#### Easter 2021 – America is ready for a Resurrection Dr. Glenn Mollette

The followers of Jesus believed in his resurrection because they saw him alive after he was dead. They had a powerful testimony of firsthand evidence seen with their own

Mary Magdalene saw Jesus first. In John's gospel chapter 20:14-16 we have the recorded appearance. "Jesus said to her, Mary! She turned and said to him 'Rabboni' which is to say teacher."

Jesus next appeared to Mary the mother of James, Salome and Joanna. They were on their way to tell the disciples that an angel had told them Jesus had risen when he appeared before them. He greeted them and the women took hold of his feet and worshipped him. (Matthew 28:9) As with Mary Magdalene these three women also touched Jesus.

Jesus appeared to Peter. "The Lord is risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" (Luke 24:34) This was a private appearance and occasion where Jesus reassured Peter. Peter had earlier denied him.

Jesus' last appearance on Easter Sunday was to the disciples with Thomas absent. It took place in the upper room in which Jesus had instituted the Lord's Supper. It is recorded in Luke's and John's gospel. Jesus came and stood in their midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you." And when he had said this, he showed them both his hands and his side. The disciples therefore rejoiced when they saw the Lord."


There were other appearances of Jesus later as recorded in the scriptures but these were the five appearances on Easter.

The followers of Jesus were terrified. They had been hiding behind closed doors. They thought they could be arrested and crucified at any time, just like Jesus. Seeing Jesus alive turned their lives around completely. They were so empowered they went out to dynamically proclaim that Jesus had risen. If you possibly can, get up, get out and celebrate life this Easter, safely. America is ready for a resurrection.





## PIEDMONT PETS

Yesterday was our 14th anniversary with our much-loved umbrella cockatoo, Buddy. With this anniversary comes a stark warning for all companion animal guardians.

Regular visitors to the shelter or readers of this column may remember that we were involved in an auction involving 600 birds at a breeding facility in North Carolina. Animal welfare groups from all around the country pooled money and acquired as many as possible to keep them out of the bird breeding industry. Buddy was one of the 19 birds we were able to get.

That is not all of the story, though. Before the auction, we contacted the owners and asked if we could pick up any of the ones that were sick or in poor condition. To my surprise, they agreed we could come and get the worst ones.

When we went to the location

When we went to the location, we saw row after row of cages outside. Companion birds of all kinds clung to the sides of cages. Their only purpose in life, according to humans, was to produce offspring so money could be made.

I am still so haunted by this experience. One bird – another umbrella cockatoo – was alone in a cage. When we walked down his row, he went to the front of the cage and started yelling, "I can talk, I can talk."

Our hearts broke. Now, I realize that some people will say that he really did not know what he was saying. Perhaps that is so, but to us it meant that this bird had at some point been in a loving home and had, in fact, been taught to speak in human language.

One volunteer with us started crying and said she wondered if he was calling out in desperation, hoping he would be taken from the sparse cage outside.

Sadly, we did not win him in the auction a few days after that.

The warning or cautionary tale that comes from this story is this - be very, very careful if you can no longer care for an animal and decide you must find another home for him or her.

The talking bird was obviously once a favored companion. Circumstances came up that resulted in him being given away to someone. More often than you realize, that second home decides another home must be sought, so once again, the animal is given away. Big birds are expensive, messy, and destructive.

If you must find another home for an animal, check, double-check, and triple-check. In one possible scenario, the talking bird may have been placed in the breeding facility because, after all, there would be other birds to keep him company, the people knew how to handle birds, etc.

In fact, even carefully check out sanctuaries. Many "sanctuaries" are actually awful places where hellish conditions exist. Check with local humane societies, state agencies, law enforcement, etc. to see if they are familiar with the sanctuaries. We once received a couple of large birds from a terrible sanctuary; a volunteer begged the owner to let her have a couple of the birds just so they wouldn't die in a horrible way.

## DANVILLE UTILITIES RECEIVES NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Danville Utilities has earned a "Platinum" level designation as a Reliable Public Power Provider (RP3 $^{\circ}$ ) from the American Public Power Association for providing customers with reliable and safe electric service.

The "Platinum" level is the second highest a public power entity can achieve. Danville Utilities has received the RP3 designation multiple times, but this year is the first time it has reached the "Platinum" level.

"I think over the last year or so, we've seen the vital importance of running a reliable and safe utility," says Aaron Haderle, chair of APPA's RP3 Review Panel and manager of transmission and distribution operations at the Kissimmee Utility Authority in Kissimmee, Fla. "The utilities receiving the RP3 designation have proven that they are committed to running a top-notch public power utility by implementing industry best practices."

The RP3 designation recognizes public power utilities that demonstrate proficiency in four key disciplines: reliability, safety, workforce development, and system improvement.

Criteria include sound business practices and a utility-wide commitment to safe and reliable delivery of electricity.

Danville Utilities will retain the RP3 designation for three years. Of the 2,000 public power communities in the nation, Danville Utilities is one of only 275 utilities that hold the RP3 designation.

"We couldn't be prouder to be honored with this designation," said Jason Grey, director of Danville Utilities. "This is the culmination of a lot of work from a lot of people who really care about powering our community. But this designation is not a final destination. We are committed to continuing to look for ways to improve our operations and service to our customers."

The American Public Power Association has offered the RP3 designation for 15 years now. APPA is the voice of not-for-profit, community-owned utilities that power 49 million people in 2,000 towns and cities nationwide. APPA advocates and advises on electricity policy, technology, trends, training, and operations.

Danville Utilities provides natural gas, water, wastewater and telecommunications services in Danville and distributes electricity to approximately 42,000 customer locations in a 500-square-mile service territory covering Danville, the southern third of Pittsylvania County, and small portions of Henry and Halifax counties.





There are a certainly a lot of myths and misconceptions in Estate Planning! Whether at seminars in person, through consults or webinars and even over the phone, we often hear these myths listed below come up quite frequently:

#### MYTH #1: "Estate planning is only for the rich."

When people hear the word "estate", the automatic association is that of a millionaire, for example, "stately Wayne Manor". This is a popular misconception. Often, people believe that estate planning only benefits the wealthy, but nothing could be further from the truth.

If you own property and assets or have loved ones that depend on you to provide for their income or care, you have an estate and need a plan—regardless of the size of your estate!

Estate planning is something everyone needs to engage in regardless of age, estate size, or marital status. If you have a bank account, investments, a car, home or other property—you have an estate. More importantly, if you have a spouse, minor children, or other dependents, an estate plan is crucial for protecting their interests and their future income needs.

An estate plan can help you accomplish these and other important goals:

- Protect those who depend on you and your income during their lifetime.
- Name guardians for minor children, or adult-disabled children.
- Name the family members, loved ones, and organizations that you wish to receive your property following your death.
- Transfer property to your heirs and any organizations you've named in your estate planning documents in a tax-efficient and expedient manner, with as few legal hurdles as possible.
- Manage tax exposure.
- Name your executor and/or trustee the individual(s) or institution you appoint to act in settling your estate and distributing your property.
- Avoid probate, the court process for proving that a deceased person's will is valid.
- Document the type of care that you prefer to receive should you become ill or incapacitated, including any life-prolonging medical care that you do or do not wish to receive. Do not assume that your loved ones "already know what you want."
- Express your personal wishes and preferences for funeral arrangements and how related expenses will be paid.

## MYTH #2: "Estate planning is only about distributing my assets after I'm gone."

Everyone knows that they need a will. But what happens when someone is in a serious accident, is in a coma, or is suffering from dementia or a stroke? Legacy and incapacity planning are two areas of planning that encompass far more than simply managing your assets during or after your lifetime.

Just like your goals, your legacy is unique to you and your family. While it includes important charitable planning goals and gifting strategies, it goes well beyond the monetary aspects to include passing down the values, experiences, hard work and memories that define your life and are important to you and your family in a way that's meaningful to you.

**Incapacity planning** helps you prepare for unexpected events at every stage of your life from naming a guardian for your minor children, to who will manage your affairs if you're no longer able to do so yourself, to the type of care you will you receive and who will oversee your care.

#### MYTH #3: "A will can oversee the distribution of all of my assets."

A will is a legal document that instructs how your property will be distributed after your death. It allows you to name an executor, who is your personal representative charged with overseeing the distribution of your property and

shepherding it through the probate process. Probate is the process that's required to validate your will and transfer your assets.

However, certain assets may sit outside of your will. These include life insurance policies or qualified retirement accounts (401(k)s, IRAs, etc.) that have a beneficiary designation, as well as assets or accounts with a pay-on-death (POD) or a transfer-on-death (TOD) designation. These assets transfer directly to the named beneficiaries and are not subject to probate. This is why it's so important to review your account beneficiary designations annually or whenever changes in your life occur. For example, if you divorce and remarry and fail to update the beneficiary designation on your IRA account to your new spouse, your ex-spouse would receive those assets upon your death. Even if your will and/or trust names your current spouse as the beneficiary or co-trustee, since these assets sit outside of your will or a trust, they are not governed by those documents.

In addition to a will, it's important to work with the right estate attorney to draw up other important legal documents to protect your interests and the interest of your dependents and/or heirs. These include:

- A Durable Power of Attorney is where you name and empower your "agent" to carry out any legal and/or financial decisions that have to be made on your behalf during your lifetime if you are unable to act on your own behalf. Unlike other powers of attorney extending specific or limited powers to a named agent, a durable power of attorney doesn't end if you become incapacitated. However it should be known that, all powers of attorney end at your death.
- A Health Care Power of Attorney indicates who is empowered to make healthcare decisions on your behalf and spells out how you wish to be cared for, alleviating the burden on your family members and loved ones to make those decisions at a highly stressful and emotional time.
- A Living Will is a legal document that enables you to specify the kind of medical care you do or do not want to receive in the event of illness or incapacity.
- Trusts: While not everyone needs a trust, it can provide the confidence that you have a plan in place to help provide for the safe and accountable management of family assets and to direct their use and distribution in accordance with your wishes and objectives. It allows while you're alive, for you to remain both the trustee and the beneficiary of the trust, maintaining control of the assets and receiving all income and benefits. Upon your death, a designated successor trustee manages and/or distributes the remaining assets according to the terms set in the trust, avoiding the probate process. In addition, should you become incapacitated during the term of the trust, your successor or co-trustee can take over its management. All trusts fall into one of two categories: revocable or irrevocable. Within these categories, many types of trusts exist to fulfill a broad range of needs and objectives.

## MYTH #4: "Once I put a plan in place, I am finished! I don't need to revisit it later."

Planning is never a "once and done" proposition. Your life, preferences and goals change over time, and may be also be impacted by outside influences, such as the financial markets, tax law changes and economic events. What if you marry or divorce, welcome a new child or grandchild, your minor children become adults, you move to another state, or experience the death of a spouse? All of these changes need to be reflected in your estate planning. That's why it's important to periodically review and update your estate planning documents, including your beneficiary designations and how your various accounts are titled!



#### **Falls and Balance**

Have you wondered why everyone talks about falls? If you have ever been to therapy, one of the first questions your therapist will ask you is how many falls have you had in the last 6 months? We all know that falls can result in injuries, but did you realize that one in four people over the age of 65 fall each year? Falls result in more than 2.8 million injuries treated in emergency departments annually, including over 800,000 hospitalizations and more than 27,000 deaths. Now that I have your attention, I would like to educate you on ways to improve your balance and prevent falls.

We have three very complex systems in our body that determine our balance. To keep it simple, they are the feeling of your feet on the floor, your inner ear, and your vision. As we age and/or develop other disease processes such as diabetes, the feeling in our feet diminishes and our brains are not provided good feedback from our feet; therefore, this system's accuracy diminishes over time.

When you think about your inner ear, think back when you were a child and you would spin yourself in circles until you felt dizzy and possibly fell down. Children tend to enjoy constantly simulating their inner ear and challenging balance but most adults don't enjoy being spun around in circles to the point of feeling sick.

The last system is your vision, and as we age, we tend to rely on our vision to help keep our balance more than the previous two systems. Now you might be thinking to yourself, but my vision has worsened as I have aged and for many this is true, but this is why it is imperative to always have good lighting during any activity. Humans tend to be more near sighted in low light situations; therefore, anytime you are up moving around without good lighting, your balance will be compromised. If you get up to go to the bathroom in the middle of the night, turn on the lights because the brighter the better. Trying to feel your way in the dark will only put you at a much higher risk of falls.

Staying active and strong, along with changing a few things throughout your home, are some of the best ways to prevent falls. Before starting any exercise program please consult your medical doctor to determine if it is safe for you to begin an exercise program. Staying active and strong doesn't have to be hard or boring. You can join the gym, start a mall walking group, take those dancing classes you always wanted to do or do anything you enjoy that gets you up and moving and improves the strength of your muscles. When patients come see us for rehab, we get them up and moving, start an exercise program and once they are stronger and getting ready to go home; we do a home visit and teach them fall recovery skills. Home visits are a vital tool in the prevention of falls for our patients. A therapist goes with you and your family member to your home and makes recommendations on how to make your home a safer environment for you. Removal of scatter rugs is probably the number one recommendation we make to patients on how to improve their safety from falls at home but other suggestions may be moving furniture, decluttering your home or installing grab bars in your bathroom.

Fall recovery is a discussion we have with almost every patient that comes to our facility prior to discharging home. Did you know that if it takes you more than one hour to get up from a fall that your risk of death from the fall doubles? We take fall recovery and prevention very seriously because we want all our patients to be safe, healthy and active. Please remove your scatter rugs, because all it takes is catching your toe on it once and you could sustain a hip fracture or even worse injuries. Talk to your doctor about starting an exercise program to ensure you stay strong and active. If you don't know much about exercise, there are many resources to get you started. You could go to your local gym for assistance using exercise equipment or you could have a physical therapy consult to target specific aspects of your balance and muscle strength. Either way, be safe and get moving!

Stimulus Payment Merry-Go-Round

A third round of stimulus payments are on their way. But has your second one shown up yet? Next question: Did you file last year's 2019 taxes on paper instead of e-filing? If so, that might well be the reason you don't have your money yet.

The IRS got behind on processing the paper tax forms we sent a year ago. If all had gone well, those who were eligible should have received a \$600 stimulus check (the second one) by Jan. 29, 2021.

The IRS has a specific page for you to check the status of your stimulus payment, but it's only good for the third stimulus check. All information for your first and second stimulus money has been removed from their website.

Confused yet? You're not alone.

Start with www.irs.gov/coronavirus/get-my-payment and scroll to Get My Payment. Click on it and fill out the information. You'll go to a page that tells you the status of the payment you're to receive now, the third payment. If it says that payment information is Not Available,

it means you're not going to receive a payment

the easy way (and might be why your second

payment is still missing). On the Get My Pay-

ment page, click on Frequently Asked Ques-

tions to see what applies to you. Even if you don't normally file, you'll need to file for 2020 (preferably e-file) if you want that stimulus money quickly. Look for Line 30 on the Form 1040 or 1040-SR. It's called the Recovery Rebate Credit. If you received Notice 1444 or 1444B in the mail from the IRS, it will tell you what figures to use.

If you did receive the money but your financial situation has changed and you should have received a different amount, click on Recovery Rebate Credit.

#### How to Help Your **Elderly Parent with** Their Finances

Dear Savvy Senior,

What tips can you offer on helping an elderly parent with their finances? My 84-year-old father is having trouble keeping up with his bills and insurance, and I just found out that he's been making contributions to a suspicious charity.

Dear Reluctant,

Many adult children serve as financial helpers to their elderly or ill parents. They provide services like paying bills, handling deposits and investments, filing insurance claims, preparing taxes and more. Here are some tips and resources that can help you help your dad.

#### Start with a Conversation

Taking on the task of helping an elderly parent with their finances can be a sensitive and difficult topic. The first step in helping your dad is to have a respectful talk with him expressing your concerns, as you stated in your question, and offering to help him with his financial chores. If you have siblings, it can be a good idea to get them involved too. This can help you head off any possible hard feelings, plus, with others involved, your dad will know everyone is concerned.

#### Get Organized

If your dad is willing to let you help manage, monitor or take over his financial affairs your first order of business is to get organized by making a list of his financial accounts and other important information. Your list should include his:

- Contact list: Names and numbers of key contacts like insurance agents, financial advisor, tax preparer, family attorney, etc.
- Monthly bills: Phone, cable, water and trash, gas, electric, credit card accounts, etc.
- Financial accounts: Including bank accounts, brokerage and mutual fund accounts, safe-deposit boxes and any other financial assets he has. Also get usernames and passwords for financial accounts that are set up online.
- Company benefits: Any retirement plans, pensions or health benefits from his current or former employer.
- Insurance policies: Life, home, auto, long-

term care, Medicare, etc. • Taxes: Copies of your dad's income tax returns over the past few years.

#### **Locate Important Documents**

This is also the ideal time to find out if your dad has the following essential legal documents: A will; an advance directive that includes a living will and healthcare proxy, which allows you or another family member or friend to make medical decisions on his behalf if he becomes incapacitated; and a durable power of attorney, which gives you or a designated person similar legal authority for financial decisions, if needed.

If he doesn't have these important documents prepared, now is the time to do it. And if they are prepared, make sure they're updated, and you know where they're located.

#### **Simplify Financial Tasks**

The quickest way to help your dad simplify his monthly financial chores is to set up automatic payments for his utilities and other routine bills and arrange for direct deposit of his income sources.

If your dad has savings and investments scattered in many different accounts, you should consider consolidating them. You can also set up your dad's bank system and investment accounts online, so you can pay bills and monitor his accounts anytime.

#### **Set Up Protections**

To guard against scams and risky financial behaviors, consider getting your dad a True Link Visa Prepaid Card (TrueLinkFinancial.com/card). Designed for older adults with cognitive issues this card would provide your dad access to his money but with restrictions that you set on how funds can be spent. Or check out EverSafe.com, a web-based service that will automatically monitor your dad's accounts, track suspicious activity and alert you when a problem is detected.

#### Seek Help

If you need help or live far away, consider hiring a daily money manager (see AADMM.com) who can come in once or twice a month to pay bills, make deposits, decipher health insurance statements and balance his checkbook. Fees range between \$60 and \$150 per hour.
