Boji Bantam now a 'Go'

While the Okoboji Summer Theatre's 2021 season is still somewhat undecided, with five of six contracts still awaiting New York sign-offs, there is good news for the Boji Bantam Children's Theatre.

A couple weeks back OST executive director Ruth Ann Burke told us there was a fair probability that there would be no Bantam shows this year, due not only to COVID restrictions, but to perhaps not having a large enough cast available to make it happen. Now, both are worked out -- if the five remaining contracts are agreed to. Burke explained over the weekend that more students than expected wanted to be a part of the 63rd Stephens College summer on the campus of the UofO this year, and the Bantam will be taking its two summer shows 'on the road' this year -- or at least "over the hill" -- to the Pearson Lakes Art Center's amphitheater on the building's north side, overlooking a wideopen green space, and possibly even some small wildlife....


The Art Center's Bob Kirschbaum said the Art Center has always worked well with the OST, and looks forward to providing the stage for The Velveteen Rabbit and Sideways Stories from Wayside School, which should each enjoy a oneweek run. "We have always worked together and we support each other very well. While all the departments at the UofO are top notch, the Fine Arts Department is at the very top -- due in part to our frequent cooperation." Stagerat

In our last chat on-the-air he played paradiddles (a drummer's exercise his doctor told him would be a good to aid in his rehabilitation following a stroke.) To prove he was doing his rehab, Hamp did the exercises on-the-air! His career spanned the decades from the days when Benny Goodman was the "King Of Swing," in the '40s, well through the Rock era. It was in the mid-fifties that he recorded one of his top-selling efforts with tenor saxophonist Stan Getz. One cut was a duet on a medley that included Tenderly, Autumn in New York, East of the Sun..., and I Can't Get Started...

The Platters' 1958 Mercury album, Twilight Time, clocked in at Number One on the pop charts in April 1958. In the beginning the song's words were only meant to be a poem, until The Three Suns composed the music. Incidentally, The Platters' alternate version -- in Spanish -- La Hora del Crepus-Culo -- translates to Twilight Hour...

Sunday will be East Meets West Day, for which RD found the Peggy Lee song, I Love Being Here With You, which begins with the line, "I Love the East, I Love the West." Co-written with Bill Schluger, the song was the hit on Lee's 1961 album Basin Street East. Diana Krall went the same musical direction in 1995, and chose the song for her CD, Only Trust Your Heart. Finally, Marilyn Maye loves the song so much she opens all of her concerts with it!

We could celebrate Virginia-born Ella Fitzgerald's natal day on Sunday, which would have been her 104th birthday. Known as "The First Lady of Song," among many other titles, Ella had dozens, if not hundreds, of great albums. Her well-received 1955 Decca studio album, Songs in a Mellow Mood, includes jazz standards such as I'm Glad There Is You, You leave Me Breathless, and People Will Say We're In Love...

Tumbling Twins

I headed up to Target Field for the first time in over 20 months on Tuesday with two of my assistant basketball coaches to watch the Minnesota Twins take on the Boston Red Sox. Dalton Perrin is a huge Red Sox fan, somehow, we still get along, and Adam Gisch made the trek with me as we met close high school friend Ryan Naatjes for the game and a quick guys' get-away. The game was a total microcosm of what has become the Twins' season so far, with Minnesota jumping ahead early with two first-inning runs, only to see the bats go quiet when runners got on base, and then watch the bullpen waste a quality start, as the Red Sox rallied with runs in the eighth and ninth innings to pull out the 4-2 win, costing me a \$20 bet with Dalton!

The Twins started the season at 5-2 with their only two losses coming in extra-inning games where they also blew late leads. Since that quality start, the Twins are 1-6 and have gone from first place to fourth place in the American League Central. One major reason the Twins are struggling is that the middle of their order has been just terrible at the plate, with Jorge Polanco hitting .167, Mitch Garver batting .200 and Miguel Sano an abysmal .116. Minnesota is counting on these three to drive in runs, and so far, that just hasn't happened. Another reason for the slow start is inconsistent pitching from middle reliever Randy Dobnak, who is 0-3 with an awful 11.88 ERA, and closer Alex Colome, who has blown two saves and has an ERA of 5.88. While no one expects these two to be perfect, if they were just average so far, the Twins would be at least 9-5 and would be in first place.

Minnesota has not played since losing to the Angels 10-3 Friday night due to COVID-19 testing and tracing protocols, so at least they haven't lost in a few days. There have definitely been some bright spots so far this season; Byron Buxton (.469) has been amazing at the plate and in the field, Luis Arraez (.304) has also been very consistent, along with newcomer Andrelton Simmons (.355), and hopefully getting Josh Donaldson back off the injured list will help provide some pop in the lineup. Starting pitching has also been very solid for the Twins, as Michael Pineada (1.00 ERA), Jose Berrios (3.38 ERA), Kenta Maeda (3.07 ERA) and J.A. Happ (3.12 ERA) have all done their jobs for the most part and have normally left their starts with leads. Taylor Rodgers has also been great out of the bullpen and is yet to give up an earned run. This team definitely has the talent to win their third straight American League Central title but they need to get things figured out sooner than later or they will fall back too far in a talented division.





Family Nature Night

Have you ever wondered what happened when lightening struck in the wild and started a fire with no one to put it out?

You can learn about wildfire and its place in nature on Friday April 23 during our Fire on the Prairie themed Family Nature Night. This program will meet in the amphitheater just outside the Nature Center on the south side. This event will have two time slots at 5:00pm and at 7:00pm with a limit of 10 families per program.

"We're excited to teach about wildfires and prescribed fires while emphasizing fire safety," Environmental edu-

cation coordinator, Bryanna Kuhlman said. This program will teach about wildfire and prescribed fires place in nature while also teaching about fire safety. Families will also get to learn about tools used to fight wildfires and, weather permitting, see a small example fire on the prairie.

"It's important to teach about fire in nature because it does have a place and there are many people who work to make sure fires burn safely," Kuhlman said. "To know fire can be good is important especially for the prairies."

Families will get to learn how to use bladder bags to spray water on a fake fire and use hand tools to learn how to dig a trench and change the path of the fire. They will also learn about fire safety and how prescribed fires can burn in a safe, responsible and helpful manner.

Since the program will take place outside, families will be able to social distance and don't have to wear masks unless they feel more comfortable that way. If the weather allows for a demonstration fire, families will not be in the path of the smoke, but they may still smell like they were at a bonfire afterwards.
