

While in Captiva Island, Florida I traveled some back roads and found Gravestones surrounded by both tiny and large ornate shells left behind by visitors. Very appropriate that shells were chosen amongst the sandy soil for those whose lives were grounded at the shore. No matter where you are it is so interesting to see the little mementos and gifts that people leave at Gravesites. Many leave flowers and some say a prayer and leave a stone behind to show respect. I have seen photos of treasured memories, spiritual items, stuffed animals, flags, food, beverages and much more. I love our own Cemetery in Mt. Albion for it's rolling hills, large protective trees and the flowers that blossom from them. Providing both shade and beauty for those that rest there and those that bring life there. It's highest point, reaching high into the Heavens, you can see all the places from which those who rest below came from. Very profound and appropriate. When I am done with my earthly body and rewarded with a new one in Heaven.. I pray my ashes will be put in a little bean pod with a George Strait cassette, a bottle of good bourbon, pictures of my family and friends, and my lipstick. All placed under a

<u>Facility Description</u>: Applicant applied to the New York State Office of Renewable Energy Siting (Office or ORES) for a permit pursuant to Executive Law § 94-c to construct and operate a 184.8 megawatt (MW) wind energy facility located in the Town of Barre, Orleans County.

Applicant filed a transfer application from a pending Public Service Law (PSL) article 10 proceeding on January 13, 2021. Because an application completeness determination was issued in the PSL article 10 proceeding, the transfer application was deemed complete upon filing.

ORES staff published draft permit conditions on March 15, 2021. The draft permit conditions may be accessed at https://ores.ny.gov/permit-applications, click on Project DMM Matter Number 21-00026.

<u>Public Comment Hearing</u>: A public comment hearing pursuant to 19 NYCRR part 900 to hear and receive unsworn comments from the public will be held on May 20, 2021, at 5:00 pm. The hearing is being conducted electronically through the Webex Events platform and by telephone.

All persons, organizations, corporations, or government agencies who may be affected by the facility are invited to attend the hearing and comment on the application and the draft permit conditions. Lengthy comments will not be accepted and instead should be submitted in writing. Equal weight will be given to both oral and written comments. To ensure that all interested persons have an opportunity to speak, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) may limit the time available for oral comments to 3 minutes per person.

Because the hearing is being conducted electronically, it is reasonably accessible to persons with a mobility impairment. Interpreter services shall be made available to deaf persons, and English language translator services shall also be made available, at no charge for either service, upon written request to ALJ Richard A. Sherman at New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Office of Hearings and Mediation Services, 625 Broadway, 1st Floor, Albany, NY 12233-1550, email: ohms@dec.ny.gov. All requests must be received no later than 4:00 pm on May 6, 2021.

Instructions on how to attend the hearing electronically or by telephone may be accessed at https://ores.ny.gov/permit-applications. Click on Project DMM Matter Number 21-00026 and the document entitled "Combined Notice of Availability of Draft Permit Conditions, Public Comment Period and Public Comment Hearing, and Commencement of Issues Determination Procedure." Instructions may also be requested by email to general@ores.ny.gov or by calling (518) 473-4590.

Written Public Comments: Written comments concerning the application and the draft permit conditions must be filed with ORES by 5:00 p.m. on May 21, 2021. Persons filing written comments are strongly encouraged to post their comments on the Department of Public Service's (DPS's) Document and Matter Management (DMM) system. To post a comment, go to https://ores.ny.gov/permit-applications, click on Project DMM Matter Number 21-00026, and click on "Post Comments" in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

Written comments may also be emailed to ORES at general@ores.ny.gov or mailed to the Office of Renewable Energy Siting, Empire State Plaza, 240 State Street, P-1 South, J Dock, Albany, NY 12242. Written comments will be considered equally with oral statements delivered at the public comment hearing, provided they are postmarked by **May 21, 2021**, or e-mailed or posted on DMM by 5:00 p.m. on that date.

Issues Determination Procedure: Pursuant to 19 NYCRR 900-8.3(b), a pre-adjudicatory issues determination procedure will be conducted by the assigned ALJs. The procedure will be conducted solely on papers and briefing unless the ALJs, in their sole discretion, determine that oral argument is necessary. The purpose of the issues conference is to determine party status for any person or organization that has properly filed a petition (as indicated below), and to narrow and define those issues, if any, that will require adjudication in this matter. Participation in the issues determination procedure is limited to ORES staff, applicant, staff from other involved State agencies, and those persons or organizations requesting party status.

Filing for Party Status and Proposed Issues: Persons seeking to participate in the issues determination procedure and any subsequent adjudicatory hearing must register on DMM and file and serve a written petition explaining whether their request is for full party status or amicus status. Petitioners may also file and serve written briefs making arguments in support of their petitions.

All petitions requesting party status and briefs in support must be filed and served no later than **4:00 p.m. on May 18, 2021. Instructions for registering on DMM and filing and serving documents** may be accessed at https://ores.ny.gov/permit-applications. Click on Project DMM Matter Number 21-00026 and the document entitled "Combined Notice of Availability of Draft Permit Conditions, Public Comment Period and Public Comment Hearing, and Commencement of Issues Determination Procedure."

Statement of Compliance with Local Laws and Regulations: Any municipality, political subdivision or an agency thereof that received notice of the filing of the application must file a statement indicating whether the proposed facility is designed to be sited, constructed and operated in compliance with applicable local laws and regulations, if any, concerning the environment, or public health and safety. The statement must be filed and served by the same deadline and in the same manner as petitions for party status. Any municipality, political subdivision or an agency thereof that proposes to adjudicate any issues related to a facility's compliance with local laws and regulations must file a petition for party status as provided for in 19 NYCRR 900-8.4(c) and include the statement of compliance with local laws and regulation.

Applicant Statement of Issues: No later than 4:00 p.m. on May 18, 2021, applicant shall file and serve on ORES staff and the ALJs a statement of issues applicant intends to raise with respect to any determination of the Office, and briefing in support. Applicant shall serve the statement of issues and brief on persons filing petitions for party status within five (5) days of such filing. For the required contents of an applicant's statement of issues, see 19 NYCRR 900-8.4(b) (1).

Responsive Briefing and Response to Comments: No later than 4:00 p.m. on June 4, 2021, ORES staff may file and serve a response to any petitions for party status, any statement of issues by applicant, and the statement of compliance with local laws and regulations. By the same deadline, applicant may file and serve a response to any petition for party status or statement of compliance with local laws and regulations. In addition, the applicant shall file and serve on ORES staff a response to public comments received during the public comment period, including any supplemental information.

Add more exercise to the workday

The American Heart Association says taking advantage of little opportunities to move more throughout the day can add up to a significant amount of exercise. Here are some ways to exercise during the workday.

- Ride or work a portion of your commute. People who live close enough to the office can ride their bikes or walk there. You even can park further away if you drive to the office.
- Switch out your desk. Desks come in different configurations and you may be able to opt for a tall or adjustable desk to enable you to stand and move around a bit while working.
- Take the stairs. Skip the elevator and go up and down the stairs each day.
- Start a walking club. Get together with coworkers who also want to exercise and use your lunch hour to walk around.
- Schedule walking meetings. Take the meeting outdoors if the weather cooperates; otherwise, take laps around the building.
- Store some workout gear at work. During breaks, do a few arm curls with dumbbells or use resistance bands to work inner and outer thigh muscles while sitting at your desk.

Exercise can be included in the work day by making some minor changes that really add up.


