



# SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week nine of our study of our United States Constitution. This week we continue with the consideration of veto power in Article I – Section 7 – Clause 2 which reads "If after such Reconsideration two thirds of that House shall agree to pass the Bill, it shall be sent, together with the Objections, to the other House, by which it shall likewise be reconsidered, and if approved by two thirds of that House, it shall become a Law. But in all such Cases the Votes of both Houses shall be determined by Yeas and Nays, and the Names of the Persons voting for and against the Bill shall be entered on the Journal of each House respectively.

If any Bill shall not be returned by the President within ten Days (Sundays excepted) after it shall have been presented to him, the Same shall be a Law, in like Manner as if he had signed it, unless the Congress by their Adjournment prevent its Return, in which Case it shall not be a Law."

Article I – Section 7 – Clause 3 is linked with Clause 2 and reads "Every Order, Resolution, or Vote to which the Concurrence of the Senate and House of Representatives may be necessary (except on a question of Adjournment) shall be presented to the President of the United States; and before the Same shall take Effect, shall be approved by him, or being disapproved by him, shall be repassed by two thirds of the Senate and House of Representatives, according to the Rules and Limitations prescribed in the Case of a Bill."

In the event of a presidential veto, the president will send the bill back to the House of Representatives with his or her objections. If the House of Representatives considers the veto, it can modify the bill to comply with the suggestions of the president and then send it to the Senate for their consideration.

If both houses are in agreement with the president's suggestions, they will send the bill back to the president for his or her consideration and signing. If the House of Representatives decides not to comply with the objections of the president, they can vote again on the bill. If two thirds of the representatives agree, the bill will be passed and forwarded to the Senate for their consideration.

The Senate can do as the House of Representatives did, and if they also agree with the contents of the bill and pass it with at least a two-thirds vote, the bill will become law which is called overriding a presidential veto. This clause grants the president ten days to review a measure passed by the Congress. If the president has not signed the bill after ten days, it becomes law without his signature.

However, if Congress adjourns during the ten-day period, the bill does not become law. Again, these clauses were designed by our founding fathers as checks and balances.

Article 1 – Section 8 has multiple clauses which are all linked together as a run-on sentence. Clause 1 reads "The Congress shall have Power To lay and collect Taxes, Duties, Imposts and Excises, to pay the Debts and provide for the common Defence and general Welfare of the United States; but all Duties, Imposts and Excises shall be uniform throughout the United States;..."

The House of Representatives has the authority to initiate financial bills, but both houses of Congress, have the responsibility together to jointly agree upon the final version of such bills. It is the responsibility of the President of the United States to administer these laws for the military and general welfare of the country. Next week, Lord willing, we will continue our study of the Constitution with Article 1 – Section 8.

### ● FISCAL STRESS MONITORING ●

The Office of the State Comptroller uses the Fiscal Stress Monitoring System to examine the annual financial information reported by your Village. This analysis provides an objective assessment of the fiscal challenges facing individual local governments and school districts, identifying situations where corrective action may be needed. These 2020 scores are based on end-of-year results — and thus generally provide a baseline measurement of local governments' ability to respond to the ongoing public health crisis and the related financial uncertainty. We expect that these factors will be reflected in reports in 2021 and beyond.


