
#### STANDING FOR VETERANS: THANK YOU DENA LOYD AND WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA



Dena Lovd invited the Wreaths Across America mobile exhibit to town on March 17, 2021.


It was four years ago when Dena and Jimmy Loyd first heard of Wreaths Across America and what the program was doing in cemeteries across the United States. WAA was bringing a positive effect on our nation's communities and families by allowing a time to honor our nation's war dead. And her interest was immediate, because ever since their son Chad was deployed to Iraq, the safety and well-bring of our military personnel was close to their hearts as parents. And then, one day during his second deployment, the worst possible thing happened; Chad was fatally shot during a skirmish near Baghdad on August 12, 2006. What followed was a scenario

that Dena and Jimmy never dreamed could or would occur. As you might imagine, there were weeks of waiting and details to be ironed out, but the day came when Chad was returned to his family. Just as happened along the roadways and highways as his entourage passed toward his hometown, so his homecoming turned out for the Loyds, with friends and residents of Hopkins County gathering reverently along the downtown route to his final resting place in Sulphur Springs City Cemetery. So, it's no wonder that the cause of Wreaths Across America deeply touched Dena's heart, and that her response was immediate.



Since then, Dena has devoted herself to the once-a-year act of marking every veterans grave in City Cemetery with a beautiful live fir wreath bearing a brilliant red bow through the Wreaths Across America non-profit organization. The first local ceremony was held mid-December 2018, with about 400 wreaths laid that day in City Cemetery. Afterward, Dena began to reach out to others she knew who have veterans buried in cemeteries across

Hopkins County. As of early 2021, four other community leaders have come forward, and Gafford's Chapel, Old Pickton, Greenview and Black Oak Cemeteries have met the qualifications to join in. And you are invited to be a part of Wreaths Across America this December as a volunteer. Individuals can attend a ceremony and help to place the wreaths upon the marked graves that day. Or you can choose to help clean a cemetery of choice and get it ready for it's big day, which will be December 18, 2021. Please do two things in advance; get in touch with Dena Loyd at 903-348-8174 for details on the local event. And get the whole amazing story of WAA by going to wreaths across a merica.org. And, another way anyone can help, is by donating \$15, the purchase price of one wreath, or \$30 which will provide for three wreaths to be placed in a participating Hopkins County cemetery. 
