

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week twenty-one of our study of the United States Constitution.

Article III – Section 2 – Clause 2 reads "In all Cases affecting Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls, and those in which a State shall be Party, the supreme Court shall have original Jurisdiction. In all the other Cases before mentioned, the supreme Court shall have appellate Jurisdiction, both as to Law and Fact, with such Exceptions, and under such Regulations as the Congress shall make."

"Original Jurisdiction" of a court is the power to hear a case for the first time as opposed to "Appellate Jurisdiction" when a higher court has the power to review a lower court's decision

"Law and Fact" is a term used to denote issues or events that have taken place and the legal jurisdiction that governs how they are viewed. Fact in legal terms, is the event, while law refers to the actual rules that determine how facts are viewed by the courts.

Article III – Section 2 – Clause 3 reads "The Trial of all Crimes, except in Cases of Impeachment, shall be by Jury; and such Trial shall be held in the State where the said Crimes shall have been committed; but when not committed within any State, the Trial shall be at such Place or Places as the Congress may by Law have directed."

"Cases of Impeachment" are initiated by the House of Representatives and tried by the United States Senate. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court tries impeachment trials of the President of the United States and the jurors are the members of the United States Senate.

Article III – Section 3 – Clause 1 reads "Treason against the United States, shall consist only in levying War against them, or in adhering to their Enemies, giving them Aid and Comfort. No Person shall be convicted of Treason unless on the Testimony of two Witnesses to the same overt Act, or on Confession in open Court."

Because many of the precepts in our Constitution were derived from the Bible, the concept that "two or three witnesses" must testify for a fact to be determined and not just the testimony of one witness. This is very important in a trial for treason because the defendant could receive the death penalty. 2 Corinthians 13:1 reads "But here is what God says about that, in the mouth of two or three witnesses let every word be established." KJV.

Article III – Section 3 – Clause 2 reads "The Congress shall have Power to declare the Punishment of Treason, but no Attainder of Treason shall work Corruption of Blood, or Forfeiture except during the Life of the Person attainted." The Congress has the authority to determine the penalty for treason as death and for misprision of treason. Misprision of treason is the deliberate concealment of one's knowledge of a treasonable act or a felony with seven years of imprisonment in a federal prison.

Upon conviction of and sentencing for treason, a person is attainted which means that a person loses all claim to the protection of the law. Under English law attainder of treason worked "corruption of blood" which deprived the traitor's descendants of the right to inherit property from or through him. We have completed Article I regarding the Congress, Article II regarding the Executive Branch and now Article III regarding the Supreme Court.

Next week, Lord willing, we will continue the study of our Constitution with Article IV which addresses the powers and limitations of the individual states and how they relate to the federal government.


