

# Tatanka Ska Trace **Trailhead Project**

Imagine Iowa Great Lakes and the Dickinson County Trails board are excited to announce the Tatanka Ska Trace Trailhead project which will be the focal point of where the Tatanka Ska Trace trail meets with the Spine Trail. The trailhead location is perfect as this is where the trail running north and south through the county connects with the rail trail spanning east and west.

The trailhead design is inspired by Native American beadwork and northwest Iowa's prairie landscape with a few railroad themes to tie in the rail trail. The facilities will include bathrooms, shaded resting areas with picnic tables and benches as well as a water fountain, bike work station and charging station. Overall, the project will beautify the area, consistent with the mission of Imagine Iowa Great Lakes, and create a relaxing space along the trails. "That is the goal of Tatanka Ska Trace trail, to get people out in nature and bring nature back to people," said Michele

As part of their J-term over the winter, 18 students led by instructors Brad Travis and Tyler Pedersen fashioned bike racks, a trail logo board and the top half of the trailhead tower. What does Tatanka Ska Trace mean and how did it get its name?"A 'Rail Trail Rally' was held in June 2017 and votes were cast to name the new line Tatanka Ska Trace," said Erin Reed, Executive Director of Dickinson County Trails Board. "Tatanka Ska" is Lakota Sioux for White Buffalo. The name pays homage to the Native American history in this area. They considered Spirit Lake a sacred dwelling place for the gods. The Iowa Commission on Native American Affairs was consulted and has given approval on the name.





Lakes Area Farmers Market in Spirit Lake will be opening soon. The first day is Saturday, June 5. The Farmers Market is open from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Wednesdays and Saturdays. It will remain open until October 9. This should be an excellent year for the Farmers Market with over 30 vendors. Several new vendors will help bring a bigger variety of products. One of the things you will definitely find at the Farmers Market is rhubarb. With the recent rain and warmer weather, rhubarb has been growing well. To keep your rhubarb growing, remove flowering seed heads and keep it watered when there isn't sufficient rain. A small handful of 10-10-10 fertilizer by each plant will help older plants thrive. Stop picking toward the end of June and don't pick from new or transplanted plants for the first two years.

Come to Lakes Area Farmers Market for rhubarb, asparagus, early spring produce, plants, eggs, baked items, and a variety of crafts. Save the date, June 5, to attend Lakes Area Farmers Market on the fairgrounds in Spirit Lake and see how we have grown. Then return on Wednesday or Saturday for more farm fresh items. We hope to see you there.

His passion for everything within the museum is contagious, and I knew he'd be the perfect person to guide me through. The Museum was moved to its current location a couple of years ago, and has been expertly designed to communicate the history in an interactive way. The entrance draws you in with a touchscreen that illustrates the routes many famous musicians took during their tour that included the Roof Garden Ballroom.

I found plenty of information on music played locally, but also enjoyed the statewide ballroom history I found in the museum. Did you know that Iowa had more ballrooms per capital than any other state in the United States? Ballrooms, and the music played in them, brought people and communities together. My parents even met at an Iowa ballroom! The museum is home to artifacts and history on ballrooms, musicians, DJs, radio stations, and anything else that helped shape the rock 'n roll music landscape in Iowa. It's not only a fun walk down memory lane, but also interesting to see the influences past music has had on the music we listen to today.

The Iowa Great Lakes Area has an abundance of museums that showcase history unique to Iowa and the Iowa Great Lakes Area, including the Iowa Rock 'n Roll Music Association Hall of Fame Museum. 


# Spencer now 21 for 25

and Sheldon. Algona, Storm Lake, and Humboldt earned Division II ratings...

What started as a group of school friends rehearsing in a cramped basement in Royal nearly a decade ago has blossomed into She's With *Us,* a band that already has a heavy schedule of gigs for this summer. SWU has also just made its



first recording for Route 86 Records in Milford, with plans for more, after completing a busy summer. Iesha Toft is the lead singer, with vocal assists from each of the other band members, who are: bassman Whitney Thiessen, Dave Zittritsch (Guitar), Nathan Shaughnessy (Drums), and Kerry Belgrave (Piano). This weekend will see SWU at Spencer's Deerfield Park, in the 1500 block of 14th Avenue West -- which is west of the Clay County Fairgrounds. The event is What the Truck Friday -- with Spencer's newest food truck serving in the park while the music is playing from 6-8:00. After a quick nap, SWU will chug up the highway to Saturday's Farmers Market in Arnolds Park, from 9-noon. The stage in the barn at the Little Swan Lake Winery will be filled by *The Duo Republic* on Thursday night, from 6-8:00; then by the Classic Rock group, Union City Strings, on Saturday, from 6-8:00; and by Lauren and the *Drifters*, from 4-6:00, Sunday afternoon...**Remember**, *The Dick Bauman Big* Band starts it at 7:00, on Memorial Day (Monday night) -- and The Jazzed Up Big Band of Okoboji will start its season on Tuesday night, June 8th, at 7:00... Stagerat Stan overheard a conversation at the VFW in Estherville a week or so back, when Northwest Iowa Jazz Band member and sometime's director, Brian Sexe (He'a now a 'retired' music teacher.) was talking with a friend about the 4th of July air show returning after being cancelled last year due to the pandamic. He was concerned because he wanted to see the Jazz Band provide some really rockin' music in the hanger where the pancake feed always takes place. The conversation didn't last long. It didn't have to. When the friend explained that the Chamber of Commerce had already decided the air show would take place this year, Sexe very quickly retorted, "If there's an air show, we'll be playing!" Amen! So put that on your calendar, and show up hungry. The show is free. The pancakes are great -- as is the vintage automobile display! Research director RD has found many things to celebrate this week. Like many composers and lyricists of the day, Hal David (1921 - 2012) was born in New York. He was most famous for his collaborations with composer Burt Bacharach, and associations with Dionne Warwick, and Karen and Richard Carpenter. Somehow, many music fans don't know that Bacarach wrote the lyrics for words used by many other artists' hits, including, Sarah Vaughan's, Broken-Hearted Melody, which hit the Top Ten in 1959... The Dick Van Dyke Show collected five Emmys, at the 16th annual Emmy Awards, including those for Male and Female Lead, as well as Outstanding Writing, Directing and Comedy. The show's well-known theme song was composed by Earle Hagen, but it was co-star Morey Amsterdam who came up with the seldom-heard lyrics... There are two reasons to celebrate Wednesday, as it will be Paper Airplane Day, and there'll be a Super Moon, too. (Did you hear about the first restaurant to open on the Moon? It had great food but no atmosphere!) All joking aside, in order to encompass both holidays with one tune, it has to be a big song -- like Fly Me to the Moon, written by Bart Howard. Nearly 700 versions have been recorded since the original, by Felicia Sanders, in 1954. Besides the most well-known rendition by Frank Sinatra, in 1964, Diana Krall used it on her 2002 release Live in Paris. and Curtis Stigers did likewise, on his 2017 CD with The Danish Radio Big Band... June will start out quite appropriately with Jazz Day on the first -- the day to salute jazz musicians from A to Z, as in Louis Armstrong to Si Zentner. Both recorded the popular standard Up a Lazy River, which was written by Hoagy Carmichael and Sidney Arodin in 1930. One of the earliest recordings was by Louis Armstrong and His Orchestra, in 1931. Some 30 years later Zentner used the song as the title track of his 1962 Liberty LP, and won a Grammy Award for the Best Pop Instrumental Performance!

To manage effectively, one has to be willing to do the work and take the time for recovery to happen. There's so much to learn about mental health conditions and NAMI NW IA is here to help. It's a grass-roots organization that offers classes (we have one starting June 21st here in Spencer)and support for families taught or facilitated by family members who have lived with loved ones who have mental health conditions. They have the "been there, done that" experiences that can give you compassion, the tools, support, and hope to work through your private struggles.

It takes you making that first step to contact us to get involved, to share your experience in a confidential setting, and to help yourself by being a part of a network with others who share these challenges. One of the bigger fears about mental health conditions is thinking you're alone and no one else can understand. We ask you to come out of the shadows and gain some peace in sharing your story. Who knows: you could be the lifeline for someone else who needs to know there is hope. # Cover Crops in a Drought

by Kris Kohl, Ag Engineering Specialist There has been a lot of buzz about the use of cover crops in the last few years. The benefits are:

1. They grow and pull nutrients out of the soil and into the growing biomass.

2. They protect the soil from erosion during the season when corn or soybeans are not growing. 3. They improve water quality

coming out of tile lines by reducing nitrate concentration and reducing water flow.

2021 will be a good year to evaluate how they perform in a year with moderate to severe drought (D1 to D2). The dry fall made establishment a little more difficult than normal and stands were a little more spotty, but without the heavy spring rains having done their job at protecting water quality and preventing erosion.

In normal years, the tile line flows are reduced with a rye cover crop by 4 to 5 inches during the winter and spring, reducing the overall nutrient loss. This year the soils in drought without cover crops have had no tile flow as well.

It has been a while since we have started out with lower subsoil moisture and I am concerned that every inch the cover crop uses may be one less inch for the main crop. This will be a good year to see what will happen and if we should refine our recommendations in drought. If you do experience lower overall yields do not abandon cover crops, plan to learn from it and adjust your management to do better next time.







#### **SLHS 'Art Of Welding' Creates Sculptures For Trailhead**

The DCTB was pleased to partner with the Spirit Lake High School Art of Welding class to design and create sculptures that will be included at the Tatanka Ska Trailhead. As part of their J-term over the winter, 18 students led by instructors Brad Travis and Tyler Pedersen fashioned bike racks, a trail logo board and the top half of the trailhead tower. They did an excellent job of creating unique pieces for the trailhead that will be a focal point of the trails system for many years.

Mr. Travis shared some history about the class and what was involved with this project. "This will be our 11th large scale public sculpture. Our first sculpture was the Sami Star, funded by the "Friends of the Sami Center" in 2008. That was the only sculpture not done in J-term. Since then we have completed all other sculptures in the 10-12 days of J-term from start to finish. This project challenged us to make pieces fit the top of the tower to the column of the shelter we are not making. We also made stainless steel bike racks and a large wall piece to be added to the shelter. In addition to using stainless steel we also incorporated colored plexiglass into the pieces to add color and lighting effects. We are extremely fortunate to live in a community that supports the arts and area students as much as they do. Every year we are honored to build something for the community that will stand for years to come. To be able to show what high school students are capable of on such a grand scale is awe inspiring. 


