

All Virginia "releasing agencies" are heavily regulated and governed by the Code of Virginia. A releasing agency is defined as "(i) a public animal shelter or (ii) a private animal shelter, humane society, animal welfare organization, society for the prevention of cruelty to animals, or other similar entity or home-based rescue that releases companion animals for adoption." (3.2 - 6500)

When an animal is received as a stray with no collar, tattoo, or other evidence of ownership by any releasing agency, that animal must be held a minimum of five days, not including the day they come in. After that stray time, the animal is considered abandoned and becomes the property of the releasing agency. That is when the animal can be adopted or transferred or euthanized.

If the stray animal comes in bearing some evidence of ownership, that time is doubled to ten days, not including the day they come in.

This is actually a very important law. In the past, an adopted animal could technically be reclaimed by a former owner, no matter how much time had passed. Now, the releasing agency becomes the legal owner and the adopter can be assured that animal is legally theirs.

A legal adoption of a shelter animal includes the requirement that the animal must be spayed or neutered. There is no exemption for previous owners who were hoping to breed that animal. This means that even if the previous owner has been out of town on vacation, has a caretaker for their very expensive breeding

dog or cat, that animal escapes and is picked up as a stray, if the holding period has passed, the animal must be sterilized. We, of course, strongly support this provision.

If you own a dog or cat, there are things that you can do to help ensure your animal is not adopted by someone else:

1. Keep your animal safely confined.

2. Microchip them so at least the stray time is doubled. Be sure to register that chip and keep your contact information current.

If your dog or 3. cat does stray from your property, promptly call every shelter and rescue group within a wide radius. File a lost report, but also visit the shelters and ask them to post a picture.

Owners need to be very diligent in searching for their strayed dog or cat; if not, ownership could be lost.

In the early 1900s, housewives began painting ceramics. Amateurs and artists bought marked plain white porcelain from Germany, Japan, England and other countries, and then decorated them in American styles. Magazines featured instructions and designs for this hobby. Special paints could remain permanently on a glazed vase or dinner plate even when washed. Unfortunately, the paint will not always survive the heat of a modern dishwasher, and the art can disappear.

One of the most famous professional decorators, John Bennett, was born in Staffordshire, England, in 1840 and worked at Doulton & Co. in the 1870s. He moved to New York about 1876 and started his own ceramic business. In 1882, he retired, moved to New Jersey and decorated pottery that he stamped "W. Orange-N. J." Bennett died in 1907.

His ceramic paintings were asym-

metrical designs of colorful flowers and nature. He was influenced by the aesthetic, and arts and crafts movements. His work is expensive today. This very large covered urn, 16 1/2 inches high, is signed "Bennett." It pictures clusters of pink and white hydrangea blossoms and green leaves on a black background. Rago Arts and Auction Center sold it for \$5,000 plus buyer's premium.



Dust Mite Allergy Triggers Cough

DEAR DR. ROACH: For months, I have had a persistent cough that I have been unable to get help with. I saw an allergist about three years ago and was told I am allergic to dust mites. I was first referred to a lung doctor where X-rays showed that my cheek sinus drains were completely blocked, and then to an ear, nose and throat doctor, who also confirmed this diagnosis.

This ENT doctor recommended I have surgery to unblock the drains and clear out the sinus area. I understand that sinus drainage can cause coughing and wonder if this would still make me cough. I sometimes cough until I can cough up something, and this seems to stop my cough for a while. I was using a nasal rinse for a while until about two weeks ago when it caused my nose to bleed. The ENT doctor prescribed antibiotics and oral steroids that did not make any difference. It doesn't seem to make any difference whether I'm home or sitting in the doctor's office, I'm still coughing. What is the best way to deal with dust mite allergy? -- J.S. ANSWER: There are many causes of chronic cough, but postnasal drip is at the top of the list. Dust mites are indeed a common allergen, and symptoms may include runny nose, watery eyes, sneezing and cough from postnasal drip. Specific treatment for dust mites should include physical barriers, such as covers for pillows and mattresses, and sometimes for other soft surfaces, like furniture cushions, but this is only part of an effective strategy. Removing as many fabrics as possible (draperies, carpets, stuffed children's toys) where dust mites can live is essential. Regular cleaning is necessary, and high efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filters for vacuuming have been shown to reduce dust mites. A low-humidity environment can be very effective in discouraging dust mites, and cooler air -- especially at night -- can reduce irritation of nasal passages caused by dry air. Many interventions for a prolonged period are necessary to reduce dust mite infestation and the symptoms associated with them. This is critical, because the issue of the sinuses is probably secondary to ongoing allergic exposure. Fixing your sinuses will not fix your ongoing symptoms. Without control of the allergens, you will continue to have symptoms and may even develop sinus blockages again, no matter how good a job the surgeon does on your sinuses. ***

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am 90 years old. My husband and I donated blood as often as needed, over 100 times, but last week my doctor said I tested positive for syphilis. I about fell off my chair. I haven't slept for four nights. Have you ever heard of this? -- E.

ANSWER: The screening test for syphilis, called the VDRL or RPR test, is not particularly accurate. About 1-2% of people will have a false positive result. Meaning, the test is positive but they do not have syphilis. There are many possible causes, such as infection and autoimmune disease, like lupus, but some people, particularly older people, will have a positive test for no identifiable reason.

In your case, I am sure it is a false positive, but your doctor may do a more specific test, such as an FTA-ABS, to be 100% sure. You shouldn't let it keep you awake at night.

HOLLYWOOD Arnold Schwarzenegger has taken two years and the pandemic to plan his next move. His last film, "Terminator: Dark Fate" (2019), cost \$190 million and earned only \$261 million. 

The public library will be closed on Friday and Saturday.


