





SPEAK OUT!!!

All letters submitted must be signed with the name, address and phone number of the author. Please make letters as brief as possible.

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week sixteen of our study of the United States Constitution. Article II – Section 1 – Clause 1 reads "The executive Power shall be vested in a President of the United States of America."

Article II contains the responsibilities and powers of the Executive Branch under the leadership of the President of the United States. Article II – Section 1 – Clause 2 reads "He shall hold his Office during the Term of four Years, and, together with the Vice President, chosen for the same Term, be elected, as follows:..."

The terms of office of the President and Vice President of the United States has been four year terms since our Constitution was formed. You will notice that the word "elected" is included as our founding fathers wanted to emphasize that the President and Vice President would be elected and not appointed or become leaders in a coup as in the case of many other countries.

Article II — Section 1 — Clause 3 reads "Each State shall appoint, in such Manner as the Legislature thereof may direct, a Number of Electors, equal to the whole Number of Senators and Representatives to which the State may be entitled in the Congress: but no Senator or Representative, or Person holding an Office of Trust or Profit under the United States, shall be appointed an Elector."

This is the origin of what is called the "Electoral College" which has been a point of contention for decades as many Americans would rather have the President and Vice-President elected by individual votes. I leave you to your own opinion on this matter. The Electoral College is formed every four years for the sole purpose of determining who will be the President and Vice-President.

It is comprised of 538 electors which is determined by adding the 438 members of the House of Representatives and the 100 members of the Senate. For the President and Vice-President to be elected, they must receive 270 electoral votes. This process became very pronounced in our lives in January 2021 when there was much controversy as to whom would become the next President and Vice-President.

Article II – Section 1 – Clause 4 reads "The Electors shall meet in their respective States, and vote by Ballot for two Persons, of whom one at least shall not be an Inhabitant of the same State with themselves. And they shall make a List of all the Persons voted for, and of the Number of Votes for each; which List they shall sign and certify, and transmit sealed to the Seat of the Government of the United States, directed to the President of the Senate.

The President of the Senate shall, in the Presence of the Senate and House of Representatives, open all the Certificates, and the Votes shall then be counted. The Person having the greatest Number of Votes shall be the President, if such Number be a Majority of the whole Number of Electors appointed; and if there be more than one who have such Majority, and have an equal Number of Votes, then the House of Representatives shall immediately chuse by Ballot one of them for President; and if no Person have a Majority, then from the five highest on the List the said House shall in like Manner chuse the President."

We saw in January 2021 how each state legislature voted in each state and then the votes were presented to Congress and the Vice-President opened the sealed votes and the votes were then counted.

Lord willing, we will continue with Article II of our Constitution regarding the Executive Branch next week.
