



In February 2014, a picture of a British military dog, Colonel, was released to the media. Sadly though, it was because he had been captured by the Taliban. It is still unknown if he was ever rescued. It was reported that the military had many volunteers who wanted to rescue him, but the military leadership said that was unlikely. I do not even like to look at the picture the Taliban released because he seemed so scared.

I also never read any sad stories about what has happened to the U.S. military dogs, especially earlier than 2000.

That was when legislation was overwhelmingly passed into law and signed by President Clinton that military dogs too old to work would be allowed to be adopted instead of being euthanized (or even, horrifyingly, considered "surplus" and left in enemy territory).

The Defense Department, up until then, caged and euthanized the dogs that became too old or sick to work, according to Rep. Roscoe Bartlett, R-Md., who introduced the bill. Retired dogs could be released to civilian law enforcement agencies, but not to members of the public to avoid claims of government liability if the dog were to injure someone.

Now, the commander of the dog's last unit decides whether the dog is suitable for adoption, after considering recommendations of the unit's veterinarian. Anybody who adopts a working military dog will be required to agree not to hold the government responsible for damage, injury, or other losses after transfer of ownership.

The use of dogs by a military force is not a new idea. The Greeks and Romans actually began equipping large dogs with spike collars and sending them forward to attach the enemy. During the Middle Ages, war dogs were outfitted with armor and were used to defend caravans. Russian used ambulance dogs during the

Russo-Japanese Ward and the Italians employed dogs as sentries. Dogs were used in large numbers during World War I, mostly by the Germans, French, and Belgians, and mostly for ambulance and messenger service.

Before Pearl Harbor was attacked, the sled dog was the only working dog in the Army. However, the attack upon Pearl Harbor and the sudden entry of the United States into war stimulated interest in the use of dogs for sentry duty. By 1944, 10,425 dogs had been trained at war dog centers. Nearly 9,300 of these dogs were used for sentry duty.

The wonderful characteristics dogs have – devotion to man, acute senses and speed – proved to be of great value for the military.

Countless American lives were saved by the service of these dogs during World War II, and dogs were also used to protect American troops during the Korean Conflict, Viet Nam War, and Operation Desert Storm. They are trained to recognize booby traps, mines, and weapons caches. They have warned troops about ambushes, and they have dragged wounded soldiers to safety. Tragically, many of the dogs were killed during the wars. Many of the dogs were declared "surplus armaments" and were euthanized. We are grateful for their service.



## CITY RECEIVES \$740,000 FROM STATE FOR RIVERFRONT PARK

The City of Danville has received \$740,000 from the

Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation for

construction of the Riverfront Park to be located adjacent to the White Mill on four acres of the former Dan River Mills property.

With the addition of these funds, \$7.2 million has been raised from public and private sources, including foundations, businesses and corporations, and individuals. Contributions are still being solicited and can be made by contacting the Parks and Recreation Department at (434) 799-5200.

"I am thankful to Delegate Danny Marshall for introducing an amendment to the state budget to help pay for the Riverfront Park and to Senator Frank Ruff for supporting it in the Senate," Mayor Alonzo Jones said today. "The park will be a great amenity for the people of Danville and the region."

Bill Sgrinia, director of the Parks and Recreation Department, said he is thankful for the state's support and recognition of the importance of the Riverfront Park to the work that has been already been done by the private and public sectors in the city.

American National Bank, through a random drawing, awarded two Graduate of Distinction students with a \$1,000 scholarship each, totaling a \$2,000 contribution. The Galileo winner is Kacie Whitley and the GWHS winner is Ny'Asia Stephens. "This past year has been challenging for our students," stated Superintendent Angela Hairston. "Today we recognize and celebrate students who have persevered, students who have overcome the difficulties associated with COVID-19 classroom restrictions, and students who faced these obstacles head-on in spite of inconveniences. Congratulations to our 2020-2021 Graduates of Distinction on a job well done." "The Riverfront Park is a true regional park that is being designed as the premier downtown public space," Sgrinia said. "It is hoped that quality public spaces like this will continue to spur future investment. We greatly appreciate our state level officials championing this effort."

The park is in the fundraising and engineering phase and will include an urban splash pad that will double as an artistic fountain, small performance area, river overlook, custom playground area, and river access.

The original cost estimate for construction was \$10.1 million, but Sgrinia said that figure could go higher because material and labor costs have risen.

The \$7.2 million raised includes a \$4 million challenge grant from the Danville Regional Foundation. On Tuesday night, the City Council adopted a budget for the next fiscal year, which begins July 1, that sets aside gap funding up to \$4 million. The gap funding will allow construction bids to be sought this fall.

Under the current timeline, construction would begin next spring, with completion in the spring or summer of 2023.


Besides construction of the Riverfront Park, the Parks and Department will oversee plans for a whitewater channel, restoration of the mill bridge, and extension of the Riverwalk Trail on the south bank of the river in front of the White Mill building. These projects are not included in the Riverfront Park construction cost estimates.

The whitewater channel will use much of the old canal system visible in front of the White Mill. It is being designed to allow control of the amount of water coming through the canal, which will make it appropriate for tubing, whitewater paddling, competitions and river rescue trainings.

The mill bridge that crosses the river from the White Mill building to the former Long Mill site will be converted to a pedestrian bridge to connect the Riverwalk Trail on the north and south banks of the river. The Industrial Development Authority will use grants to abate asbestos and lead paint and remove the bridge's metal panels.

An easement over approximately 1.12 acres of land fronting the Dan River will allow for the extension of the Riverwalk Trail.

she worked for Corning Glass for many years until retirement and was a member of Community Baptist Church. Faith and Family were foremost in Joyce's life.



dried cranberries, bacon, sunflower seeds, and onion in a large bowl.

In a separate, small bowl, whisk together mayo, sour cream, vinegar, sugar, salt, and pepper until smooth and well-combined. Pour dressing over broccoli combination and toss or stir well.

Broccoli salad may be served immediately, but for best flavor refrigerate for at least one hour before serving. Make sure to toss broccoli salad thoroughly again before serving. Keep refrigerated if not consuming right away.
