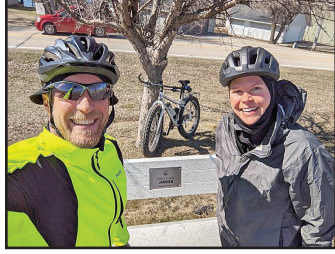
A Trail Bench Story

The bench program continues to grow and be a popular opportunity to honor loved ones and friends. The program also helps raise funds for development and provides the trails with rest areas. The Marvin and June Janssen family chose to replace their old wooden bench along Big Spirit Lake last fall. They shared how Marvin started a family legacy and love of biking.

Honoring Dad & Grandpa: A Family Legacy and His Love of Biking - Marvin and June Janssen have had a cabin on Big Spirit Lake for over 20 years. Marvin loved biking. He would bike to the cabin and back from their farm in southern Minnesota and he enjoyed biking around the lake. Marvin also brought his bike whenever he visited his daughters

that were further away. His love of biking became a family activity for three generations. For 8 out of 10 years, there was a multi-generational family team involved in RAGBRAI. Planning would begin once the route came out in March; number of people going, motels reserved and sometimes t-shirts were made for the whole family. Mom would be the fearless driver dropping off, picking up and sitting

by the roadside with the littlest of grandchildren waiting for the family of bikers. Dad loved his bike and he would bike a thousand miles a year! He was happy when he decided to put a carving of a bike with the saying "Thanks for the Ride" on his tombstone. Now that he has passed, when we see and sit on that bench, we think of him and his "Love for Biking".

Trailhead Making Progress

Construction has started again at the old shiny diner property on Peoria Avenue and Lake Street. The DCTB purchased the land last April and, in partnership with Imagine Iowa Great Lakes, we have been planning a new trailhead where Tatanka Ska Trace and the Spine Trail intersect. The trailhead will be a focal point of the trails system in the heart of Spirit Lake and features designs inspired by Native American beadwork and north-west Iowa's prairie landscape with a few railroad themes to tie in the rail trail. The facilities will include restrooms, shaded areas with picnic tables and benches as well as a water fountain, bike workstation and charging station. Overall, the project will beautify the area and create a relaxing and natural space. The DCTB is excited to bring this new amenity to the Iowa Great Lakes Trails system and we look forward to a grand opening in early summer. 

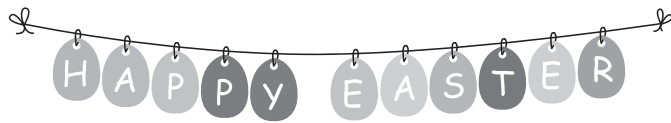

Okoboji Blue Water Festival Returns for 2021

After a one-year hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Okoboji Blue Water Festival is back for 2021, and from all indications, it will be bigger and better than ever! Mark your calendar for Saturday, August 7,

for what promises to be an unbelievable day partaking in all of the activities that make the Festival the premier clean water event in the state of Iowa.

Held at the Preservation Plaza green space in Arnolds Park, the Okoboji Blue Water Festival offers families fun-filled clean water activities and best of all, it's free - all day!

Greg Drees, organizer of the Blue Water Festival shared his excitement for the August 7 event. "After having to postpone our event in 2020, we are so excited to be able to resume the Festival this year. The day's activities commence at 9:00am and run to about 3:00pm. As always, our goal is to raise public awareness of water quality issues in the Iowa Great Lakes and beyond. We have the framework all worked out and want to let folks know what will be happening. Specific times will be released as we get closer to August 7."

Utilizing the winding sidewalk in the Green Space, more than 30 exhibitors ranging from lake protective associations, non-profits and conservation organizations will be spaced out through the sidewalk answering questions and sharing their clean water stories. At the same time, a designated area will be reserved for the Kids' and Family Activities. Drees notes, "We have a committee devoted to developing a dozen or so watershed education stations for parents and children. When we can make the stations both educational and entertaining, youngsters show a keen interest in enhancing our natural resources. After all, they are the future of that guardianship."

For anglers both young and old, a special fishing seminar will take place at 10:30am under the Big Tent. This year's clinician will be Dan Spengler, Senior Bait Development Engineer with Pure Fishing.

Another popular component of the day is the panel discussion on important clean water topics, which will take place at 1 p.m. under the Big Tent. This year's panel is a distinguished group of clean water experts. Drees says, "We have a wonderful lineup of speakers from around the State of Iowa: Adam Schneider, who is the Water Quality Coordinator for the DNR; Nathan Anderson from Practical Farmers of Iowa; Sylvia Secchi from the University of Iowa, from the Sustainability Department; Dr. Larry Weber, who is also from the University of Iowa and an Expert Hydrologist; David Thoreson, Worldwide Traveler and Photographer; Rich Leopold, who heads the Polk County Conservation Board; and Joe McGovern from the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation."

Shortly after the panel discussion, keynote speaker Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., world renowned clean water advocate, will take the stage under the Big Tent. "All people need to know about Kennedy is, that he has spent his entire adult life traveling the globe talking about water. Everything is focused on water, and we're just really excited about this part of our festival."

As the day winds down, everybody will be waiting for this year's concert on the Preservation Plaza stage with music starting at 6:30pm, with JD McPherson the opening act, followed by Colbie Caillat, multi-Grammy pop singer and songwriter.

According to Drees, "We are so excited for this year's Festival. As always, this event is brought to the public ALL DAY and ALL Free of charge. None of this could happen without all of the businesses, organizations and individuals who have given so generously and have volunteered their time and talents to make the 2021 Okoboji Blue Water Festival such a great event."

The Festival was originally created by the Okoboji Protective Association (OPA) in 2016 to raise public awareness of water quality in the Iowa Great Lakes. Founded in 1905, the OPA is a non-profit organization dedicated to the protection and enhancement of West Lake Okoboji and the entire Iowa Great Lakes watershed. Drees adds, "We continue to work in partnership with the OPA and Historic Arnolds Park, Inc. to make the Okoboji Blue Water Festival the premier clean water event in the state of Iowa."

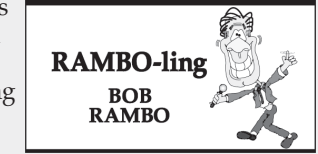


DBBB working on plans for 2021 U of O summer

Hawks Exit Early

Most Iowa fans that I know (I even have some Hawkeye friends) said prior to the NCAA Tournament that for this season to be considered a success the team would have to make at least an appearance in the Sweet 16. Having earned a #2 NCAA seed and with a national ranking of #5, I agreed with them. Iowa had a very good, not great regular season, and as we know, teams and coaches are judged, fair or not, by what they do in March. Unfortunately for the Hawks and their fans, Iowa ran into a very good Oregon team in the second round of the NCAA Tournament and the Hawks were bounced 95-80 by the Ducks.

This game showed what many experts have said all season long, teams that play Luka Garza one on one and have long and athletic guards cause Iowa issues. Coach Dana Altman and his staff had a great game plan of letting their undersized but athletic post players mostly play Garza one on one while not letting Iowa's guards get open looks from the 3-point line. The plan worked to perfection as Garza did all he could with 36 points and 9 rebounds in 36 minutes, but unfortunately, besides Joe Wieskamp (17 points) and Patrick McCaffery (10 points), the rest of the Hawks struggled mightily. Starters Jordan Bohannon, Conner McCaffery and CJ Fredrick combined for 0 points on 0-8 shooting, and normally reliable Keegan Murray had an off night with 6 points on 2-9 shooting. It also definitely did not help Iowa that CJ Fredrick never fully recovered from his lower leg injury, Conner McCaffery has two bad hips, and reserve big man Jack Nunge has been out since February with a knee injury. Unfortunately, in the cruel world of sports, injuries are a part of the game, and most teams deal with them through the season, especially during this irregular year.

Many people are upset with Fran McCaffery as he has never gotten Iowa past the second round of the NCAA Tournament, and as many Hawk fans lamented after the Oregon game, if you can't do it with this team, will it ever happen? McCaffery has led Iowa to five NCAA Tournaments in his 11 years (is really 6 as they would have made the 2020 Tournament) but holds just a 4-5 record in these games. Iowa fans do need to remember that they also ran Tom Davis out of town because he couldn't get to past the Sweet 16, and don't forget how things went after Davis was pushed out with coaches Steve Alford and Todd Lickliter. I am not a huge fan of how Fran acts on the sidelines, and I am not going to take a sword to defend him, but be very careful what you wish for when you complain about the job he has done. If you count 2020 as an NCAA Tournament year, which it would have been, Fran has taken Iowa to three straight NCAA Tournaments and this year's team did finish the regular season where they started, ranked #5 in the nation. I will hold out on judgment of McCaffery until the next few seasons as the Hawks now face a pretty major rebuilding job with their career leading scorer (Garza) and career leading 3-point shooter and assist man (Bohannon) ending their storied careers. If Joe Wieskamp decides to go pro, the Hawks rebuild will be even tougher as that will take away Iowa's top three scorers from this year's team. McCaffery and his staff do need to evaluate the roster they have and what has been their kryptonite the last few years, long and athletic wings, and go out and sign several of them. Iowa will also probably need to dabble in the transfer market and try to find an impact player to help with some of the nice young pieces that they do have. I know that the ending of the season wasn't what you wanted Iowa fans, and it probably stung even more when Oregon got trounced by USC in the Sweet 16, but take a step back, take a deep breath, and be thankful that you didn't just suffer through a 2-22 season like us Cyclones!

Noxious Weed Policy 2021

Dickinson County weed commissioner Douglas Todey has released the 2021 noxious weed policy.

"That each owner and each person in the possession or control of any lands in Dickinson County shall cut, burn or otherwise control all noxious weeds thereon," the policy states, "and in such manner shall prevent said weeds from blooming or coming to maturity, and shall keep said lands free from such growth."

Each landowner must control all noxious weeds prior to the listed dates:

- June 21: Leafy spurge, Russian knapweed, Buckthorn, Multiflora rose, Quackgrass, Musk thistle
- July 19: Canada thistle, Field bindweed, Bull thistle, Purple loosestrife, Palmer amaranth, Plumeless thistle, Perennial sow thistle

However, these are only guidelines. Weather conditions may cause weeds to mature ahead of normal and may require control measures prior to the listed dates.

"There are many ways to control noxious weeds and that varies greatly depending on the size of the infestation and what species it involves. Control can be anything from hand pulling a small number of plants to using a chainsaw or forestry mower to cut down bigger woody species," Todey said.

Home and land owners should check their green spaces to analyze if they have any noxious weeds. If anyone has trouble identifying any possible noxious weeds, Todey suggested utilizing sites such as the Iowa State Extension, Iowa Department of Natural Resources, and the Iowa Weed Commissioner's websites that all have guides to invasive plants with recommended methods and timings of control.

If landowners need advice, Todey is willing to help anyone to avoid being fined as noncompliance requires that fines be assessed "If there is a weed complaint on an area of land, I will work with the landowner to ensure that it is controlled by the date laid out in the 2021 weed resolution," Todey said. "Getting the weeds controlled and prevented from going to seed are my main priorities."

Huevos Rancheros ~ Serves 4 at 550 calories/person

1 tablespoon olive oil
1 yellow onion, chopped
1 teaspoon minced garlic (2 cloves)
1 jalapeno, minced
1 red bell pepper, diced
15 ounce diced tomatoes, undrained
2 teaspoons red wine vinegar
15 ounces canned red kidney beans, drained and rinsed
1/2 teaspoon ground cumin
8 large eggs
1/4 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons water
8 corn tostadas
1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1/4 cup plain Greek yogurt, or sour cream

Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat, add the onion, garlic, jalapeno and bell pepper; cook about 5 minutes. Add the tomatoes, vinegar, beans and cumin; cook, stirring occasionally, 5 to 6 minutes. In a small bowl, whisk together eggs, salt and water. In a separate nonstick skillet, cook the eggs over medium-low heat, stirring often until eggs are just set. Top tostadas with tomato mixture and eggs. Top with cheddar cheese and plain Greek yogurt or sour cream.
