Career and Tech Students Help Medina PD Stay on Target

Lieutenant Todd Draper of the Medina Police Department says the department has always enjoyed their relationship with Orleans/Niagara BOCES. Not only does Lt. Draper serve on the Advisory Committee for the Security and Law Enforcement program at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center (OCTEC), the Auto Body program and the Welding program have been helping the Police Department with projects to assist in their mission.

It helps to mix the training up and make it more realistic since they will show the upper torso and head and there are also targets that represent hostages or good people. We think we will get a lot of positive response from our officers using these instead of paper targets."

Poler and Dillion Wagner were assigned the project. "It is pretty cool to

"It's rewarding, we actually get to build something and help the police department." Lt. Draper has stopped in to the class to see their progress. He says he enjoys his time with the students as they tell him what equipment and techniques they have used to make the firearm targets. "It has been very beneficial to us. We are a small department and our budget is not the largest. The targets are very expensive to buy, so having the class help us has been gratifying and beneficial for all of us."

Lt. Draper says he and the Medina Police Department would like to extend their thanks to the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center for all their time and energy. "We truly appreciate all the effort the students and teachers have put in to helping out the department. On a personal note, I really enjoy talking to the students and seeing their excitement in showing me what they have accomplished. It is great to see the sense of pride they have in their work."





COVID-19 Update: Vaccination Dates

The Genesee and Orleans County Health Departments (GO Health) have first dose Pfizer vaccination clinics with appointments available targeting those who are 16 and older and open for any New York State individuals, who reside, work or study in the state.

Currently in New York, being fully vaccinated will begin to offer opportunities that have been limited for the past year. Anyone who is fully vaccinated (2 weeks after the J&J vaccine or the second dose of Pfizer and Moderna) will be able to participate in various activities without having to be tested for entry for events such as professional sports, weddings with over 100 guests, proms, graduations and more. Also, when fully vaccinated, the individual will not have to quarantine if they are exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Most importantly, you are protecting your health along with others you come in contact with.

"We have clinics scheduled on...Saturday, April 24th at the Athletic Center at GCC Batavia Campus Center," stated Paul Pettit, Public Health Director for GO Health. "These clinics are open to anyone who is 16 and older. We want to see all of these clinics filled up with those who can also commit to returning for the second dose of the Pfizer vaccine 21 days later.'

Visit the vaccination web page at https://bit.ly/GOHealthVaccine. Choose either the GCC Pfizer Clinic or the Orleans Pfizer Clinic button and follow the directions. Keep the link handy, as there are Moderna clinics scheduled on April 27th at Ridgeway Fire Hall and on the 28th at GCC.

The buttons are live when we have that particular vaccine available. If the clinic is full or we do not have vaccine, it will show 'No Appointments Available.' We were going to work this out... until we couldn't. Ten at night and Jen was at my house so we could get him inside. She begged us not to leave him outside alone overnight. Thing is when you get a Rescue their story before you is unknown. In 2017 he was 3, maybe. He had distemper as a puppy so his head always shakes a little even when he is sleeping, but he doesn't seem to notice. It took months for Charles to allow Brian to approach him, to this day he backs up a little when approached by men. However, he is OK when he can do the approaching. Charles just doesn't like to be walked up on by other males. Strange thing is that he is totally at ease with me and I am always the one to scold or ignore. Even if he is being scolded by me he doesn't seem to mind too much. He just wants my attention. One thing is for sure, he is loyal to a fault. When home he has me in his sight at all times, which makes one feel pretty safe and appreciated. He's been found outside my Sheshed in the rain because he doesn't want me out there alone. He loves dinner and treat time and is very food motivated. He may not be smart about many things, but he knows when it's time to eat and will remind you mercifully. As he moves about it looks like he is skipping, but he does not have the agility to jump up or on things. If you have a rescue with little quirks don't you wonder what life was life before your home became their home? So many animals out there need homes, love, understanding and patience. If you truly make your Rescue a part of your indoor family, then you come to know that their love and loyalty makes your heart grow 10 times bigger and the blessings of sharing love, home and security go both ways.
