

People who work or volunteer in the animal welfare field generally have strong opinions of the issues related to animals. Each side sincerely believes that their opinion is better for the animals. Sometimes, those opinions can turn into contentious committee meetings at the General Assembly.

Such was the case a few years ago. A few controversial bills had been introduced, and we went to Richmond to testify at the House Agriculture Subcommittee, the House Agriculture Committee, and the Senate Agriculture Committee. Testimony about certain bills evoked lots of emotion. As SB 1001 was introduced by Senator Bill Stanley in the Senate Agriculture Committee, the chairman asked if anyone wanted to speak in opposition to the bill. No one came forward, and the committee members seemed rather surprised that we spoke with one voice. Upon reflection, they were very relieved.

As introduced, the bill prevented the sale of dogs and cats at flea markets, store parking lots, etc. It was a bill that we had hoped for many years would become law. The bill passed the Senate committee, the full Senate, and then the House Agriculture Subcommittee, and then the full House. Governor McAuliffe signed it into law.

Virginia Code 3.2-6508.1 reads:
A. It is unlawful for any person to sell, exchange, trade, barter, lease, or display for a commercial purpose any dog or cat on or in any roadside, public right-of-way, parkway, median, park, or recreation area; flea market or other outdoor market; or commercial parking lot, regardless of whether such act is authorized by the landowner.

Some people did express concern about adoption fairs and other issues, so there were exceptions placed in the law.

It does not apply to: 1. The display of dogs or cats by or the adoption of dogs or cats from a humane society or private or public animal shelter as those terms are defined in § 3.2-6500; 2. The display of dogs or cats as part of a state or county fair exhibition, 4-H program, or similar exhibition or educational program; 3. The sale, exchange, or trade of dogs that are sold primarily for use in commonly-accepted hunting or livestock farming activities; or 4. A prearranged sale between a dog breeder and a specific individual purchaser. Such prearranged sale shall not take place at a regularly-occurring event such as a flea market or other organized trade venue.

A lot of animal neglect and cruelty has resulted from the sale of all companion animals at flea markets, as well as in parking lot displays. We are thrilled that such a law now exists in Virginia. We do wish, however, that it included all companion animals. However, we have learned that one step at a time eventually brings great benefit.

If you see dogs or cats being sold at flea markets or other prohibited places, please call the authorities in the locality. For Danville, call 799-5111, option 5 and for Pittsylvania County, call 432-7937.

Flag-Topped Table

"Unique" is a word that is often misused by collectors. It means one of a kind. There can never be a unique mass-produced chair but there can be a rare one. More than 20 years ago, the Kovels' newspaper column wrote about a table with a top that was made to look like an American flag. A similar table is being sold by Woody Auction. The Kovel table had 23 stars on the flag. Maine was the 23rd state, added in 1820. The table being sold at Woody has 35 stars, suggesting it was made to honor the statehood of West Virginia in 1863.



This unusual, flag-topped table is handmade but not unique. Another almost identical table sold at an auction years ago. It had only 23 stars. This table has 35. Could there be others?

The 35-star table was marked by the maker: "Made & Designed by F. Wedin, Roxbury." Recent research by the auction gallery suggests he was a piano maker from Massachusetts. Both tables were made of solid wood with inlaid stars and stripes. The way edges of the 35-star table make it look windblown. It has a drawer with carvings of dueling pistols, side supports like anchors, cross braces like rifles, legs like cannons and cannonball feet. It is estimated at \$20,00 to \$40,000. It is truly unique.

Q: I picked up what I think is a Currier & Ives print from a thrift store. I'm just trying to see if the name of the print is a legitimate

Currier & Ives print. It's titled "A Mountain Home." If the title matches a real print made by Currier & Ives, I'd like to know if it's a reproduction. I bought it for \$6, so even if it is a reproduction, I wouldn't care since I like the print.

A. Currier & Ives was in business in New York City from 1857 to 1907 and is famous for its American lithograph prints. Reproductions and fakes have been made. "A Mountain Home" is not one of the prints listed in books that catalog the original Currier & Ives prints. It's often offered for sale online, identified as a Currier & Ives print from 1890, but one seller probably got it right when he said it is "after Currier & Ives," which means it was done in the style of the famous printmakers.

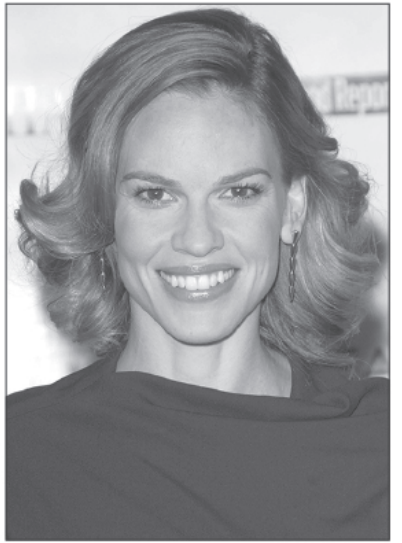

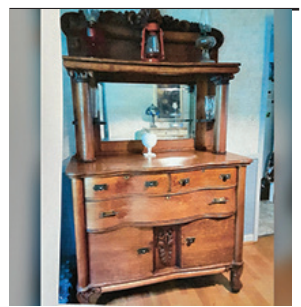

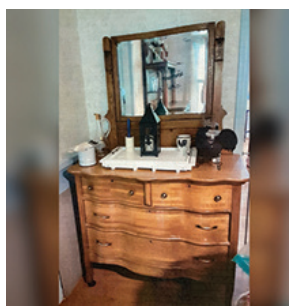

TREASURY STAFF HELP CITIZENS FIND OVER \$100,000

Virginia Department of the Treasury staff helped Danville residents find a total of \$103,230.91 during an unclaimed property virtual call event that was held on June 3-4 for local citizens who might be owed funds they don't know about.

Treasury workers looked up 542 names during the two days.

The event was held in partnership with the City of Danville's Treasurer's Office, which has already saved the dates of Dec. 1-2 to hold this event again.

The State Treasury's Unclaimed Property Division operates essentially as a centralized lost and found. It handles unclaimed money and property turned over by companies when they have lost track of the rightful owner.

Unclaimed property can include utility deposits, customer refunds, unpaid wages, money from insurance policies, securities and investments, bank accounts, and tangible property.

Under Virginia law, any funds in dormant financial accounts must be turned over to the state government, which holds them in trust. Examples of dormant accounts include a company that sent a check but was never cashed or perhaps a loved one who died with money he or she never collected.

The State Treasury's Unclaimed Property Program is a consumer protection initiative to benefit citizens. No commissions or fees are charged.

Besides the virtual call event, citizens can always go online 24/7 to www.vaMoneySearch.org and search for their name for unclaimed property.

There is no charge for searching, either at community-outreach events or through the website at www.vamoneysearch.org.

State officials caution consumers to be aware of fee-based unauthorized or unsolicited offers and make sure they are working with an authorized state representative.

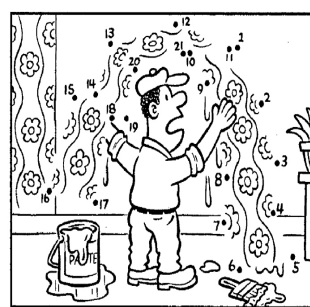

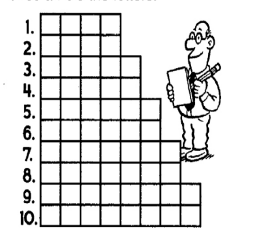

Peach Upside Down Cake



Ingredients

- ¼ cup butter
- ½ cup packed brown sugar
- 1 ½ cups sliced, pitted and peeled peaches or frozen unsweetened peach slices, thawed and large slices cut in half lengthwise
- 1 ¼ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 ¼ teaspoons baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup butter, softened
- ¾ cup granulated sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- ½ cup milk

Directions

Step 1
 Place 1/4 cup butter in an 8x8x2-inch baking pan. Warm in a 350° oven about 5 minutes or until butter is melted. (Be sure to watch carefully to avoid browning the butter). Remove pan from oven. Add brown sugar, stirring until sugar is completely moistened. Spread sugar mixture evenly in pan. Arrange peach slices evenly over brown sugar mixture. Set aside.

Step 2
 In a medium bowl, combine the flour, baking powder and salt; set aside. In a large bowl, beat 1/2 cup butter with an electric mixer on medium to high speed for 30 seconds. Beat in granulated sugar until well combined. Add egg and vanilla, beating until combined. Alternately add the flour mixture and milk to beaten butter mixture, beating on low speed after each addition just until combined. Spread batter evenly over the peaches in the pan.

Step 3
 Bake for 45 to 50 minutes or until a wooden toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool in pan on wire rack for 5 minutes. Loosen cake from sides of pan; invert onto a large serving plate. Cool for 10 to 15 minutes more. Serve warm.
