a first grader fascinated with dinosaurs who felt like he had no friends. Hart began sending hand-drawn dinosaur pictures to the student in October of 2020, along with

spending an average of 3 to 5 hours per month on the project. The student loves the personalized drawings and letters and has written a thank you note back. Hart says that the illustrations have also helped the days and hours go by for her during this time.

"The school counselor tells me that the student 'lights up' when they open the envelopes. He looks forward to seeing the pictures and is in awe of each picture. He thinks she is just such a great artist, and he is becoming more interested in creating art himself. The art has also helped the student be more comfortable and share more openly. This connection has been a wonderful experience for everyone involved," shared VanDenBroeke.

VA Survivor's Benefit Programs, Continued...

Survivor's Pension Benefit /Aid & Attendance/Housebound The Survivor's Pension Benefit, also referred to as Death Pension, is a monthly tax-free benefit available to low-income. un-remarried surviving spouses and/or unmarried children of a deceased Veteran with wartime service. Survivor's Pension is based on yearly family income which must be less than the amount set by Congress to qualify for this benefit.

You may be eligible if you are the surviving spouse or dependent child of a Veteran who:

Received a discharge from service under conditions other than dishonorable, AND

Served at least 90 days of active military service (other than training) prior to September 7, 1980 with at least one day during a wartime period OR

· Served at least 24 months or the full period for which the Veteran was called to active duty, with at least one day during a wartime period if the Veteran entered active duty after September 7, 1980.

Dependent children may be eligible for Survivor's Pension if they are permanently incapable of self-support due to a disability incurred before age 18, are not married, and are younger than 18 or between ages 18 and 23 if attending school.

Surviving spouses may be eligible for Survivor's Pension if they continuously lived with the Veteran from the date of marriage until the Veteran's death and have not remarried, with certain exceptions.

Aid and Attendance (A&A) is a monthly pension that is paid if veterans meet certain conditions listed below. A& A is not a separate benefit but instead provides additional monthly income over and above the Basic Monthly Pension. To be eligible, you must also meet the requirements for Basic Pension.

Eligibility conditions include: · The veteran is required to have help performing daily func-

tions including bathing, eating or dressing

· The veteran is bed-ridden

· The veteran is in a nursing home or assisted living

· The veteran has eyesight limited to a corrected 5/200 visual acuity or less in both eyes

Housebound Benefits are an increased monthly pension amount, paid to veterans who are permanently disabled and are confined to their residence and unable to leave without assistance. This is for veterans with a disability rating of 100%.

If you think you may be eligible for these benefits, please call the Dickinson County Veteran Affairs Office at 712-336-0883 to set up an appointment.

## Be a Tourist in Your Backyard

by Rebecca Peters, Okoboji Tourism Director Each year thousands of people visit the Iowa Great Lakes to enjoy the activities and attractions our area has to offer. Join me

each week as I become a tourist in our backyard to explore a few of the spots that make the Iowa Great Lakes special!

This week I tried aerial yoga at Studio Yoga & Barre in Spirit Lake. There are very few instructors or studios in the Midwest that offer this type of yoga. Silks, or large slings of fabric, are hung from the ceiling. You can really enhance your stretching by utilizing the silks in different yoga poses, and do poses that allow you to be completely suspended in the air.

My instructor was Amanda Jorgensen, who also owns this

yoga studio located on the top floor of Allure & Co. on Hill Avenue. She started the class by telling me the basics of what I could expect, and stressed that it is important to listen to my body throughout (and breathe). We started with simple poses and stretches that allowed me to feel more comfortable with silk. As I explored different poses she told me what comparable yoga poses they were most similar to. My shoulders were tense when I entered the studio, but much of that tension was eased by winding the silk behind my shoulders and leaning forward ever so slightly. Just a small movement or shift could make a huge difference!

Once I was more comfortable with the silks, I wanted to try a couple simple aerial poses where my body would be completely suspended off the ground. The first pose I tried required a forward bend into a downward dog yoga pose. Then came the challenge! Lifting my right foot off the ground was simple, but I was terrified to lift my left foot, even though I was supported by the silk and still balanced with both hands. I eventually lifted my left foot and it was then time to lift my hands upward, one at a time, to have the feeling of floating in air! I was supported completely by the silk! It was more difficult for my brain to accept than my body, but what a thrill! Next I tried a backwards pose that allowed me to flip upside down. The most challenging aspect was accepting that I could let go with my hands. Eventually I did let go, and laughed with a mixture of pride and shock that I was floating upside-down!

I left the yoga studio with such a sense of accomplishment! Never in a million years would I have guessed that I could balance upside-down, suspended from a silk hanging from the ceiling! I hope you are adventurous enough to become a tourist in our community, and try aerial yoga. It's a fun adventure that not a lot of communities offer. Our visitors look forward to trying it, and we can experience it in our own backyard! ### **Mid-March Musings**

Some of you may fall out of your chair when you read this first paragraph, but I'm actually going to talk about wrestling, and to top that off, Iowa Hawkeye Wrestling! The Hawks claimed their 24th team NCAA Championship on Saturday night in commanding fashion with 129 points with B1G rival Penn State finishing a distant second at 113.5. The only surprise to me when I saw Iowa clinch the title was that it was their first title since 2010, as we have all grown so accustomed to the Hawks being on top of the wrestling world. While Iowa's team performance was very impressive, the most impressive feat of the weekend, in any sport, was Spencer Lee winning his third NCAAChampionship on two torn ACLs at the 125-weight class. Everyone knew that Lee was wrestling with one torn ACL, but after he won his 2021 NCAA title, he revealed in his interview that he tore his other ACL eight days ago and thought about not wrestling because of the pain, but then came back with one of the best sports quotes ever, saying "f-that, excuses are for wusses". Lee was simply dominant during the tournament, even with no ACLs he scored 59 points and gave up only 8 points, and will undoubtedly go down as one of the all-time NCAA wrestling greats. Iowa State also had an individual champion at 157 pounds when David Carr had an impressive 4-0 victory in the title match. Carr also had a great quote after he joined his father, Nate Carr as an NCAA Champion, saying that he "just wants some gummy bears.'

### **ISU Makes Hire**

Although the Iowa State Men are not anywhere close to March Madness, they did have a lot of news last week when head coach Steve Prohm was fired after six seasons, and just 48 hours later TJ Otzelberger was hired. Otzelberger has spent the last five years as a head coach at South Dakota State and UNLV, where he was 99-63 and made two NCAA trips with the Jackrabbits. Otz, as he's known in the coaching community, is very familiar with Iowa State, having spent a total of eight seasons as an assistant coach under Greg McDermott, Fred Hoiberg and Prohm. Otzelberger is also married to former Cyclone WBB great Allison Lacey, so their Cyclone ties run deep, and this is truly his dream job. I really like, but don't love this hire just yet. I think AD Jamie Pollard had to act fast with a very fluid roster, and the NCAA granting players a one-time transfer waiver that will make recruiting a whole new world this spring/summer. This will give the Cyclones a head-start in trying to fill a roster that can compete in the Big 12, something they have not done in the last two seasons. Look for several current Cyclones to transfer, as that is par for the course with a new coach who wants to bring in guys that will fit his culture and style of play. I love Otz's ability to recruit, as he recruited many of ISU's best players the last 10 years, and we've seen many of these players come out in support of this hire on social media. My one concern is how Otz will do with the X and O's of college basketball against some of the best coaches in the nation that you face nightly in the Big 12. I am hopeful he will hire a veteran assistant coach who has been a head coach, similar to what Hoiberg did with Doc Sadler and Bobby Lutz. Otz does have five years of head coaching experience, which is good, but we all know that coaching in a league like the Big 12 or B1G is a step-up in the caliber of coaches and talent. I totally trust Pollard with his hires, especially after he hired and has retained Matt Campbell, so I'm going to be optimistic that Otz will bring back Hilton Magic and have the Cyclones at least sniffing the NCAA Tournament next March!

Online COVID-19 Questionnaire to be Discontinued

For the initial vaccine rollout, DCPH asked those interested in receiving the COVID-19 vaccination to complete a questionnaire found on LRH's website. The questionnaire included the person's age and health conditions, which allowed DCPH to administer over 4,350 doses of the Moderna vaccine to those eligible and most vulnerable to COVID-19. At this point less than 20 people complete the questionnaire each day, and it's now easier to provide the vaccine to more people in the community because of the vaccine's availability at DCPH and other locations such as the Hy-Vee Pharmacy. For these reasons, the questionnaire will no longer be available or used beginning

When DCPH was vaccinating the 65 and older population, they were reaching out to those who had completed the online questionnaire and asking them to come in to vaccine clinics. Now that more people are eligible to receive the vaccine, DCPH will provide COVID-19 vaccine clinic scheduling links at www.lakeshealth.org/ and on LRH's Facebook page.

More People are Eligible to Receive

(IDPH) recently expanded the definition of those who can get vaccinated for COVID-19. In addition to people over

people ages 18 to 64 who have medical conditions that put them at increased risk of severe illness from COVID-19, which include:

- Cancer
- · Chronic kidney disease • Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary
- Disease (COPD) • Down Syndrome · Heart conditions

• Immunocompromised (weakened

- immune system) • Obesity or severe obesity
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease
- Smoking

• Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus

People included in Tier 1 have been vaccinated, according to Lakes Regional Healthcare Director of Population and Public Health Katy Burke. She said, "We are now focusing on Group 1 of Phase 1B Tier 2, which includes those with disabilities living in home settings and their attendant care staff. We will then open up Tier 2 Group 2 to support those in the manufacturing industries that are unable to socially distance."


DCPH has been receiving 300 doses per week and was recently told by the IDPH that amount will not increase in the foreseeable future.

From the healthcare perspective, Lakes Regional Healthcare (LRH) has changed visitor policies and infection control processes and provided testing and treatment for COVID-19. Dickinson County Public Health (DCPH) has vaccinated people against the virus. As the seasons have changed, new information is learned about the virus, and availability of the vaccine is increased, everybody has adjusted in order to best meet the challenges. Dickinson County has recently achieved a milestone in those vaccinated while the state has expanded the definition of who is eligible to receive the vaccine. For these and other reasons, LRH and DCPH will be changing their processes for COVID-19 vaccination and testing. Test Iowa Clinic to End April 16

The Test Iowa Clinic will be closing Friday, April 16, for two reasons. The Monday, March 22. number of people who utilize the Test Iowa Clinic has been consistently declining since February. According to LRH Chief Nursing Officer Chris Ingraham, the clinic tests about 40 people a day at most, and usually it's only about 25 people. He said, "We believe we can now handle the number of tests in a different way, and reduce the staffing requirements specifically for testing purposes." Furthermore, the Test Iowa Clinic was a Vaccine The Iowa Department of Public Health partnership between LRH and the State of Iowa, which was tentatively scheduled

to end on April 16. Patients who are symptomatic or have
