<u>16 servings</u> Ingredients

- 1 pound spiral macaroni, cooked and drained
- 3 medium tomatoes, diced and seeded
- 16 ounces cheddar cheese, cubed
- 1 to 2 bunches green onions, sliced
- 3 ounces sliced pepperoni
- 3/4 cup canola oil
- 2/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/2 cup red wine vinegar
- 2 teaspoons dried oregano
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- Croutons, optional

1. In a large bowl, combine macaroni, tomatoes, Cheddar cheese, green onions and pepperoni. In a small bowl, combine oil, Parmesan cheese, vinegar and seasonings. Pour over macaroni mixture; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate for several hours. Top with croutons just before serving if desired.



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Antipasto Pasta Salad

<u>18 Servings</u> Ingredients

1 package (16 ounces) penne pasta

1 can (15 ounces) garbanzo beans or chickpeas, rinsed and drained

1 medium sweet red or green pepper, julienned



2 plum tomatoes, halved lengthwise and sliced

1 bunch green onions, sliced

- 4 ounces Monterey Jack cheese, julienned
- 4 ounces part-skim mozzarella cheese, julienned
- 4 ounces brick or provolone cheese, julienned
- 4 ounces thinly sliced hard salami, julienned
- 3 ounces thinly sliced pepperoni
- 1 can (2-1/4 ounces) sliced ripe olives, drained
- 1 to 2 tablespoons minced chives

BASIL VINAIGRETTE:

- 2/3 cup canola oil
- 1/3 cup red wine vinegar

3 tablespoons minced fresh basil or 1 tablespoon dried basil

- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

Directions

1. Cook pasta according to package directions; rinse with cold water and drain. In a large bowl, combine the pasta, beans, vegetables, cheeses, meats, olives and chives.

2. In a small bowl, whisk the vinaigrette

ingredients. Pour over salad; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate. Toss before serving.

Spiral Pasta Salad

<u>14 Servings</u>

Ingredients

- 1 package (12 ounces) tricolor spiral pasta
- 4 cups fresh broccoli florets
- 1 pint grape tomatoes
- 1 can (6 ounces) pitted ripe olives, drained
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1-1/2 cups Italian salad dressing with roasted red pepper and Parmesan





Directions

1. In a Dutch oven, cook pasta according to package directions, adding the broccoli during the last 2 minutes of cooking. Drain and rinse in cold water.



2. Transfer to a large bowl. Add the

tomatoes, olives, salt and pepper. Drizzle with salad dressing; toss to coat. Chill until serving.

Cashew-Chicken Rotini Salad

<u>12 Servings</u>

- Ingredients
- 1 package (16 ounces) spiral or rotini pasta
- 4 cups cubed cooked chicken
- 1 can (20 ounces) pineapple tidbits, drained
- 1-1/2 cups sliced celery
- 3/4 cup thinly sliced green onions
- 1 cup seedless red grapes
- 1 cup seedless green grapes
- 1 package (5 ounces) dried cranberries
- 1 cup ranch salad dressing
- 3/4 cup mayonnaise
- 2 cups salted cashews

Directions

1. Cook pasta according to package directions. Meanwhile, in a large bowl, combine the chicken, pineapple, celery, onions, grapes and cranberries. Drain pasta and rinse in cold water; stir into chicken mixture.

2. In a small bowl, whisk the ranch dressing and mayonnaise. Pour over salad and toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour. Just before serving, stir in cashews.

Macaroni Coleslaw <u>16 Servings</u> Ingredients

- 1 package (7 ounces) ring macaroni or ditalini
- 1 package (14 ounces) coleslaw mix
- 2 medium onions, finely chopped
- 2 celery ribs, finely chopped
- 1 medium cucumber, finely chopped
- 1 medium green pepper, finely chopped
- 1 can (8 ounces) whole water chestnuts, drained and chopped
- DRESSING:
- 1-1/2 cups Miracle Whip Light or mayonaise
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup cider vinegar

- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

Directions

1. Cook macaroni according to package directions; drain and rinse in cold water. Transfer to a large bowl; add the coleslaw mix, onions, celery, cucumber, green pepper and water chestnuts.

2. In a small bowl, whisk the dressing ingredients. Pour over salad; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour.

Chicken Taco Macaroni Salad <u>8 Serving</u>s Ingredients

- 2 cups uncooked elbow macaroni
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons reduced-sodium taco seasoning
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 3/4 teaspoon ground mustard
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 2 cups cubed rotisserie chicken
- 1 small sweet yellow or orange pepper, chopped
- 1 jalapeno pepper, seeded and chopped
- fresh cilantro leaves, optional

Directions

1. Cook macaroni according to package directions; drain and rinse with cold water. Cool completely.

2. For dressing, in a small bowl, combine mayonnaise, taco seasoning, sugar, mustard, salt and pepper. In a large bowl, combine chicken, peppers and macaroni. Add dressing; gently toss to coat. Refrigerate until serving. Top with cilantro if desired.

Claybank Master Gardeners July, 2021

Greetings Gardeners and Wannabes,

July seems to be moving in with all it's tropical fury, so here are some thoughts about how to make the most of it.



*Looking at the Alabama Extension's SOW app, there are two crops you can plant in July that

tolerate the high heat and still produce: okra and southern peas. I've grown both in my raised beds, and they do very well. The southern peas will attract ants and aphids, so get out the hose and give them a blast. *To protect from the high heat and provide a bit of afternoon shade for your plants, cover with burlap or shade cloth, or just move pots where the afternoon sun won't be so strong. Under trees, on the shady side of your home, may help. Mulch your plants with grass clippings or pine straw; both will also provide nutrition and help maintain hydration. Water when the top inch of soil is dry. Water deeply, so the roots will seek moisture deeper down rather than near the top of the soil. They might need daily or twice daily watering if they are in pots.

*Here is my best tip that is so easy and inexpensive, and has saved my veggies and roses from fungus or black spot: mix 1 part water with 2 parts milk, sour milk or buttermilk (1/3 milk, 2/3 water) in a spray bottle or canister and spray stems and both upper and underside of leaves. Folks, for me this actually works! Evidently it's the milk protein that does the trick. This is the first year I haven't lost my cucumber plants to sooty mold and bare rose stems are growing new leaves! So far I've sprayed two or three times, and it is amazing to see the improvement!
