events around the state. Florence/Lauderdale Tourism hosts a different walking tour each Saturday in April as a way to promote historic sites, neighborhoods and unique architecture, each guided by local historians. The tours begin at 10am, are free to the public, and will last 60-90 minutes.

The free tours in Sheffield and Tuscumbia also start at 10am on April 3 and continue on April 10, 17 and 24.

The Tuscumbia tours begin outside Cold Water Bookstore, 101 W. Sixth St. and will be led by local historian, John McWilliams.

The Sheffield tours begin at the Municipal Building, 600 N. Montgomery Ave. and will be led by local historian, Jimmy Austin.

According to Susann Hamlin, president and CEO of Colbert Tourism, the tours provide an excellent opportunity to learn the histories about the oldest buildings and the earliest residents of the towns. In addition, Saturday mornings in the spring are a wonderful

time to explore Alabama. "April is one of the most beautiful times of the year to be outdoors as the early spring flowers are blooming and the weather is typically perfect for a morning walk."

All three cities have hosted these annual walking tours for over a decade. The local tourism organizations have been sponsoring these tours since their inception when the Alabama Tourism Department initiated these statewide tours.

Both Florence and Tuscumbia predate the founding of Alabama as a state in 1819.

**FLORENCE**  
**April 3: Florence City Cemetery.** The tour of the Florence City Cemetery, established in 1818, features unique headstones and monuments adorned with burial and religious symbolism. The cemetery contains graves belonging to early settlers, two former governors in the O'Neal family, along with other prominent community leaders and families.

**April 10: Walnut Street Historic District.** The Walnut Street Historic District boasts tree-lined sidewalks, diverse architecture, and elegant homes. The tour will begin in the UNA Tennis Courts parking lot on Hermitage Dr. Walk by 29 beautifully restored houses that originally comprised the Walnut Street Historic District and were placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1977.

The tour begins at the corner of Walnut St. & Hermitage Dr. at 10am. Parking is available at the

UNA Tennis Courts on Hermitage Drive. Tour Guide: Billy Warren

**April 17: Forks of Cypress Plantation Site & Cemetery.** The Forks of Cypress Plantation was one of the oldest antebellum mansions in Alabama. It was built in 1822 by James Jackson, one of the first settlers in Lauderdale County. Bring your lawn chairs for the beginning portion of the tour. The second part of the tour will be at the historic Jackson Cemetery.

The tour begins at Forks of Cypress at 10am. Directions- Take Cox Creek Pkwy. to Jackson Rd. and turn right (no traffic signal at intersection). Turn right at the dead end. Park along the road or enter the gate to

park in the field leading to the columns. Tour Guide: Harry Wallace.

**April 24: North Court & Seminary St.** The North Court & Seminary Streets tour will begin at Rogers Hall or Courtview on the UNA campus. It features Rogers Hall, Coby Hall, the Governor O'Neal Home, Connor Place, Wakefield, the Robert Dean Martin Home, the Medical Arts Building, Pope's Tavern, two Sears & Roebuck houses and many other homes. The tour begins at Rogers Hall, at the North end of North Court Street at 10am. Parking is available on Court Street and at the UNA parking lot located at One Harrison Plaza. Tour Guide: Billy Warren.

**SHEFFIELD TUSCUMBIA**

Native Americans were living around what is now Spring Park in Tuscumbia when the first recorded white family, the Dicksons, arrived around 1817. Alabama became a state in 1819.

Sheffield was founded in the 1880s. However, a town known as York Bluff was located at what is now Sheffield before 1820. "Among the property

owners of York Bluff was Andrew Jackson, who would later become President of the United States," Hamlin added..

Jimmy Austin coordinates the Sheffield tours. He said the April 3 and 17 walks will concentrate on the historic homes along Montgomery Avenue north of City Hall. The April 10 and 24 tours will focus on businesses along Montgomery Avenue south of City Hall.

The April walking tours are a part of an Alabama Tourism Department initiative and will take place throughout the state.

Walking tour participants should wear comfortable shoes and dress appropriately for the weather that day.

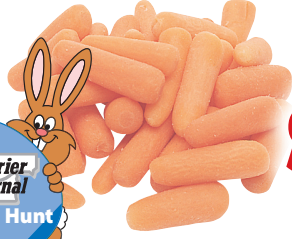

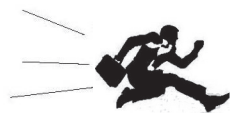

# Stay Ready and Attentive During Storm Season

*We don't want any more lives lost in Alabama*

**D**uring the peak of storm season, the greatest concern is for the safety of everyone who will be affected by a storm.

State Farm encourages all residents in the projected path of any storm to protect

Despite taking proper precautions to prepare your home for a disaster, damage happens. It is important to consider these before and after recovery recommendations.

The following preparation tips are suggested.

### BEFORE

Move garbage cans, patio furniture, and other large objects inside.

Prepare for power outages by keeping items such as flashlights and batteries on hand.

Create a home inventory: Make a list of your possessions and their estimated value

Put together an emergency kit. The kit should include basics such as water, food, first aid, blankets and important documents.

Evacuation – Follow your local authority's evacuation process. Fill your vehicle's gas tank. Don't forget medications, identification and cash.

Tie up boats securely or if possible, place inside a building.

Safe Room.....If you're at home, pick a place in the home where family members can gather if a tornado is headed your way. One basic rule is AVOID WINDOWS. An exploding window can injure or kill.

The safest place in the home is the interior part of a basement. If there is no



cleanup process.

Make temporary repairs to avoid further damage to your property. Take plenty of photos and receipt for repairs.

Document everything: To assist with the insurance claim process, be sure to document items you throw out. Save your receipts, photograph the items and by making a room-by-room inventory of missing or damaged goods. Include manufacturers' names, dates and places of purchase and prices, if possible.

Do not throw out any expensive items, such as large televisions and furniture, until authorized by your claim representative

Once you have cleaned up your property and you are ready to begin to repairs, be careful of home restoration scams.

Find a qualified license contractor to complete any repairs. Insist on a detailed, written estimate clearly stating the quantity of materials needed, Avoid signing any repair contracts without reviewing first with your insurance company.

basement, go to an inside room, without windows, on the lowest floor. This could be a center hallway, bathroom, or closet.

For added protection, get under something sturdy such as a heavy table or workbench. If possible, cover your body with a blanket, sleeping bag, or mattress, and protect your head with anything available--even your hands. They could fall though the floor if the tornado strikes your house.

# Medicare Minute

## "Mail, Calls and Door Knocking 2"

Last week we began discussing ways that agents and companies market Medicare plans to people turning 65. We discussed the phone calls you may receive and the possibility of someone showing up unannounced at your door. This week we will look at online marketing and direct mail.

Direct mail - This is the most common way companies market their plans. When you are within 6 months of turning 65 a company will purchase a mailing list with your name and address on it. Most companies will start sending mail 6 months prior to the month you turn 65. This is because you are eligible to purchase a Medicare supplement any time during that 6 month period. In most cases direct mail is designed to initiate a response on your part. That response is to call a toll free number. You may be calling to get information but usually are connected to a sales person. If you do respond to direct mail, our advice is to never give the agent on the line your social security number until you are ready to buy. This should protect you against unknowingly signing up for a plan.

Online marketing - Occasionally we will have someone stop by our office that has gone online to research Medicare plans. Most online marketing companies will ask you to provide your phone number and/or email address to get pricing information. Once you enter this information you will immediately begin getting phone calls. This is because when you hit "send" that information goes out to 10 or more agents who have bought that lead. All the agents will begin reaching out to you within minutes.

Phone calls, direct mail, door knocking and online marketing are perfectly legal and compliant under Medicare guidelines for some plans but not others. If you have any questions concerning any of these you can contact our office for more information.



from becoming wealthy and living like no one else when it's time to start thinking about retirement.

If you stay in the mindset that having debt is okay, or that you're going to let it hang around, eventually it will really mess you up financially. Winning with money is more about behavior than math. Don't get me wrong, you need to crunch the numbers and be mindful of them, but all the mathematical components are nothing but theory if the behavior doesn't kick in.

So yeah, I'm siding with your wife on this one. Just follow the Baby Steps plan. Have all your debt paid off, except for your home, and an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses saved and set aside before you start any long-term investing. A lot of folks will tell you my way isn't mathematically correct, but it will work better in the long run—for your money, your marriage, and in other areas of your life!

for the initial info from which an opinion is formed. Politicians don't want accuracy; they want to make specific points, many of which are often inaccurate, others of which are always inaccurate. It was assumed the

suspect in Atlanta was racist since he was a white male and six of his eight victims were Asian. Only later did issues of illicit spas and his sex addiction surface.

The Boulder suspect was a shirtless, lightly-complected man being led away from the scene in handcuffs. Assumptions were made there as well. Twitter followers leveled charges of him being a privileged, white, Christian terrorist. It turns out Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa was soon after identified as a Muslim originally from Syria.

National media is only too glad to help spread such unverified misinformation.

They are shorthanded and most lean in a direction of scuttlebutt. Even when inaccurate information is prefaced as alleged or assumptive, it still gets all the initial screen and airtime that they want.

When the truth about the shooter, his motive, or the victims, is realized, it is often in stark contrast to the facts. Yet, no social media accounts are suspended for misinformation, factual inaccuracies, or outright lies. No one is fired for inaccurate reporting.

Everything is left 'as is' with the briefest coverage of some truth in an anticlimactic setting. So most people never know the truth. They hear the lies, discuss it heavily on social media, and when

the truth comes out, new topics are grabbing all the headlines and are trending.

Meena Harris, the niece of Vice President, Kamala Harris, who sticks a racist foot in her mouth regularly, posted a tweet blaming violent white men for the Boulder shooting.

"The Atlanta shooting was not even a week ago. Violent white men are the greatest terrorist threat to our country,"

It had over 6,500 retweets and 35,700 likes before she deleted it.

Soon after that she posted, "I deleted a previous tweet about the suspect in the Boulder shooting. I made an assumption based on his being taken into custody alive and the fact that the majority of mass shootings in the U.S. are carried out by white men."

The double standard is quickly getting old.

A lone white male is automatically representing all the privileged Christian white people, while any shooter of color or with an Islamic background is a completely isolated act by a lone individual and has nothing to do with anger or ideology.

Six out of eight victims of a white gunmen are Asian, so it is automatically a hate crime. All ten of the victims killed by an Islamic-American are white and there is nothing substantive to report.

Yes, ASSumptions.

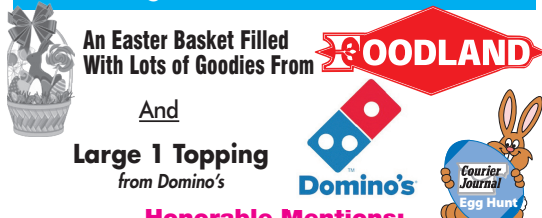

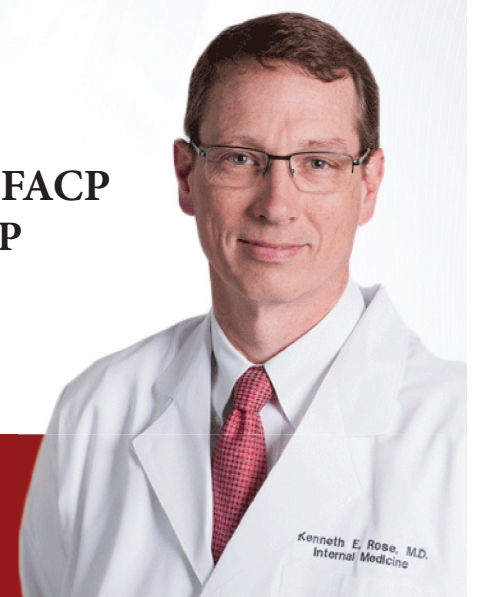

# SIGNS OF THE PAST



**BAILEY SPRINGS A.M.E. CHURCH**  
Circa 1886

It is believed that the Bailey Springs A.M.E. Church, at this location, had its beginnings in the 1880s. At that time, African-American residents of the area would meet to worship in private homes, in clearings in the woods and at various vacated dwellings. Worship services were conducted by traveling preachers, including Rev. T.B. Edge and Rev. Goodson. The first building at this location was the Hewitt School, built in 1920 on land donated by the A.H. Hewitt family. Funding and labor were provided by community farmers, sharecroppers and Private Anthony Brannon, Civil War Veteran, 11th Regiment, U.S. Colored Troops, Infantry. Hewitt School was also used for church services and other activities by the African-American community. In 1953, church leaders purchased an adjacent lot west of the school. Construction began on the Bailey Springs A.M.E. Church on that lot in 1954, under the leadership of Rev. L.S. Gannon. In 1955, Rev. J.S. Jones led the church to the building's completion. During the next six years, the school continued to operate next door. In May 1961, under its integration plans, the Lauderdale County Board of Education transferred seventeen students from the Hewitt School to the East End High School, in Rogersville. Thereafter, the old school building was demolished. On September 16, 1985, the Bailey Springs A.M.E. Church was incorporated under the leadership of Rev. S. Ambers. The sanctuary was expanded, in 1999-2000, thanks to the visionary leadership of Rev. E. Willoughby. As of 2018, the African-American population in the Bailey Springs area has been holding church services in the vicinity of this location for approximately 130 years.

# ASK THE ATTORNEY

**Q** I have custody of my child from my previous marriage and my child lives with me. If something were to happen with me would my child automatically be placed in the home of my ex-husband? Do I have any right to decide as legal guardian where she would go? If it were written in a Will would the Will be followed?

Vanessa - Florence, Alabama

**A** The law is based on preferences and decided by different legal tests. The law prefers a parent to a non-parent. Between two parents seeking custody, as in a divorce, the issue is determined by the best interests

of the child. The test for custody between a parent and a non-parent is very difficult. It is extremely difficult for a non-parent to gain custody of a child from a parent.

Therefore, if you were to leave in a Will, for example, that your sister would obtain custody of your child, that would not be legally enforceable. The law would still favor the child's father. However, if your sister could prove that the father was unfit and prove that it would be in the best interest of the child to be with the sister then perhaps the sister could get custody. If the father was in prison or something equally dramatic it would be easy. If he is a reasonably good father it would be impossible.

One of the issues that you can decide in a Will is who controls the money from your estate through a trust. You can provide that whatever money you leave that child is to be spent consistently with your wishes through a trustee that you appoint. However, you can not determine custody. The courts will do that and they generally do a good job.
