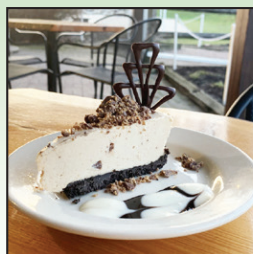

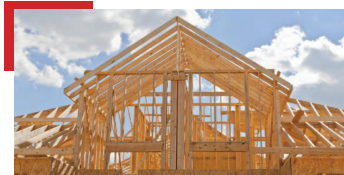

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week nineteen of our study of the United States Constitution. Article II – Section 2 – Clause 3 reads "The President shall have Power to fill up all Vacancies that may happen during the Recess of the Senate, by granting Commissions which shall expire at the End of their next Session."

When the United States Senate is in recess and a vacancy occurs in the Executive Department, the President of the United States has the authority to fill that vacancy.

Article II – Section 3 – Clause 1 reads "He shall from time to time give to the Congress Information of the State of the Union, and recommend to their Consideration such Measures as he shall judge necessary and expedient; he may, on extraordinary Occasions, convene both Houses, or either of them, and in Case of Disagreement between them, with Respect to the Time of Adjournment, he may adjourn them to such Time as he shall think proper; he shall receive Ambassadors and other public Ministers; he shall take Care that the Laws be faithfully executed, and shall Commission all the Officers of the United States."

We have heard "State of the Union" addresses by various Presidents. It is important to notice the word "recommend" because the President can only recommend to the Congress measures which he believes are necessary for their consideration and cannot force Congress. An extraordinary occasion during which he may convene both Houses of Congress would be to ask Congress to declare war against another country. This has not happened since President Franklin Delano Roosevelt convened both Houses of Congress on Monday, December 8, 1941, to declare war against Japan.

Presidents in the past eighty years have declared wars unilaterally which is a direct violation of our Constitution. Both the House of Representatives and the United States Senate must mutually agree upon their joint adjournments. This provision ensures that one House would not be in recess while the other House was in session in the event a national emergency occurs which would endanger the security of our country. To "receive Ambassadors and other public Ministers" was intended to determine which nations the United States would have relations with and what the tone and temper of those relations would be. This clause also instructs the President to faithfully execute all the laws of the United States.

Article II – Section 4 – Clause 1 reads "The President, Vice President and all civil Officers of the United States, shall be removed from Office on Impeachment for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors." We have all been educated in the past couple of years concerning the topic of impeachment. It is important to understand that any officer of the United States of America can be impeached including elected representatives of Congress and members of the Supreme Court.

We observed recently that Article I regarding the responsibilities of the Congress encompassed over three months and now in just a few short weeks we have concluded the responsibilities of the President of the United States.

Our founding fathers entrusted more responsibility to the Congress than to the Executive Branch of our government. The United States Constitution began with the words "We the People" and the Gettysburg Address reads "by the people, for the people..."

Lord willing, we will continue our study of our Constitution next week.

knowledgeable, skilled, careful, and thoughtful. He is an outstanding clinical leader and is well respected amongst his peers. Rob always puts others before himself. Even during this deadly pandemic, his courageousness and sense of duty has not wavered. He is an example amongst his peers - that we in this profession are here to serve others, no matter where we encounter them, in a timely efficient manner and with a commitment to compassion and excellence."

EMS Agency of the Year Award: Livingston County EMS

The Monroe-Livingston Regional EMS Council has also recognized Livingston County EMS with the EMS Agency of the Year award. This award is presented to an agency that strives for consistency in EMS excellence and exhibits exemplary performance when providing or supporting prehospital emergency medical care.

Dr. Farney also nominated Livingston County EMS for this award. Farney states, "In 2004, a county-wide municipal safety net EMS service was established by Livingston County. Today, Livingston County EMS serves as primary ALS for the majority of Livingston County, the primary transport ambulance agency for many towns, and continues to provide backup services for other local agencies. Livingston County also offers inter-facility, Specialty Care and Physician transport services from Noyes Memorial Hospital to other hospitals in the region."

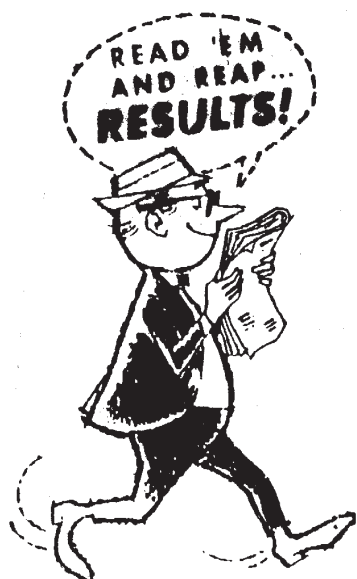
"In 2020, as the COVID pandemic set in, LCEMS visibly established themselves as a leader in the region," Dr. Farney continues. "The county agency took point on PPE distribution to Livingston County police, fire, and EMS agencies. The agency transported COVID-19 samples, hosted daily briefings and weekly county-wide conference calls, offered medical support for county DOH COVID-19 vaccination clinics, and demonstrated leadership in the field as COVID cases surged, role modeling PPE."

Rural counties throughout the state as far away as the Adirondacks have turned to Livingston County for guidance and advice, seeking to establish a similar system. 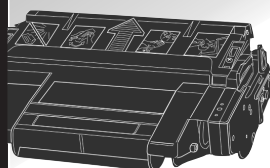

Reproductive Health Center Celebrates 50 Years and Has a New Name!

Mount Morris, NY, June 2021 – Reproductive Health Center (RHC), has provided quality comprehensive family planning, sexual and reproductive health services to teens and adults in our community since 1971 and continues to offer the most up to date care. RHC now has a new name, the Center for Sexual Health and Wellness, which better represents the services that are offered.

The Center for Sexual Health and Wellness, a program of the Livingston County Department of Health, continues to offer clinics at two community sites in Dansville and Mt. Morris, which are located in Livingston County to make family planning services conveniently accessible to all County residents. Two additional clinics are located at SUNY Geneseo and provide services to SUNY Geneseo students.

“The Center for Sexual Health and Wellness continues to make preventive health and family planning services accessible to many low-income and uninsured community members”, states Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director.

This year marks the 50th anniversary of the Center for Sexual Health and Wellness’ existence! The Center is celebrating the significant positive impact it has had on teens and adults in our community. According to the New York State Department of Health, the teen birth rate among Livingston County youth aged 15-19 has continued to remain low for several years. While STI rates in Livingston County are much lower than New York State rates, they have trended upward in the past few years. This has also been occurring nationally.

“Individuals who may be at risk for STIs are encouraged to call the Center for Sexual Health and Wellness or their doctor to get tested”, states Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director. In addition to STI testing, Expedited Partner Therapy (EPT) is another way to reduce the spread of STIs. EPT is the clinical practice of treating the sex partners of patients diagnosed with chlamydia, gonorrhea or trichomoniasis by providing prescriptions or medications to the patient to take to his/her partner without the health care provider first examining the partner.

The goals of the Center for Sexual Health and Wellness are to ensure the availability of birth control, offer STI testing and treatment and provide annual exams including cervical cancer screenings. Our friendly and professional staff provide in person services using COVID-19 precautions or using telehealth through video chat or online. Confidential, low or no cost services include birth control, emergency contraception, STI testing and treatment, HIV rapid testing, pregnancy testing and options counseling, reproductive life planning, annual exams and counseling and referral services.
