## CARAMEL APPLE

## Ingredients

- 1 pkg. (2-layer size) yellow cake mix
- 1 pkg. (3.4 oz.) Vanilla Flavor Instant Pudding
- 1 cup water
- 4 eggs
- $1 / 3$ cup oil
- $1 / 4$ cup milk

- 3 Granny Smith apples (1 lb.), peeled, coarsely chopped
- 20 KRAFT Caramels
- 3 Tbsp. milk


## Directions

Heat oven to 350 ㅇ. Beat first 6 ingredients in large bowl with mixer until blended. Stir in apples. Pour into greased and floured 12-cup fluted tube pan or 10-inch tube pan. Bake 50 min . to 1 hour or until toothpick inserted near center comes out clean. Cool cake in pan 15 min . Loosen cake from sides of pan; invert onto wire rack. Gently remove pan. Cool cake completely. Transfer to plate.
Microwave caramels and milk in microwaveable bowl on HIGH 1-1/2 min. or until caramels are completely melted and sauce is smooth, stirring every 30 sec . Cool 10 min . or until slightly thickened. Drizzle over cake just before serving

## OLD FASHIONED PINEAPPLE UPSIDE DOWN

## Ingredients

- 4 eggs
- $1 / 2$ cup butter
- 1 cup packed light brown sugar
- 1 (20 ounce) can sliced pineapple
- 10 maraschino cherries, halved
- 1 cup sifted cake flour

- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- $1 / 4$ teaspoon salt
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 tablespoon butter, melted
- 1 teaspoon almond extract


## Directions

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F ( 165 degrees C ).
In a 10-inch cast iron skillet, melt $1 / 2$ cup butter over very low heat. Remove from heat, and sprinkle brown sugar evenly over pan. Arrange pineapple slices to cover bottom of skillet. Distribute cherries around pineapple; set aside. Sift together flour, baking powder, and salt. Separate the eggs into two bowls. In a large bowl, beat egg whites just until soft peaks form. Add granulated sugar gradually, beating well after each addition. Beat until

medium-stiff peaks form. In a small bowl, beat egg yolks at high speed until very thick and yellow. With a wire whisk or rubber scraper, using an over-and-under motion, gently fold egg yolks and flour mixture into whites until blended. Fold in 1 tablespoon melted butter or margarine and almond extract. Spread batter evenly over pineapple in skillet.
Bake until surface springs back when gently pressed with fingertip and a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, about 30 to 35 minutes. Loosen the edges of the cake with table knife. Cool the cake for 5 minutes before inverting onto serving plate.

## PINA COLADA TUBE CAKE

## INGREDIENTS

- 1 package white cake mix (regular size)
- 1 package ( 3.4 ounces) instant coconut cream pudding mix
- 1 cup canola oil
- 3/4 cup water
- 2 large eggs, room temperature
- $1 / 4$ cup rum
- 1 cup drained crushed pineapple

- Glaze
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar, divided
- 2 tablespoons unsweetened pineapple juice
- $1 / 4$ cup cream of coconut
- 1 tablespoon rum
- 1/4 cup sweetened shredded coconut



## Directions

Preheat oven to $350^{\circ}$. Grease and flour a $10-\mathrm{in}$. fluted tube pan.
In a large bowl, combine cake mix, pudding mix, oil, water, eggs and rum; beat on low speed 30 seconds. Beat on medium 2 minutes. Stir in pineapple. Transfer batter to prepared pan. Bake 45-50 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pan 15 minutes before removing to a wire rack.
In a small bowl, mix 1 cup confectioners' sugar and pineapple juice; brush over warm cake. Cool cake completely.
In another bowl, mix cream of coconut, rum and remaining confectioners' sugar; drizzle over cake. Sprinkle with coconut.

## STRAWBERRYLEMONADE CAKE

## Ingredients

Cake

- 1 cup butter, softened
- 4 large eggs, separated
- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 3 cups cake flour
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- $1 / 8$ teaspoon table salt
- 1 cup milk
- 1 tablespoon lemon zest
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- Shortening

Strawberry-Lemonade Jam

- 21/2 c. chopped fresh strawberries
- 3/4 cup sugar
- $1 / 4$ cup fresh lemon juice
- 3 tbl. cornstarch


## Strawberry Frosting

- 1 (8-oz.) package cream cheese, softened
- 2/3 cup sugar, divided
- 2/3 cup chopped fresh strawberries
- 1 drop pink food coloring gel (optional)
- $11 / 2$ cups heavy cream
- 3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice


## Directions

Preheat oven to $350^{\circ}$. Beat butter at medium speed with an electric mixer until creamy; gradually add sugar, beating until light and fluffy.Add egg yolks, 1 at a time, beating until blended after each addition. Stir together flour and next 2 ingredients; add to butter mixture alternately with milk, beginning and ending with flour mixture. Beat at low speed just until blended. Stir in zest and juice. Beat egg whites in a large bowl at high speed until stiff peaks form. Gently stir one-third of egg whites into batter; fold in remaining egg whites. Spoon batter into 4 greased (with shortening) and floured 9 -inch round cake pans. Bake at $350^{\circ}$ for 16 to 20 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pans on wire racks 10 minutes; remove from pans to wire racks, and cool completely.
For Strawberry-Lemonade Jam: Process strawberries in a blender until smooth; press through a wire-mesh strainer into a $3-q t$. saucepan, using back of a spoon to squeeze out juice; discard pulp. Stir in sugar.Whisk together lemon juice and cornstarch; gradually whisk into strawberry mixture. Bring mixture to a boil over medium heat, and cook, whisking constantly, 1 minute. Remove from heat. Place plastic wrap directly on warm jam; chill 2 hours or until cold. Refrigerate in an airtight container up to 1 week. For Frosting: Beat cream cheese and $1 / 3$ cup sugar with an electric mixer until smooth; add strawberries and food coloring (if desired); beat until blended. Beat cream and juice at medium speed until foamy; increase speed to medium-high, and slowly add remaining $1 / 3$ cup sugar, beating until stiff peaks form. Fold half of cream mixture into cheese mixture; fold in remaining cream mixture. Use immediately.
Layer Cake: Place 1 cake layer on a serving platter, and spread with about $1 / 2$ cup Strawberry-Lemonade Jam, leaving a $1 / 2$-inch border around edges. Spoon 1 cup Strawberry Frosting into a zip-top plastic freezer bag. Snip 1 corner of bag to make a small hole. Pipe a ring of frosting around cake layer just inside the top edge. Top with second and third cake layers, repeating procedure with filling and frosting between each layer. Top with last cake layer, and spread remaining Strawberry Frosting on top and sides of cake.

# Claybank Master Gardeners 



Lower Alabama weather is so unpredictable in the spring months, we can go from winter frosts to summer heat almost overnight, not to mention raging downpours followed by drought conditions just when we're setting out new seeds and/or plants. How to cope? Greg Lolley, one of our truly knowledgeable Master Gardeners, recommends spraying the leaves of the plants with compost tea. The plants readily absorb this "liquid gold" and you will see results in a few days. Compost is full of nutrients which help your plants overcome many stress factors. With three compost piles in different corners of our yard, for this gardener this is a free and easily applied solution. If your compost piles are not yet matured enough (when the compost has turned into very black soil) try using a small scoopful from a bag of Black Kow compost mixed into a watering can of water.

What to plant in April? The AL Extension's SOW app suggests asparagus, cantaloupe, celery, corn, cucumbers, eggplant, kohlrabi, lima beans, okra, peppers, radishes, snap beans, southern peas, summer squash, sweet potatoes, tomatoes, turnips, watermelons, and winter squash.
Also look for herbs you can use in cooking. Herbs contain many healthful nutrients that make your food taste better so you need less salt, fat and sugar, and provide disease fighting phytochemicals. Basil, cilantro and parsley are three basic ones that grow easily from seed or transplants. Rosemary, sage and thyme are great with meats and potatoes.
