mama cat, we have great news. As we discussed the busy kitten season we are having, we decided to increase our spay/ neuter assistance amounts. Beginning Wednesday, May

19th and continuing through June 30th, the amount of the spay/neuter rebates will increase to \$100 for City of Danville residents and \$75 for Pittsylvania County residents.

As always, if you own an outside cat and will continue to provide all the legally-required care of the cat on your property, please call and speak with our director at 799-5306 and we can make arrangements to pay the entire amount of the surgery itself. You must call before the surgery!

For all other animals, you must pick up the certificate at least the day before the animal is taken to the clinic for the surgery. There are additional guidelines:

The animal must belong to a resident of Danville/Pittsylvania County and must reside with the owner in Danville/Pittsylvania County.

The rebate cannot be used to sterilize any stray animal.

The certificate may not be used for any animal adopted from another shelter or rescue group or for an animal that is going to be released to another

shelter or rescue group.

If the cat is feral, there must be an owner who is prepared to provide food,

water, veterinary treatment, and shelter for the cat for its lifetime. The cat may not be released on to any public property, but must live on the property of the person trapping and releasing

The certificate must be obtained at least the day before the animal is taken to the veterinary clinic for the surgery. The certificate cannot be combined with any other DAHS program, including DAHS grant money paid to veterinary clinics.

The certificate must be used and redeemed no more than four months after the date on the certificate. No more than five certificates be obtained by the same

household during a 12 month period.

To redeem the certificate, after the certificate, mail the veterinary bill, this certificate, and a selfaddressed stamped envelope to Danville Area Humane Society, P.O. Box 3352, Danville, VA 24543. If the self-addressed, stamped envelope is not included, \$.50 will be deducted.

If the surgery costs less than the advertised rebate amount, the rebate amount will be the cost of the surgery, not including the cost of shots, flea treatment, etc.



Vintage Lunchbox

Vintage collectibles, especially those related to sports, sell quickly at auction, perhaps because not all are expensive. Sometimes they are not noticed by the dedicated sports collectors and sell at bargain prices. This metal lunchbox was made in 1976. It is decorated with the helmets of the National Football Conference on one side, and American Conference helmets on the other side.



It took only \$35 to win this lunchbox, a football sports collectible, at a Main Auction Galleries sale in Cincinnati.

Lunchbox collecting began in 1950, with the first example picturing the cowboy movie star Hopalong Cassidy. The metal boxes and matching thermos bottles remained popular until 1960, when soft plastic boxes were the style. (And it is a myth that metal boxes were replaced because students were hitting each other in the head and causing injuries.) This football collectible included a matching thermos and was an auction bargain at \$35. The King-Seely Thermos Company made many metal lunchboxes, including the one with the football helmets.

The most expensive metal lunchbox ever sold pictured "Toppie the Elephant," a Kroger grocery store figure that promoted plaid Top Value stamps. A 1957 Toppie lunchbox with thermos sold for \$2,784.

• On the TV show "Better Call • Saul," the plot included a **Hummel figurine that was so rare** that it would sell for thousands of dollars. Your comments on Hummels say they are bought for very low prices today, most under \$50. Did the show make up the story? Or is there a type of Hummel that sells for over \$1,000?

A. The "Better Call Saul" show was talking about the rarest Hummels, a group called International Figures. The characters talked about the Bulgarian figure, but the real one depicted a Bavarian figure. In 1976, eight were in a sale by Robert Miller, the author of the first Hummel price book and an expert in all things Hummel. He realized they were different from any he owned, so he made for a

dealer in Hungary before World War II. Later research claims that 24 or 26 different designs were made in the 1940s. The figures are marked with the M.I. Hummel signature used from 1935 to 1955 and mold numbers that run consecutively from 806 to 813 and others with numbers up to 968. Each figurine is depicted in its country's national dress. The thieves in the TV show wanted to steal an ordinary Hummel figurine and redecorate it to look like the famous one that has sold for thousands of dollars. The first sales were at \$20,000, but by 2013, the price for the International figure was as low as \$5,000.

UNION STREET POCKET PARK OPENS WITH CEREMONY

Mayor Alonzo Jones joined other members of City Council and local officials recently in a ribbon cutting ceremony to mark the opening of the Union Street Pocket Park in the heart of the River District.

Located at 121-123 South Union St. next to The Bee boutique hotel, the urban park provides an open space for people to gather.

"As you can see, it is a short walk from the governmental offices, the courthouse, many businesses and places of residence," Jones said. "For those who work or live nearby, and for those who come to shop, this park offers a place to step outside, take a break from their work, enjoy lunch, or simply to relax and enjoy the outdoors."

Jones said the park also will serve everyone in the city.

"Much like the nearby Main Street Plaza and JTI Fountain, in this space, you will be able to gather with family and friends, take photos by this fountain, admire the architectural features that have been preserved, and learn about the rich history of this property. It can serve as a small event space or a place for company meetings."

The park can be reserved for events by contacting the Parks and Recreation Department, which will manage the park. The park is open from dawn until dusk.

In May 2019, the Industrial Development Authority (IDA) purchased the property, which was the former Knights of Pythias Building. It was part of the original plans for The Bee hotel, but the Pythias building was deemed unsafe and demolished because of to a culvert issue under the property. Last month, the IDA donated the property to the City of Danville as construction on the park neared completion.

The building was built in the late 19th century for the New and Miller Carriage Co., which sold carriages and harnesses on the first floor. The basement was a stable where horses were tied to be watered and fed while their owners attended tobacco auctions or conducted other business downtown.

Trenda Leavitt, a landscape architect who founded Beechgrove Design in Moneta, designed the space to honor the former building's history and provide amenities for contemporary life.

"Union Street Park is a stunning space replete with historic and modern character," Leavitt said. "A stable, where horses once rested, has been reimagined into a space for people to rest; reflect on the past; enjoy trees, water, sunshine and shade; socialize; work; have a meal; and celebrate life's milestones."

The hand-laid stone wall on the west side fronting South Union Street and brick walls are part of the original walls of the New & Miller building. They were stabilized and left in their original state to show floor divisions, beam locations, staircases, and paint layers. These walls provide backdrops for photography.

An alley in the rear of the park can be reconfigured into outdoor rooms and are ideal for working, parties, meetings, lunches and dinners, dancing, and a backstage for theater or musical events.

Timber beams and steel posts are among the original materials salvaged from the original structure and have been incorporated into the park. A brick and granite mounting block has been constructed on the south wall and provides an ideal location for prom, wedding, graduation, and family photography as well as informal seating. Mounting blocks were used to mount horses.

Contemporary design elements include wheelchair lift accessibility; furniture and spaces for mobile work, outdoor dining and meetings; site furniture constructed from recycled materials and made in the USA; a tree grove; and a modern minimalist steel water sculpture designed by artist Randy Bolander of Centerport, N.Y.



COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Friday at Averett







VA Vaccine Clinic Gets a Thumbs-Up

I wasn't the only one walking down the street toward the Department of Veterans Affairs pop-up vaccine clinic. In fact, there were about six guys who were doing the same thing I was: scoping out the situation before actually getting in the drive-up line for the vaccine.

I'll say it right off the top here: The VA did this right. They did a good job on the logistics and execution. Here in town, they'd selected a location with lots of space outside. There was an army of volunteers of all kinds, laying out a traffic cone grid in the parking lot, directing cars along the rows, nurses with tablets taking information, VA medical staff giving shots through car windows. There was even an observation area where cars would park afterward (with medical staff there) in case a veteran had a bad reaction.

"Looks pretty good," said one guy as we hovered on the sidewalk and watched. A few others chimed in, agreeing. One muttered something about an expected SNAFU, but there was none of that to be seen. We stopped a couple of cars with veterans leaving after getting their shots and queried them about how it had gone. SITREP: It was great.

Now that everyone age 16 and up is eligible for the vaccine, and now that SAVE (Strengthening and Amplifying Vaccination Efforts) has opened up a long list of veteran-related people who are eligible, if you want to get the vaccine, make an appointment now. If you wait too long, the demand for vaccines will eventually slack off, and these nearby pop-up clinics will be gone.

Keep an eye on the news for VA pop-up clinics in your area. Judging by how this drive-thru clinic was run, I have confidence that the VA is doing just as well in other areas where they're giving vaccines: medical centers, community clinics, outreach centers, mobile units -- and even rural parking lots.



Lemon and Blueberry Bread



Ingredients

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- l cup suga
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1/2 cup butter melted
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 2 teaspoons lemon zest
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 11/2 cups fresh blueberries

Instructions

Begin by preheating the oven to 350 degrees F. Then spray the inside of a 9x5-inch loaf pan with baking spray. Set aside.

In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, sugar, baking powder, and salt. In a medium bowl, whisk together the eggs, milk, melted butter, sour cream, lemon zest, and vanilla extract.

Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and mix until just combined. The batter may be slightly lumpy. Gently fold in the blueberries.


Pour the batter into the prepared loaf pan, spreading it in an even layer.

Bake for 65-70 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. (If needed, cover the bread with foil to prevent overbrowning.) Allow the bread to cool completely before slicing.

Notes

I like to serve this Lemon and Blueberry Bread with a little salted butter. However, if you want to highlight the lemon flavor and make the bread even more decadent, you can whip up a glaze of confectioners' sugar and lemon juice to drizzle on the top. Simply add fresh lemon juice (You don't need much.) to a cup of confectioners' sugar until you achieve the desired drizzling consistency.
