# Aitkin's City Park compromise should lead to all ages welcome

By ANN SCHWARTZ Improvements to Aitkin's City Park are in the eye of the beholder. A new hockey rink, with pickle ball courts, is almost ready for summer.

The Aitkin City Council voted earlier in April to demolish the existing skate park, which needs repairs, and replace it with additional pickle ball courts so tournaments could be hosted.

Pickle ball is a game similar to tennis, played with paddles and a plastic ball. It is very

popular with active senior citizens.

The Aitkin Skate Park is in the City Park. Originally, money was raised for its construction by grants and fundraisers by community members — including many business sponsorships

It appears now that the city council and parents will work together to find a compromise for the skate park.

Jennifer Sutch, 43, Aitkin, and her husband, Chris, often take walks through the City Park and see how much the skate park is being used. "My daughter was very upset when she heard about losing the skate park," said Sutch. "My kids enjoy skateboarding."

Sutch said parents are very excited for all the improvements at the park — including new pickle ball courts. She is all for new activities taking place but wants to preserve one of the few activities for young people in the town. "We love the park and want it to be all that it can be. We see people coming up from the Cities who use our park"

Dennis VanPortFliet, a local parent, started working on the project right away.

"I talked to Paul out of Min-

neapolis who works for the skateboard association. When it comes to fixing and repairing our concrete skate park here — it is very simple, very easy," said VanPortFliet. He are cracks and chips to fix and concrete to be replaced. "We should be able to get it done this week."

The NewsHop-PER sent a reporter to meet with an unofficial group of parents and boarders last Saturday at the park. The young people were proud of their skills and their equipment and were willing to talk and demonstrate their agility.

Aitkin, uses a

long board "Skateboarding is cheaper than a car and more fun to ride around town," said Lathrop. Long boards are longer than a regular skateboard, with a wider wheel base and are used to travel at higher rates of speed.

Josh Lindgren, 15, Aitkin said: "Skate boarding is my life," Lindberg described his board: "I have a Denny Dun-

When a community rallies together great things can be accomplished. It appears that a compromise can be reached so pickle ball players and skateboarders can both do what they do, in harmony, side by side in a small town park.





# **Rep. Dale Lueck legislative update**

Friday, April 9th marks the deadline for budget finance bills to complete the committee hearing process in both the House and Senate. We now have several state agency budget bills to pass totaling about \$51-52 billion in state revenues and spending. Those bills will become the state's next two-year budget.

Each chamber now will bring those bills to the floor for debate and final passage. The results are sent to the other chamber for consideration. The other body may be pass the bill and send it to the governor, or may amend the bill and sent it back for reconsideration.

In most cases there are enough differences that the bills will ultimately be referred to conference committees. There, the differences will be reconciled, and the product sent back to both the House and Senate for a final up or down vote, with no amendments allowed.

During this past week, the majority in the House has added a significant amount of new tax increases to the revenue side of these bills. While current data indicates a \$1.6 billion surplus going forward and several billion dollars of new funds coming to the state from the federal government, nevertheless, unlike the Senate finance bills, the House bills contain billions in new state tax increases

The House majority's tax bill and transportation bills alone add up to about \$2.5 billion in tax hikes over the next four years. Examples include:

A gas tax increase (\$363 million over four years) by linking Minnesota's gas tax to the Highwav Construction Cost Index, resulting in an automatic annual inflationary gas tax increase.

A half-percent Metro sales tax increase to fund light rail and other transit (\$916 million over four years).

A Motor Vehicle Sales Tax increase (\$120 million over four vears). Vehicle registration tax increase (\$149 million over four years).

increases (\$10.7 million over four years).

The tax bill adds a brand-new

5th tier income tax of 11.15%, giving Minnesota the 2nd highest top income tax rate in the country. That raises state income taxes by more than \$1 billion, but fails to fully protect businesses from Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) tax hikes on forgiven federal loans.

Working with the Senate, I believe these unwarranted tax increases will not go forward. We need to allow our economy to fully recover and get this pandemic behind us.


