BAIL

Whether by poor choices or unfortunate circumstances, if you find yourself in jail, your first goal will be to pay bail so you don't have to remain there until your arraignment, or worse, your trial date. If the crime you've been arrested for is common, such as minor theft or property damage, there is usually a set amount of bail you will have to pay. If you can't afford that amount and don't have property of value to offer, you may ask a judge to lower your bail at your arraignment. Being "out on bail" includes following any conditions of release set by a judge such as not leaving the state or having contact with others involved in

If you've been arrested for a minor offense, you might be given a written citation and released, after signing the citation and promising to appear in court at a later date. If not, you will go through the bail and bond procedure. If you have been charged with a crime and are worried about a way out, consult the Law Office of MACK & PACE. Being accused of a criminal offense can be scary and it may include a lot of paperwork. To avoid mistakes that might cause a longer sentence, please call.

To the Residents of the Town of Barre,

I am currently a resident of the Town of Barre and possess a Bachelor of Science Degree in Biology and a Master of Education Degree in Secondary Education and Special Education. With regards to the upcoming primary election on June 22, 2021 two town council positions will be available. It is important for the Town of Barre residents to have a voice, be able to express concerns on all matters, feel that they are heard, and have people in town council positions who vote representing the views of the residents.

According to The Association of Towns of the State of New York Town Law Manual referenced on page 20 addressing the duties of a Town Board member: "When a town board member votes on a proposal before the board, he or she represents, through that vote, the views of the town residents. Because of this high level of responsibility, and in order to ensure that residents' voices are accurately reflected, some board members may want residents to vote on matters before the town board takes action." A resident town vote or poll was never conducted concerning the construction of wind turbines affecting all of the residents in the Town of Barre and surrounding communities prior to lease contracts being signed and the board approving the updated Wind Ordinance on Feb. 10, 2021. At many Town Board meetings since 2018, residents have asked for a vote on the proposed Wind Project, or if industrial wind facilities have a place in the Town of Barre, and this request was

dismissed every time. If a town vote

or poll was conducted it would have clearly shown where the majority lies alleviating the stress and division it has placed on the community. Instead only one survey was conducted; however, I never received this survey along with the majority of residents in Barre. Essentially the results of this survey do not accurately represent the views of the residents of Barre because not all of the 2,025 residents were aware of this survey and did not receive this survey by mail.

On Nov. 4, 2020 I submitted an email to all four town council board members including the town supervisor expressing my concerns regarding six 680 feet wind turbines being placed all within 34 of a mile from my residence. My four-year-old child was diagnosed with autism two years ago. Autism is a neurological developmental disorder. All children with autism have Sensory Processing Disorder (SPD) which causes their nervous system to respond to stimuli much different than an ordinary individual. People with autism are extra sensitive to sound and visual disturbances due to the abnormal neural connectivity in their brain which can impact their ability to function daily. Therefore, close proximity of wind turbines to an individual with autism can severely impact their quality of life due to the shadow flicker, audible noise, and infrasound.

Then on Feb. 3, 2021 I submitted an article to all town council board members written by Grace L. Howell from Western University entitled, "Autism and the effect of introducing a new noise source into quiet rural communities: risk factor from industrial wind power generation", to validate my concerns regarding the effects on individuals with autism in close proximity to wind turbines.

On Feb.10, 2021 all four town council board members along with the town supervisor were emailed a letter from my daughter's developmental

pediatrician, who diagnosed my child's autism, expressing concerns for the impact wind turbines can have on a child with autism. It is important to note that only one town council board member responded to my letter, article, and doctor's letter addressing these concerns, and she is

not up for re-election this year. In addition, on Feb. 10, 2021 a town board meeting was held without public attendance due to COVID restrictions allowing virtual access through YouTube. One town board member addressed my concerns regarding close proximity of six turbines to my child with autism. Some town board members acknowledged that they received the three emails including attached documents but dismissed my concerns regarding my child with autism declaring that it is "site specific" only. The town supervisor then stated at 3 hrs and 5 minutes into the meeting regarding my concerns, "At this time with the autism, I don't see where we can really do anything with that. Um in essence that would be like telling if that project were to go through they would have to remove four or five of their turbines in that area up there but the ambient noise I think is the same or greater if I remember the research on that "

It doesn't matter where you stand on the proposed Wind Turbine Project the concern is that if your position doesn't align with the current town council board members your concerns will be dismissed and not considered important enough. Let's not put a price on a child with special needs quality of life. If the Town of Barre residents want to be heard and have their concerns addressed please make a change and vote for George McKenna and Dave Waters for town council on June 22, 2021.

SHERIFF'S REPORT

In the month of May, the Orleans County Sheriff's Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 2069 police incidents, including 795 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 221 for the New York State Police and 1013 calls for the Village police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley along with other law enforcement. There were 610 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched countywide with 449 of those calls emergency medical in nature and 10 drug overdoses.

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 42 automobile accidents, including 10 with injury and 18 car-deer collisions. Road patrol, also, made 83 service attempts and successfully served 53ubpoenas, civil, or court papers.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 127 incidents including 33 stray or loose animals, 4 animal bite complaints, 9 neighbor dog problems, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 7 animals were taken in to shelter on a voluntary surrender.

The Orleans County Jail processed in 52 new inmates and handled 12 transports to other facilities, court appointment, or medical appointments.
