

Right now Albion seems like a big city. We've gone from small town living to living in Tennessee's least populated mountain community. There are 300 residents in our hills. The Post Office does not deliver here. They outsource

I wish I could say our first days in this old coal mining mountain have been all sunshine & rainbows for Fin, Charles, Brian and I. The reality is this 16"x 28" shed type living is a bit different than I am accustomed to. I don't like to camp, I need organization and do not thrive in chaos. We are on the most beautiful mountain top overlooking the mountain ranges, a true blessing from God. We arrived during one of the regions most rainiest springs and our land received a good excavation prior to our arrival. So the land on the bluff we are living, is quite messy. Lucky for us our soil is sandy because down below us the soil is like clay. My arms and patience have gotten quite a workout. I have never swept so much in my life. At the present time we have no electricity or cable, but within the next week we should be able to plug in a refrigerator and surf the web, if we desire. Trying to function with coolers and a MIFI device is tricky. However, I am thankful for the options. The biggest challenge is water. The well is still pending. Luckily for us we had the foresight in March to set up rain barrels to collect water which allows us to take a heavenly outdoor shower each evening. This is my favorite part of the day. It is a temporary outdoor setup, like most of our setups right now, but it serves it's purpose. Our neighbors on the mountain, who are weekenders, offered their well water until our well is complete which we greatly appreciate. When you are living in the smallest populated area of Tennessee, it creates proximity issues for supplies so we have created a clipboard system. Everything we need when we head off the mountain is written down, because when you come back if you did not get it, you are out of luck. You may wonder how a Sassy Small Town Missus is surviving this situation. Once I yelled at my husband, yep I did. Other than that my husband has helped keep me calm. Sometimes he has patiently listened and then created a happy situation. Other times he has poured me Bourbon. With all these challenges do you know what this little mountain top does have? Morning whippoorwills, big colorful butterflies galore, peace, possibilities, adventure, character building moments, a warm and welcoming community, breathtaking views, countless fireflies, endless night stars and joy. Everyone who learns we are transplants has let us know that TN is a great place, they have huge pride for their state. Maybe that is why they have happily welcomed us! (Someday maybe I will tell you about the Porta Potty, viks!) Where is your happy place?

Travel Thoughts By Kim Let's go on an adventure together.... to New Orleans Louisiana!

You don't have to wait till Mardi Gras to visit and have a ton of fun in New Orleans, Louisiana! In fact, I am so glad my first time in NOLA was during the off season – it was so much easier to get around and explore without the crowds of people.

My time in New Orleans was in September 2016 during the cross country motorhome trip I took with my brother and sister-in-law. We spent about ten days in Houma, LA visiting with my nephew and his family, and, I even got to see an old friend in addition to the family we stayed with.

I took the hour's drive from Houma to New Orleans on three different days. The first day was with my family. We parked downtown and walked all along the Main St through New Orleans to the dock where we took a steamboat cruise on the Natchez – one of only two true steam boats still active on the Mississippi River, today. I loved that cruise – so much fun. Consider taking one if you go – it really is wonderful.



Look up on whatever street you happen to be walking along in the French Quarter in New Orleans and you'll see gorgeous balconies loaded with plants and flowers.

Along our stroll, we stopped for our first taste of the amazing food New Orleans has to offer. We had lunch at one of Sean and his family's favorite places: Huck Finn's – a place you really need to put on your to-do list when planning a trip to NOLA – fabulous food. I chose the jambalaya wrap and it was awesome – just the right amount of heat and the flavors were to die for. We also stopped at the Café Du Monde for beignets – pure heaven on a plate – hot, fluffy, fresh, and sugary – also a must do spot!

The next day, I took the rental car and drove in to meet up with an old high school friend who was living just outside New Orleans in Metairie at the time. He took me walking all over the French Quarter. I was in awe of all the gorgeous buildings and amazing music. We stopped to listen to a lot of the wonderful street musicians playing lively jazz and soulful blues. We strolled through the French Market and looked at all the beautiful crafts

and breathed in the amazing aromas of food. I was also really fascinated by all the "human sculptures" throughout the French Quarter – these are people who make themselves up specifically to pose in a stationary position for hours on end for whatever the tourists leave in their buckets - tough way to make a living, if you ask me, but it is really entertaining to see.

We were even lucky enough to get to see a little pop-up parade with music, dancing, and umbrellas - just like you see in the movies. I understand you have to get a permit to close off a street for a parade like this and it is usually reserved for weddings and funerals, but other celebrations occur on occasion – this one was a birthday celebration. So glad we got to see it - what fun!

That day, Russ and I found a cool little place on Bourbon Street and had Shrimp Po-boys for lunch. Sorry – I don't remember the name of the place, but it was so good! The shrimp was perfectly cooked and crunchy with a nice little kick to it on an amazing roll with pickles, lettuce, and tomatoes - WOW!!! Everywhere we went, there was alligator of some kind on the menu - right alongside lots of varieties of seafood and southern comfort food. I regret that I wasn't adventurous enough to try it - I should have so I could say I did, but you know what they say about hindsight!




St. Louis Cemetery # 1 is the oldest and most famous cemetery in New Orleans. One of the crypts that stands out is this one owned by Nicolas Cage. He loved New Orleans so much, he decided he wanted to be buried there.

On the third New Orleans day, I drove in to take a hop-on-hop-off trolley tour on my own that took me absolutely everywhere. A particular

thrill for me was to hop-off for a tour of St. Louis Cemetery # 1 – the oldest and most famous of the currently existing cemeteries in New Orleans. It was stablished in the late 1700s and still has active burials. Cemeteries in NOLA can only contain above ground burials because they are right at sea level, so it makes for wonderful place to wander around. This particular cemetery is where famed Voodoo Priestess Marie Laveau is interned in a family crypt. But, the crypt that stood out most was a pyramid shaped one that looked totally out of place among all the incredible old crypts and mausoleums. Our guide told us that it was actually the final resting place of Nicolas Cage! Of course, he's not there, yet, but he loved New Orleans so much that he bought a plot and had this crypt designed so he could be interned there when the time comes. Be sure to put St. Louis Cemetery # 1 on your list – there is a \$20 entrance fee and can only be entered with a tour guide because they had a lot of trouble with vandals and damage, in particular to Marie Laveau's crypt, but so worth it.

That day, I had lunch at a crepe café. I chose "The Lucy" – crepes stuffed with fresh strawberries and amaretto custard and topped with cinnamon and powdered sugar and more fresh strawberries – YUMMY!

New Orleans was amazing and between my three days there and three difference perspectives with family and friends I don't think I missed anything! But, I don't want to leave Houma out of this article. Houma is a wonderful town with several bayous. We had dinner at a little shack-like dive called Bayou Delight just outside Houma one night that serves Cajun and Creole cuisine. We all had their specialty - fried chicken - so good - crispy, spicy breading and moist, tender, juicy chicken! And, while we were waiting for our food, we went out on the deck to watch the alligators in the bayou – that was fun. So - don't think all New Orleans has to offer is Mardi Gras and crowds of crazy people. If that's your thing, then go during that annual festival. But, you can go off season and have so much fun and see it all and enjoy the food and the music that New Orleans is most famous for without all the crowds. It is an awesome experience, for sure. SIGNS OF A STROKE


Ballots for a Divisive Election

My most sincere gratitude is extended to Donna Burdick, historian for the Town of Smithfield, and Melissa Irelan, historian for the Town of Clarendon, for their help in research.

Local history in Orleans County tends to be....local. Being rural, it's not that we are cut off from larger currents of history, but our connections tend to be more indirect. This is certainly true in the political sphere.

On the precipice of Civil War, the election of 1860 was tense. Abraham Lincoln is often perceived as a champion of abolition, which is inaccurate. In reality, abolitionists did not favor Lincoln as a candidate because they believed he made too many concessions to proslavery advocates. Instead of voting for the "lesser of two evils," a few men in Gaines and elsewhere in Orleans County supported the Liberty Party, which held an uncompromising abolitionist stance among other platforms outside the mainstream, such as the prohibition of alcohol.



Robert J. Anderson (1787-1873), Gaines' second supervisor, was a fervent abolitionist, as evidenced by the fact he was a constituent member of the Free Congregationalist Church in Gaines, and by the high probability he ran for Lieutenant Governor for the Liberty Party in 1848. In late October 1860, Robert received a letter originating from Peterboro, NY. The letter, written by Charles A. Hammond, chair of the financial committee of the Liberty Party, stated that "24 Electoral and State tickets" were enclosed for him to

compromise to preserve the Union.


However, members of the Liberty Party by this point were also known as Radical Abolitionists. They believed in the immediate emancipation, with no recompense to slaveholders. Founded in 1840, the abolition of slavery was their primary objective, but the prohibition of alcohol emerged as a second major goal. As the 1850's wore on, they were dismayed to see more pragmatic abolitionists shy away from absolute abolition and temperance ideals to support more nuanced approaches to these issues. As early as 1853, Charles Hammond was guoted in the New-York Daily Tribune that he "suspected the Liberty party had lost its savor, and was not worth maintaining."

Although the above reference does not indicate in exactly what way he felt

the party had lost its way, one wonders if perhaps he perceived a de-emphasis of temperance ideals. Charles A. Hammond (1825-1912), both a minister and lawyer, was well-known in central New York as a vocal temperance advocate, as can be seen by numerous citations in various newspapers throughout the latter half of the 19th century. He also happened to be a friend and one-time neighbor of Gerrit Smith, a philanthropist based in Peterboro, NY, who was the Liberty Party's presidential candidate in 1860. Those who supported the Liberty Party in 1860 were idealists in the

all of the candidates the party had endorsed, were printed on a single sheet of paper. Each ticket was cut out, and that is what was placed in the ballot box.

Douglas. Charles Hammond added some revealing commentary in his post script: "Let us by all means, save for freedom all we can. How can Abolitionists vote for a



them in the ballot box." The letter mentions that tickets were also sent to George Salisbury of Clarendon.

George S. Salisbury (1803-1882) had the honor of having the first recorded marriage in the town book of Clarendon in 1830. He, his wife Amanda, and their eight children lived in a stone house which still stands on the east side of Fancher Rd. The *Holley Standard* reported in 1873 that a large number of Salisburys were members of the Good Templars, a temperance society – which is not too surprising, given his connection to the Liberty Party.

There are a number of things that have changed over the past one hundred


and sixty years, and voting is one of them. In the 19th century, ballots were created by each political party and sent out to its members. In 1860, the major parties were Republicans and Democrats, but four other parties had presidential candidates as well, including the Liberty Party. State laws dictated how large the ballots could be and what sort of paper was to be


extreme. Had they been willing to make concessions, they might have garnered more votes, but they had a clear view of the end goal and refused to deviate from it. Over a hundred years later, Republican presidential candidate Barry Goldwater said, "Extremism in the defense of liberty is no vice. And moderation in the pursuit of justice is no virtue." I think Robert, George, Charles and Gerrit would have agreed.
