SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week fifteen of our study of the United States Constitution. Article I – Section 9 – Clause 8 reads "No Title of Nobility shall be granted by the United States: And no Person holding any Office of Profit or Trust under them, shall, without the Consent of the Congress, accept of any present, Emolument, Office, or Title, of any kind whatever, from any King, Prince, or foreign State."

Our founding fathers did not want anyone to be called "Prince", "Duke" or any other title of nobility because we had just severed connections with the King of England and his aristocrats. They also did not want any elected official to accept a bribe which would influence their decisions involving policy matters.

Article I – Section 10 – Clause 1 reads "No State shall enter into any Treaty, Alliance, or Confederation; grant Letters of Marque and Reprisal; coin Money; emit Bills of Credit; make any Thing but gold and silver Coin a Tender in Payment of Debts; pass any Bill of Attainder, ex post facto Law, or Law impairing the Obligation of Contracts, or grant any Title of Nobility.

Every state was expected to be loyal to the United States of America and no other country.

A "Letter of Marque and Reprisal" is the grant of authority by one country to a private party to cross into the territory of another country to seize a ship deemed by the authorizing country to be an enemy vessel or one that has traded with the enemy.

A "Bill of Attainder" is an act of a legislature declaring a person, or group of persons, guilty of some crime, and punishing them without a trial.

An "ex post facto law" is a law that retroactively changes the legal consequences of actions that were committed before the enactment of the law. I am sure that no one would like to be charged and tried for a crime for which a law was not in effect when their supposed crime was committed.

Article I - Section 10 - Clause 2 reads "No State shall, without the Consent of the Congress, lay any Imposts or Duties on Imports or Exports, except what may be absolutely necessary for executing it's inspection Laws: and the net Produce of all Duties and Imposts, laid by any State on Imports or Exports, shall be for the Use of the Treasury of the United States; and all such Laws shall be subject to the Revision and Controul of the Congress.

The weakness of the original "Articles of Confederation" allowed individual states to compete with one another in commerce. Our founding fathers did not want individual states to be competing with one another by laying tariffs on other states. We are supposed to be competing with other countries in commerce and not with one another which would weaken our republic.

Article I – Section 10 – Clause 3 reads "No State shall, without the Consent of Congress, lay any Duty of Tonnage, keep Troops, or Ships of War in time of Peace, enter into any Agreement or Compact with another State, or with a foreign Power, or engage in War, unless actually invaded, or in such imminent Danger as will not admit of delay."

To "Lay any Duty of Tonnage" was to charge a ship according to its weight. It was a tax levied by a state for a ship to use one of its ports. During the American Civil War, the Confederate States of America established a military which was in direct conflict with our United States Constitution and eventually led to war.

We have now completed our study of Article I of our Constitution and, Lord willing, we will begin Article II of our study next week.

Good Day Keshequa Community,

The Keshequa School District has some great news for the community! As described in previous articles, "the Capital Project", which the voters approved in 2018, had a significant amount of money left over. The bids from contractors came in very reasonably due to the timing of the bid process. With that savings the District has been able to move forward with a phase two and address some additional needs that we have identified since the project began.

Yesterday a meeting was held where another round of bids was opened to address those needs. After opening the bids we are now in a position to replace seven rooftop heating and ventilation units, which are more than 20 years old and have reached the end of their useful life. The District will also address the drainage issue at the Dalton building, which has become a safety issue as well as modernizing the nurse's office space, which is in need of a significant makeover.

Additionally, the District will address changing the exterior lighting at both buildings to LED lighting. This will help the District see significant savings in energy costs. We will also resurface the tennis and basketball courts on the Nunda campus.
