Let's go on an adventure together....to San Francisco!

I cannot tell you how happy it has made me to write about and relive my past adventures this past year or so in these articles. Because of Covid, I have not been on a major adventure since January, 2020! But, I go somewhere in my imagination every couple of weeks with you all and get to remember all the amazing things I have seen and done – pre-Covid! I was concerned I'd run out of things to write about before I could get back into going to new and exciting places, but I'm still here and still at it!

This time, we're going to San Francisco together. I have written about parts of my 2017 West Coast Adventure a couple of times before. Part of that trip included five days in the San Francisco area after the cruise ended. This was actually the second time I visited San Francisco. Many years ago, I tacked on a long weekend at the end of a business trip to Los Angeles so I could visit a friend who lived near Sacramento. I stayed at the Cow Hollow Inn on the corner of Lombard and Steiner Streets (eight blocks up Steiner from that corner is the house from Mrs. Doubtfire – Robin Williams actually owned and lived in that house, until he got tired of people knocking on the door and asking for **Mrs. Doubtfire**). Mitzy at Orleans Travel got me a great deal on the room through Expedia and it was a large, bright, clean room with very friendly and helpful front desk staff. It was also in a great location for getting around, too. I recommend it, if you're looking for a hotel in San Francisco. And, while I'm making some recommendations, I had the BEST breakfast EVER at the Home Plate Restaurant on Lombard Street – about 1/2 a block down from Steiner. A must try if looking for a great breakfast.

I took advantage of a 48 hour Gray Line Hop-On-Hop-Off ticket to get around the city the first two days. It was an inexpensive way to hear a bit about the city from several different tour guides (one in particular that was WAY cool – he'd have fit in perfectly in the '60s) and it gave me a ride up on the top of an open bus in the warm sunshine to just about anywhere, whenever I wanted to go somewhere for 48 hours. I also had two day trips booked – one to Muir Woods / Sausalito and another to Sonoma / Napa Valley – I'll write about those adventures another time.

I loved every minute of my time in San Francisco – it is a colorful and exciting city with so much to see and do. I was told afterwards that I should have been a bit more cautious in my typical way of wandering around all independent, like I'm invincible, but I had a great time. The architecture everywhere you look is just incredible and, of course, the Golden Gate Bridge is an awesome sight – it was all like a magical playground for someone with a camera around her neck!

Just a few highlights – not counting the two day trips that I'll do another article about another time:

Definitely loved "The Haight" – a neighborhood made famous during the Summer of Love in 1967. Talk about colorful and eclectic – it's an old hippie's dream! Hahaha! I saw where Jimi Hendrix, Janis Joplin, The Grateful Dead, The Beatles, and many others lived or hung out during the Summer of Love. And, of course, I took a selfie on the corner of Haight and Ashbury Streets. It was made extra special because I was there in 2017 – the 50th anniversary of the Summer of Love, so there were extra cool things to see around The Haight and in Golden Gate Park.

Fisherman's Wharf was also where I picked up the bus that took me to the Coastal Starlight Train that I took to Seattle when I was done with San Francisco.

Another awesome place I think everyone visiting San Francisco should see is the Japanese Tea Garden in Golden Gate Park. It was absolutely stunning – the flowers and the gardens and the peaceful settings throughout made for the perfect way for me to spend my last day in San Francisco. I strolled through the gardens and relaxed near peaceful koi ponds and had a lovely lunch with delicious Jasmine tea. Do yourself a favor – if in San Francisco, plan at least a couple hours or so in the Japanese Tea Garden, as well as the rest of Golden Gate Park.

I'm so glad I allowed a full five days to explore San Francisco and the surrounding area. The seven day cruise was amazing, the overnight train ride to Seattle was really cool, and the few days I spent in Seattle were very nice.....but, those days in San Francisco were really quite special, in deed.

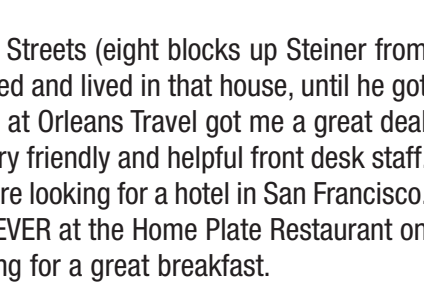

Dos and Don'ts of Caring for Wedding and Engagement Rings

Jewelry is a key component of weddings. The financial resource CreditDonkey notes that, in the United States, the average amount spent on an engagement ring is \$5,500, while Canadians spend an average of \$3,500. Jewelry costs can add up, especially when adding in the cost of wedding bands, which can cost as much as \$1,000. The cost of jewelry only underscores the importance of learning how to care for it and preserve its value.

The best way to maintain jewelry depends on the makeup of the rings. The online jewelry guide Jewelry Notes says gold rings without gemstones can be cleaned effectively with only soap and water. Simply prepare a solution of lukewarm water and mild dish soap in a small bowl. Soak the rings for 20 to 30 minutes. Use a soft brush or cloth to clean the jewelry of dirt. Rinse the residue under clean water.

Rings with diamonds can be treated similarly with a mild soap-and-water solution. The Diamond Information Center also says to soak the diamond ring in equal parts cold water and ammonia for half an hour and let it air dry. Brand name jewelry cleaner also is another good option. This method only should be used with diamonds; ammonia can't be used with other gemstones.

Maintaining jewelry also should include twice yearly visits to a jeweler who can check the prongs and make sure the setting is not loose; otherwise, the diamond can become dislodged, according to Martha Stewart Weddings.

Avoid touching diamonds and other gemstones as much as possible when putting rings on and taking them off. Precious stones often are magnets for dust, dirt and body oil, according to Taylor Lanore, diamond consultant and engagement ring designer for Lauren B. Fine Jewelry and Diamonds. Grab the ring by the band.

Use discretion when wearing rings while engaging in hands-on activities. Activities like cleaning dishes, moving furniture, gardening, or diving through waves at the beach warrant caution; otherwise, you risk damaging or making jewelry unnecessarily dirty. Store the ring in a safe location until you can safely wear it again.

One of the most important steps to safeguard wedding and engagement rings is to insure the jewelry. The description of the ring, its cut, carat weight, metal, and other information offered through a certified independent jewelry appraisal will be needed to insure the ring. Take a close-up photo of the jewelry as well. Other items like laser inscription or a home security system can qualify jewelry owners for discounts on insurance. Consumers also can add a jewelry rider to a homeowner's or renter's insurance policy.

These are some ways to care for wedding jewelry. Always consult with a jeweler before attempting to clean items made of various materials. ■

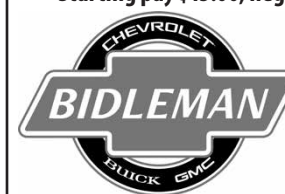

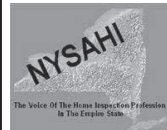

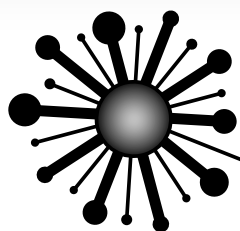

This notice announces that, on or about May 7, 2021, Heritage Wind, LLC (Applicant) will file a Joint Application for wetlands and related permits, including a request for a Water Quality Certification (WQC), with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and New York State Office of Renewable Energy Siting (ORES) relating to the proposed 184.8 megawatt (MW) wind-powered electric generation project (of up to 33 wind turbines and related components) to be located in the Town of Barre, Orleans County.

The Applicant previously submitted an application under Section 94-c of the New York Executive Law seeking a Major Renewable Energy Facility Permit from ORES. The Joint Application that is the subject of this notice covers the permits/approvals required to construct and/or operate the Project under the Clean Water Act § 404 from the USACE and for Water Quality Certification (19 NYCRR § 900-1.4) from ORES. No public comment period is required for the Joint Application at this time.

The Joint Application includes, among other things: a description of the Project, including details on Project components, Project design, Project construction, and related information; an analysis of the environmental setting of the Project; results from analyses conducted to assess potential impacts to aquatic resources, streams and jurisdictional waters from construction and operation of the Project; proposed measures to minimize environmental impacts; and reasonable alternatives. The Application also addresses compliance with the Endangered Species Act and the Historic Preservation Act.

The Project will have the following environmental impacts relevant to the Joint Permit Application under review. Construction of the Facility will temporarily disturb 0.83 acre(s) of wetlands in the project area (0.41 acre(s) of state-regulated wetlands); only 0.19 acre(s) will be permanently disturbed, 0.18 acre(s) of which are state-regulated. In addition, the Facility will result in 1.73 acre(s) of permanent forest conversion and 15.0 acre(s) of total impacts to state-regulated 100-foot wetland adjacent areas.

Pursuant to the ORES Section 94-c regulations, this notice is being provided in accordance with 19 NYCRR § 900-1.4(b)(3), and will be published at least three (3) days prior to the filing of the Joint Application with ORES. Burger season gets fired-up

As the mercury rises, the opportunities to cook a greater number of meals on the grill increases. For many people, there's nothing like the smoke-kissed flavor of meats, poultry and vegetables seared over an open flame.

Hamburgers are a grilling staple in many households. Burger flavors and toppings are only limited by a home cook's imagination.

For those who may need a little burger inspiration, this recipe for "Barbecue Chipotle Burgers" courtesy of the Iowa Beef Council features a beer-based homemade barbecue sauce and is best served on Texas Toast for an extra burst of flavor.

Barbecue Chipotle Burgers

Makes 4 servings



- 1 pound ground beef (93 percent lean or leaner)
- 1/2 cup beer
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons ketchup
- 1 tablespoon minced chipotle peppers in adobo sauce
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 4 slices frozen Texas Toast
- 2 spears pickled okra, sliced

To prepare barbecue sauce, combine beer, brown sugar, ketchup, chipotle peppers, and Worcestershire sauce in saucepan; bring to a boil. Simmer 8 to 10 minutes until sauce is thickened; set aside.

Lightly shape ground beef into four 1/2-inch thick patties. Place patties on grid over medium, ash-covered coals. Grill, covered, 8 to 10 minutes (over medium heat on preheated gas grill, covered, 7 to 9 minutes) until instant-read thermometer inserted horizontally into center registers 160 F, turning occasionally. (Cooking times are for fresh or thoroughly thawed ground beef. Ground beef should be cooked to an internal temperature of 160 F. Color is not a reliable indicator of ground beef doneness.)

Meanwhile, prepare Texas Toast according to package directions. Cut each piece of toast in half. Fresh Texas toast, buttered, may be used instead of frozen product.

For each sandwich, spread 1 tablespoon barbecue sauce over one toast half. Top with burger, another tablespoon sauce and okra slices. Close sandwich.

Cook's Tip: Dill pickle chips or pickled jalapeño peppers may be substituted for pickled okra. ■
